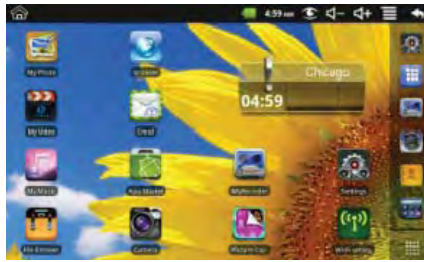

Setting Up Your FunTab Tablet

Charge the device

- 1 Plug the power adapter into an electrical wall outlet.
- 2 Connect the power adapter to the device's power interface port to fully charge the battery before use (approximately 4 hours).



- a. While charging, the battery indicator light  will fill and then drain with an image of a lightning bolt.
- b. When fully charged, the battery indicator light  is green.



NOTE: The device cannot be charged via the USB cable.



NOTE: The device can be used while the battery is charging, although the charging time is longer when operating and charging at the same time.

Battery Management

The battery is not fully charged out of the box, so it is recommended you charge the battery for at least 4 hours before you start to use the device.


The rechargeable battery is designed and manufactured to be used and recharged frequently. As with all batteries, the capacity of the battery reduces each time it is charged/depleted. However, you can still try to prolong the battery's lifetime by following the suggestions below:


- Use your Tablet at least once a week.
- Charge the battery regularly and fully.
- Never leave the battery fully discharged for a long period of time.
- Always keep the device and the battery away from heat.

To connect to a 3G wireless network:

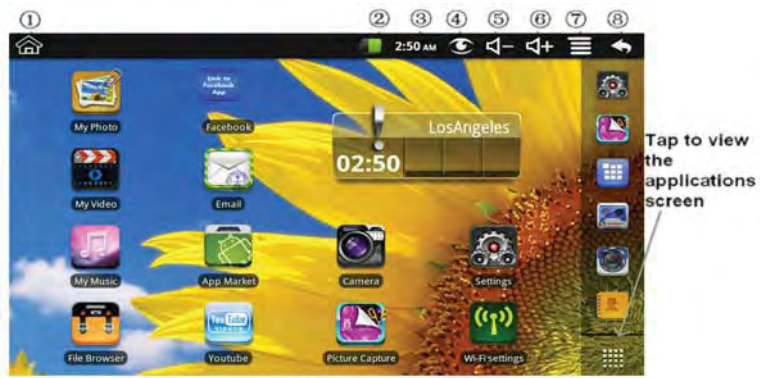



Tap the **File Browser** icon  to view the files on all storage devices (*Internal memory, MicroSD card, USB device*), and to quickly and easily install Android applications on your device.


Use the icons across the top of the screen as follows:

To copy media between a computer and the device:

Use the **File Browser**  to copy files between an external storage device and your tablet. You must first copy the desired files onto a MicroSD card or USB device.

 **NOTE:** The internal device storage is titled "LocalDisk", a memory card "sdcard", and a USB storage device is titled "udisk".


 **NOTE:** The instructions below are for copying from a MicroSD card or USB storage device into the tablet. To copy files between your computer and the device, connect the tablet to your computer with the USB Cable. Then drag & drop your files to/from the tablet Remove Storage Device located in "My Computer".

- 1 Tap the **File Browser** icon .
- 2 Tap the MicroSD card icon  or the USB icon  to display the contents of your storage device.
- 3 Tap and hold in the folder/file you want to copy.
- 4 Tap **Copy**.
- 5 Tap on the Local disk icon .
- 6 Tap on the folder into which you want to copy the file.
- 7 Tap **Paste**.
- 8 Tap the HOME icon  to return to the *HOME* screen.





To delete files:

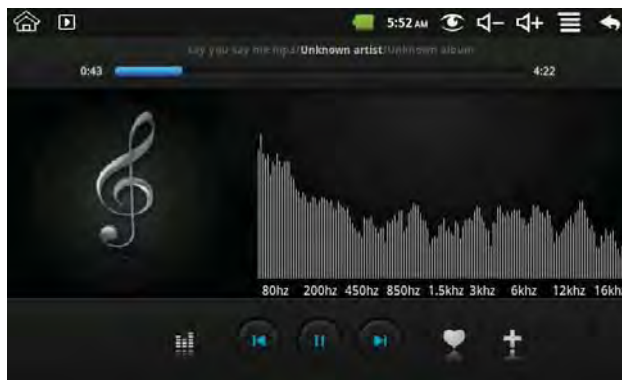
- 1 Tap the **File Browser** icon .
- 2 Tap and hold on the folder/file you want to delete.
- 3 Tap **Delete**.
- 4 Tap **OK** to confirm the deletion.


