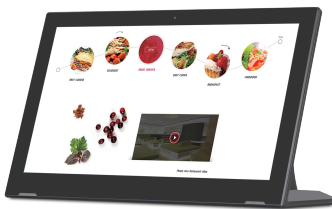
Important Notices

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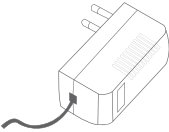
1) Do not push objects into holes and ventilation slots.

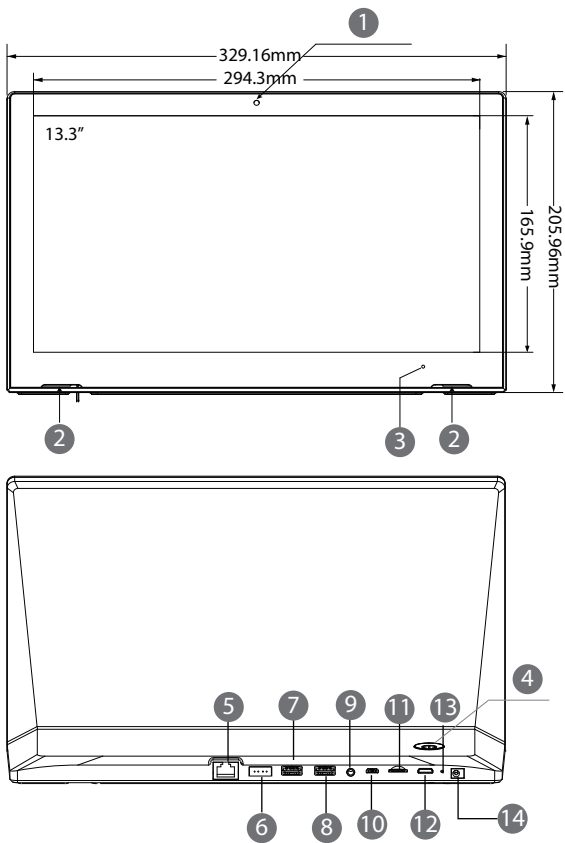
