
Z Watch Quick Guide

Thank you for buying SmartQ Z Watch! In order to help you have fun with employing the product, please read this quick tutorial first to understand the basic operations and notes of Z Watch.

Product Appearance





Power button	Long press to turn on/off Z Watch; Short press to make Z Watch sleep/ wake.
Back button	Back to the previous interface.

Notes:

 The water resistance of Z Watch ensure that it can soak briefly in shallow water at room temperature. Please don't wear watch when you bath, swim and dive or dip the watch into water for a long time.

• Please use certified adapters by Smart Devices or computers to charge.

• When using headphones, please adjust volume to a safe level and avoid listening continuously for very long periods in case of hearing loss. Besides, for the sake of safety, please don't use headphones when driving or crossing the road.

Please connect the accessorial cable to the USB interface on the computer or a 5V DC charger. Insert the headphone plug into the headphone jack and start charging.After 2-3 hours, the battery will be full. Then, unplug the cable.

Turn On

Press the power button until the logo of Smart Devices appears on the screen. Then wait a moment and enter the main interface after Android system has started.

Shutdown/Reboot

If the watch won't be used in several days, please turn off the power. The operations are illustrated as follows: Press the power button for two seconds and then click "OK" on the window of "Shutdown". When it has a system crash or the operation has no response, press the power button for more than 10 seconds so that the system can be forced to reboot.

Synchronize to Phone

Please download and install Z Watch Aide APP through http://126.am/zwatch or QR code. (The phone's system had better be Android 4.0 or higher so that you can gain the best experience.)