My Music

 **NOTE:** The device supports MP2, MP3, WAV, AAC, and WMA file formats.


To play music:

- 1 Tap the **My Music** icon .
- 2 Select an audio file from All/Albums/Artists/Directories/My Favorites/User Defined Playlists.
- 3 Tap the **Pause** icon  to stop the music.
- 4 To leave the music playing and return to previous screens, tap the **BACK** icon  or the **HOME** icon  to return to the *HOME* screen.
- 5 Tap the photo on the left corner to access the Music Player interface. It appears as follows:



 **NOTE:** At this interface, you can view the lyrics, play/pause, switch to the previous/next, add to favorites, loop, random operation, etc.

To add a playlist:

- 1 Tap the **Plus Sign**  on the lower right-hand corner.
- 2 Enter the playlist name.
- 3 Tap **Add**.

To rename or delete a playlist:

- 1 Tap and hold the playlist.
- 2 Tap **Rename** or **Delete**.


To add music:

- 1 Tap and hold the music file you want to add.
- 2 Tap **Add**.
- 3 Tap the following item to add music in it, or tap **Cancel**.



To delete music:

- 1 Tap and hold in the music you want to delete.
- 2 Tap **Delete**.


My Video

 **NOTE:** The device supports MPEG1/2/4, MJPG, H263, and H264 file formats. In addition to H264, which is supported by 720 x 480 resolution, the other video formats are supported by 1280 x 720 resolution.

To play video:

- 1 Tap the **My Video** icon .
- 2 Select a video file from All/Directories/My Favorites/User Defined Playlists to play it.
- 3 Tap the screen to display video controls (adjust volume, pause/play, previous/next, adjust brightness).
- 4 Press the BACK button  to return to the **MY Video** screen.

To add a playlist:

- 1 Tap the **Plus Sign**  on the lower right-hand corner.
- 2 Enter the playlist name.
- 3 Tap **Add**.

To rename or delete a playlist:

- 1 Tap and hold in the playlist.
- 2 Tap **Rename** or **Delete**.

To add a video:

- 1 Tap and hold the video you want to add.



- 2 Tap **Add**.
- 3 Tap the following item to add music in it, or tap **Cancel**.

To delete a video:

- 1 Tap and hold the video you want to delete.
- 2 Tap **Delete**.

My Photo



NOTE: The device supports JPG, JPEG, BMP, and PNG file formats.

- 1 Tap the **My Photo** icon .
- 2 Tap on a photo group.
- 3 Tap on the desired photo to view individual photos.
- 4 Press the **BACK** button  to return to the photo gallery screen.
- 5 Tap the **PLAY** icon  to make a slideshow. There is Normal play, Reminiscently, Activity, Romantic, Tranquil, and Fresh.
- 6 Tap the **COLOR** icon  to sort pictures by color.
- 7 Tap the **TIME** icon  to sort pictures by time.
- 8 Tap the **NAME** icon  to sort pictures by name.
- 9 Tap the **Doodle** icon  to enter the doodle interface where you can select different doodle operations, including: word balloons, titles, stickers, and brush.




Gallery


Tap the **Gallery** icon  to view all **Photos** and **Videos**.





NOTE: Media files are sorted into groups by the local disk (internal memory), MicroSD card and camera.

To view photos:



- 1 Tap the **Gallery** icon .
- 2 Tap on a photo group.
- 3 Tap on the desired photo to view individual photos.
- 4 Press the **BACK** button  to return to the photo group screen.
- 5 For a slideshow of all photos in a group, tap the **INDEX** icon .
- 6 Select **Slideshow**.

- 7 Press the BACK button  to return to the photo group screen.




To change photo settings:

- 1 In the photo gallery screen, tap the INDEX icon .
- 2 Select **Settings**.
- 3 Tap an option to set or change your preference.
- 4 Tap the BACK icon  to return to the photo group screen.

To view videos:

- 1 Tap the **Gallery** icon .
- 2 Tap on a video group.
- 3 Tap the desired video to view it.
- 4 Tap the screen to display video controls (adjust volume, pause/play, previous/next, adjust brightness, etc).
- 5 Press the BACK button  to return to the **Gallery** screen.




To delete photos or videos:

- 1 Tap the **Gallery** icon .
- 2 Tap on a photo or video group.
- 3 Tap the INDEX icon .
- 4 Select **Multiselect**.
- 5 Tap the desired photo(s) or video(s) you want to delete.
- 6 Tap **Delete**.
- 7 Tap **OK** to confirm deletion.
- 8 Tap the BACK icon  to return to the **Gallery** screen.

