- CHARGE THE SPEAKER

 1. Remove USB Protector Cover.

 2. Attach the small connector of the USB Charging Cable to the Charging Jack (I).

 3. Attach the soft connector of the cable to a computer's USB port.


 4. A red LED light (I) will turn on, indicating speakers are charging.

 5. Remove the USB cable from computer when the red LED light turns off

 6. Cover (I) with water resistant USB Protector Cover

 7. When the battery is low, and alert note can be heard reminding you to recharge the speaker.

Note: It takes approximately 4 hours to fully charge speakers.



PAIRING THE SHOWER SPEAKER

Your device must have BLUETOOTH* capability. Consult your device manufacturer or user manual if you are unsure if your device has this feature.
Turn off any devices that may have been previously paired to the speakers.

- 1. Press and hold (H) to turn the speaker ON. You will hear a voice say, "Waiting for Device."
- 2. Place your device within 3 feet of the speaker (Figure 1).
- 3. Enable BLUETOOTH® on your device and search for new BLUETOOTH® devices. Refer to your device's manual on how to enable and operate BLUETOOTH®.
- 4. Select SHOWER from the list of BLUETOOTH® available devices (Figure 2).
- 5. A voice from the speakers will notify you when the speaker is successfully paired.
- 6. You can now stream music wirelessly from your device to your speaker.
- 7. After the speaker has been and there is not a BLUETOOTH* device paired to it, it will turn off automatically after 15 minutes.

 $Note: If you \ restart \ the \ Speaker, it \ will \ automatically \ pair \ with \ your \ device. \ A \ voice \ will \ notify \ you \ when \ it \ is \ successfully \ paired.$






Before exposing the Shower Speaker to moisture, cover the Speaker's USB port with the USB Protector Cover.

CONTROLS

- A. While playing music- press and hold to decrease volume volume/ Short press to skip to previous track. During a call - Press and hold to decrease volume.
- B. Play and pause audio.
- C. While playing music Press and hold to increase volume / Press once to skip to the next song. During a Call - Press and hold to increase volume.
- D. Turns blue when Bluetooth is active.
- E. Answering a call Press once to answer / Press twice to reject. During a call - Press once to end the call. Redialing - Press twice.
- F. Microphone
- G. Red light turns on while charging.
- H. Press and hold to turn on Shower Speaker / Press and hold to turn off Shower Speaker.
- I. Charging jack
