

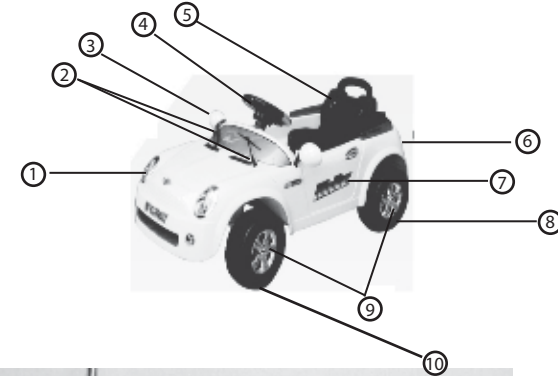

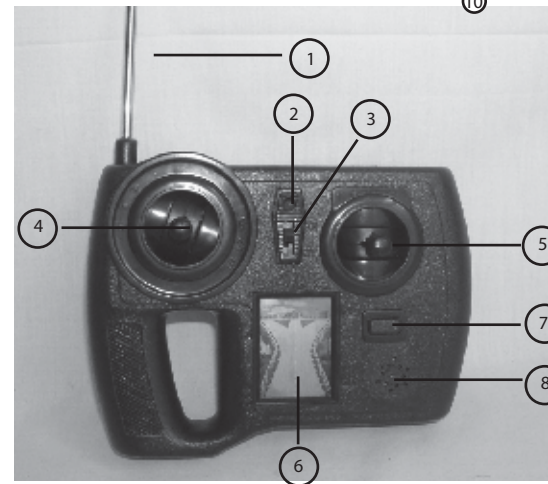

FEATURES & FUNCTIONS

- 1.This car has self-driving function and remote control function.
- 2.Turn on the “POWER SWITCH”, it will be startup sound and flashlight on the back of car, then is engine sound.
- 3.This car can be drive forward/backward, turn left/right.
- 4.There are many function buttons on the steering wheel: ENGLISH / CHINESE, MUSIC, HORN, TURN LEFT, TURN RIGHT.

SAFETY CAUTIONS & MAINTENANCE

- 1.Note that, the car drive on street, road, slop or any danger places is prohibited.
- 2.The kinds of surfaces which are appropriate for safe use of the toy. Flatten surface is the preferred place to drive this car, pls don't drive on sandy or lumpy surface.
- 3.The load capacity is 30 kgs, It limits for one child to ride only.
- 4.Pls don't switch the GO/BACK button when the car is driving. You could change it when it was stopped.
- 5.It must by adult to charge the battery when it is flat of power.
- 6.The car must be assembled by adult and checked it before using. It's necessary to supervised by adult when the child is riding.
- 7.Pls don't wash the car with water, just clean it with dry cloth.
- 8.Only use the chargers specified by the manufacturer.
- 9.Only use the battery specified by the manufacturer

BATTERY INSTALLATION & INFORMATION

1. Require 3 AA batteries.
 - A. Install the battery according to the instruction (anode to anode, cathode to cathode).
 - B. Pls recharge the battery every three months if you don't use it.
 - C. It must recharge the battery if the voltage lower than 5.5VDC.
 - D. Note that, the thum should be tight for the connection.
2. How to charge (As PICTURE 2 show):

METHOD 1: Pls open the seat cushion firstly, the battery can be charged on the car if available.

METHOD 2: The battery also can be charged after been taken out, but should pay attention to:

 - a. Open the seat cushion firstly, then loose the screws and remove the bar on the battery. After that, you can take the battery out.
 - b. The plug on the charger should be insert into the socket on the battery.
 - c. It is natural that the charger and the battery will be warm when charging.
 - d. Note that, the voltage of the charger should be same as the local voltage. Batteries should be installed and replaced only by an adult.

Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.

Do not mix old and new batteries.

Do not use rechargeable batteries.

Remove exhausted batteries from the unit.

Do not short circuit battery terminals.

Remove batteries and store them in a cool, dry place when not in use.

To avoid explosion or leakage, do not dispose of batteries in a fire or attempt to recharge alkaline or other non-rechargeable batteries.

Use only batteries of type and equivalency.

ASSEMBLY METHOD

1. To install the seat cushion:
 - A. As PICTURE 3 show, put the seat cushion on the car body directly, then fasten it.

Fitting parts: Seat cushion 1 set

- B. As PICTURE 4 show, pls fasten the safety belt when driving.

2. To install the review mirrors:
 - As PICTURE 5 show, put the review mirrors on the car body directly, then press it into the socket deeply.

Fitting parts: review mirrors 1 pair

3. To install the steering wheel:
 - A. As PICTURE 6 show put the connected plug on the steering wheel directly into the connected socket on the car body, but should pay attention to the direction.

Fitting parts: steering wheel 1 set

- B. As PICTURE 7 show, install the steering wheel on the direction pole and press it deeply. Then lock it tightly with the screws and nut.

(Required tools: “+” screwdriver)

Fitting parts: 5×35 screw and nut for 1 set.



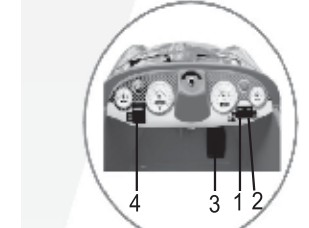

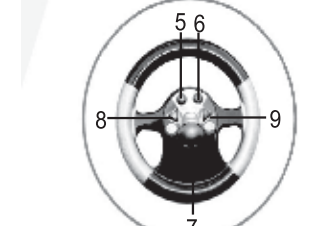

FUNCTIONS INTRODUCTION (As PICTURE 8, 9 show)

1. POWER SWITCH: for turn on/off the car.
2. R/C and FOOT STEP exchange: for exchange remote control function or foot step function.
3. START: for driving car based foot step function.
4. GO/BACK: for exchange driving forward or backward based foot step function.
5. ENGLISH/CHINESE: for exchange the caution sound into ENGLISH or CHINESE.
6. MUSIC: for play IC music.
7. HORN SOUND: for play horn sound.
8. TURN LEFT: for play turning caution.
9. TURN RIGHT: for play turning caution.



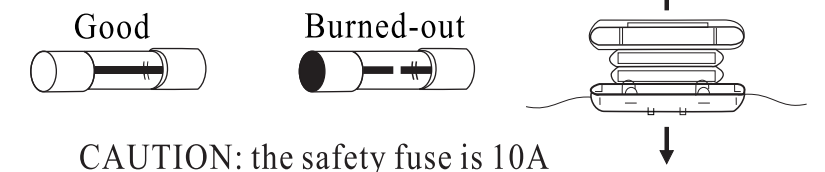

SAFETY FUSE

1. Pls examine whether the fuse have been melt when the car doesn't work or recharge.
2. The fuse set fix under the seat cushion, near with the battery. (on the red line)