Contacts



You can create an address book of your personal contacts, including personal notes as desired.

To add a new contact:


- 1 Tap the **Contacts** icon .
- 2 Tap the INDEX icon .
- 3 Select **New Contact**.
- 4 Tap the **Plus Sign**  at the right to reveal additional choices.
- 5 Tap on the option name to reveal choices.

- 6 Tap in the option entry fields to enter the contact's information.
- 7 Tap **Done**.

To add a contact to favorites:

- 1 In the **Contacts** screen, tap the desired contact name.
- 2 Tap the **Star** icon  in the upper right-hand corner.
- 3 Tap the **BACK** icon  to return to the **Contacts** screen.
- 4 Tap **Favorites** to view a list of favorite contacts.


To edit contacts:

- 1 In the **Contacts** screen, tap the contact name to be edited.
- 2 Tap the **INDEX** icon .
- 3 Select **Edit Contact**.
- 4 Make the desired changes to the contact information.
- 5 Tap **Done**.

To delete contacts:


- 1 In the **Contacts** screen, touch and hold on the contact to be deleted.
- 2 Tap **Delete Contact**.


OR

- 1 In the **Contacts** screen, tap the contact to be deleted.
- 2 Tap the **INDEX** icon .
- 3 Select **Delete Contact**.
- 4 Tap **OK** to confirm the deletion.


Picture Capture

You can capture a screen image at any time by tapping the **Picture**

Capture icon .


Tap the **Picture Capture** application icon  to set options for a screen capture.

- Select a delay timer to automatically capture the screen in the desired number of seconds.
- Select the default storage device for saving your images.


After images are saved, they can be viewed using the **My Photo** application .

Task Manager



Use the **Task Manager**  to manage applications and widgets.

 **NOTE:** Android does not automatically stop applications after they are loaded. However, you can manually stop an application as desired.



To stop applications:

- 1 Tap the **Task Manager**  icon to display a list of the applications running on the device.
- 2 Tap the application to be stopped.
- 3 Select **Force Stop**.

To uninstall applications:

- 1 Tap the **Task Manager**  icon to display a list of the applications running on the device.
- 2 Tap the **INDEX** icon .
- 3 Tap **Third Party** or **All** to list more applications.
- 4 Tap the application to be uninstalled.
- 5 Select **Uninstall**.
- 6 Tap **OK** to confirm the uninstall.

YouTube

- 1 Tap the **YouTube** application icon  to view YouTube.com videos.
- 2 Tap a video to launch it.
- 3 Tap the screen to display video controls (adjust volume, pause/play, previous/next, adjust brightness).
- 4 Press the **BACK** button  to return to the **YouTube** screen.

Android

Q: What Android OS version is on my device?

A: 2.2

Basic Device Functionality

Q: Do I have to charge the battery before use?

A: You should charge the battery for at least 4 hours after first removing the device from its shipping container. However, you can use the device while it's charging. Use the included power adapter to charge. This device does not charge via a USB cable.

Email

Q: Can I use any of my personal email addresses to send/receive email?

A: The device supports POP3 and SMTP accounts. Some free email accounts are not supported on mobile devices. Check with your email provider to see if your account is supported.

Media Cards

Q: Which media cards are compatible with my device?

A: MicroSD cards

Music

Q: What type of music files can I play on my device?

A: MP2, MP3, WAV, AAC, WMA

Q: How do I add music files to my device?

A: Connect the tablet to your computer with the USB Cable. Locate the device in "My Computer", then drag & drop your media files to this Removable Storage Device.

Photos

Q: What type of photo files can I view on my device?

A: JPG, JPEG, BMP and PNG.

Q: How do I add photo files to my device?

A: Connect the tablet to your computer with the USB Cable. Locate the device in "My Computer", then drag & drop your media files to this Removable Storage Device.

Video

Q: What type of video files can I play on my device?

A: MPEG1/2/4, MJPG, H263, H264. In addition to H264 which is supported by (720 × 480) resolution, the other video formats are supported (1280 × 720) resolution.

Q: Can I play YouTube videos on my device?

A: Yes. You can tap the YouTube application icon to quick access videos.



Q: How do I add video files to my device?

A: Connect the tablet to your computer with the USB Cable. Locate the device in "My Computer", then drag & drop your media files to this Removable Storage Device.

Wi-Fi

Q: Do I need a Wi-Fi adapter to connect to the Internet?

A: No. The Wi-Fi adapter is built-in to the device.



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
