
Introduction

- Support both Handsfree, Headset & Phone Book profile.


Package content

This package include 3 parts :

1.1 Main unit



2. Cradle with In-Car Charger




3. Sunvisor metal clip



Mounting the Blue Goose at sunvisor

Step I

Clean up the magnet surface.



Step II

1. Attach the metal visor clip at Car sunvisor




Open this clip
and slide into the visor

2. Attach Blue Goose's magnet on the metal visor clip

1. Hang Up
2. Charging indicator
3. Microphone
4. Answer Call
5. Volume Up
6. Volume Down
7. Status Indicator
8. Speaker




■ Bottom view

Reset
When Blue Goose crashed,
press once to power off
the unit. Re-press and
hold for 3 seconds,
Blue Goose powers on again.

Features

- DSP (Digital Signal Processor)
- Echo cancellation
- Phone Book Download (support 1 phone book)
- Text To Speech Technology
- Announce Caller Name
- Support 5 languages
- (English, Spanish, Deutsch, French, Italian)
- Support voice dialing.
- Call Transfer.
- Last Number Redial
- Battery charging indicator.
- Talk time : up to 20 hours
- Standby time : 230 hours.

Pairing procedure

Step 1: Power on Blue Goose by press and hold  for 3 seconds.

Step 2: Press and hold  for 5 seconds to activate pairing.

Red and Blue LED flash alternatively.

TTS announce "From phone's bluetooth Menu search the devices. Then select Blue Goose & enter pin code 0000"

Step 3: Blue Goose is now ready to pair.

Step 4: Activate the phone "SEARCH" for bluetooth device.

Please refer phone user manual how to activate.

Step 5: In "SEARCH", You may find a list of bluetooth device in phone, select Blue Goose

Step 6: Enter generic pass code "0000" to associate "Pair" and connect the Blue Goose.

Step 7: Once you have entered the pass code, your phone is paired for this bluetooth speakerphone.

Step 8: TTS announce " Connected to Phone"

Note : For Nokia, Motorola etc phone connect automatically.

For Some phones (SonyEricsson) etc require user to activate the connection on the phone itself.

Keys and its operation

- Power on
Press and hold  for 3 seconds.
- Power off
Press  for 7 seconds.
- Disconnect
Press  for 2 seconds.
- Connect last paired phone
Press  once (when no other phone connected)
- Answer incoming calls
Press  button.
- Reject and hang up a call
Press  button to reject or hang up.
- Volume up and down
Press  to increase volume
Press  to decrease volume
Volume have 15 levels.
When volume reach 15, TTS announce "Volume Maximum"
- Last Number redial.
Double click  .
- Call waiting
In conversation with 1st call, a new 2nd calls come in.
Press  to activate 2nd call, keep 1st call waiting.
Press  again to switch to 1st call, keep 2nd call

Keys and its operation

- Call transfer

Press and hold  2 seconds to transfer call to Phone.

- Voice dialling (if phone support)

Press  once to activate voice dialling. For those conventional phones, you need to pre-record voice tag for voice dialling. For more details, please refer to phone user manual.

- Call History (phone must get connected)

Press and hold  2 seconds to enter incoming call history.

TTS announce the caller name of last incoming call

Press  and  to navigate to next incoming call.

After you hear the TTS announce, you could press  to dial the caller name just announced.

Maximum calls history : 20

Phone Book Download

1. Once your phone get connected with Blue Goose, phone contacts will be automatically downloaded to Blue Goose.
2. When downloading, TTS announce "Phone book downloading, please wait"
3. TTS announce "please wait" every 30 seconds, during downloading.
4. When download completed, TTS announce " phone book download completed"
5. Duration of download depends on the number of phone contacts & phone brand
For example, Nokia takes about 90 seconds to download 500-600 phone contacts.
6. Blue Goose could support 1 phone book which can store 1000 phone contacts.
7. Each time when the new phone get paired with Blue Goose, all phone contacts will be downloaded.
These new phone contacts will overwrite the previous phone contacts from another phone.

Remark 1 :

If the last connect phone get connected with Blue Goose, its phone book contacts record are still stored inside blue Goose. Blue Goose does not activate Phone book download.

Remark 2 :

Some phones may not support phone download. TTS announce Phone book automatic transfer not support by phone, loading phone book not successful. If phone book is not download, when calls come in, TTS announce telephone number instead of caller name.

Update Phone Book

You could add up new phone book anytimes

1. Once your phone get connected with Blue Goose, press and hold **▲** for 2 seconds to enter SETTING.
2. TTS announces "Update phone book". "Please press green button to confirm & red button to exit".
3. Press **↵** to activate phone book download.
4. During downloadm TTS announce "Please wait" every 30 seconds.
5. When downloaded completed, TTS announce " Updated phone completed"

Language selection

Blue Goose support 5 languages

(English-Spanish-Deutsch-French-Italian)

You could select the language you desire by following procedures:

1. Press and hold **▲** for 2 seconds to enter SETTING.
2. TTS announce "Update phone book", "press green button to confirm & RED button to exit".
3. Press **▲** again to enter language selection. Press **↵** to confirm.
4. Press **▲** once to browse the language you need. Languages are in following sequences:
 - English ■ Spanish ■ Deutsch
 - French ■ Italian
5. Press **↵** once to confirm your selection.
6. TTS announces English Selected if you select English.

Using Guideline

1. When battery is lower, Blue Goose will send BuBu sound every 1 minute.
You need to charge it through the cradle with the car charger or Travel charger 110V 5V/500mA (not included)
When charging, red LED is on. When charging complete, red LED is off.
2. When Blue Goose does not get connected within 15 minutes, Blue Goose powers off automatically for energy saving.
3. Please fully charge the Blue Goose for 3-5 hours before you use it for the 1st time.
