

# BLUETOOTH VIRTUAL REALITY Headset with Built-in Headphones

Please read all instructions and warnings in this sheet prior to using the Bluetooth Virtual Reality Headset with Built-in Headphones. Keep this instruction sheet as it contains important information for future reference.

## SAFETY WARNINGS: PLEASE READ ALL SAFETY WARNINGS BEFORE USE

- The VR Headset should not be used by children under 12 years of age.
- Adults should monitor children over the age of 12 for the symptoms described below and ensure they take the recommended breaks.
- Use the VR Headset only for its intended purpose.
- Some people may experience seizures or dizziness when experiencing virtual reality. Stop use immediately if you feel any discomfort and consult your doctor if you have any concerns.
- Ease into the use of the VR Headset to allow your body to adjust; use for only a few minutes at a time at first, and only increase the amount of time using the Gear VR gradually as you grow accustomed to virtual reality. Looking around when first entering virtual reality can help you adjust to any small differences between your real world movements and the resulting virtual reality experience.
- Only use the VR Headset in a safe environment and always be aware of your surroundings. The VR Headset produces an immersive virtual reality experience that blocks your view of your actual surroundings.
- Always remain seated when using this product.
- Never wear the VR Headset in situations that require attention, such as walking, bicycling, or driving.
- Take frequent breaks when using the VR Headset (at least a 15 minute break every 30 minutes is recommended).
- Never use the VR Headset while in a moving vehicle as this may increase any susceptibility to adverse symptoms.
- Do not handle sharp or otherwise dangerous objects while using the Smartphone 360° Virtual Reality Headset.
- Make sure the VR Headset is level and secured comfortably on your head, and that you see a single, clear image.
- Do not modify or service the VR Headset. The VR Headset has no serviceable parts.
- The VR Headset is not a protective case for your phone. Avoid dropping, hitting, or sitting on headset.
- Inspect the product before every use. If the product appears worn, frayed, cracked, or broken in any manner, discontinue use and discard immediately.

- Requires download and installation of Google Cardboard-compatible app.
- Remove phone case before inserting into VR Headset.


## CARE & MAINTENANCE

- Spot clean only with damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals.
- Store in cool dry area.
- Avoid temperatures below 0°C / 32°F or above 45°C / 113°F.
- Ensure that the strap is kept clean.
- Ensure that the lenses are not scratched and keep them clean for clear visibility.

## CHARGING

1. Insert the Micro USB end of the charging cable into the charging port (D).
2. Connect the other end to a USB port or a standard 5v USB adaptor.
3. The Charging Indicator LED will turn red while charging.
4. When charging is completed, the LED will turn green and the cable may be disconnected.

## CONTROLS & INPUT

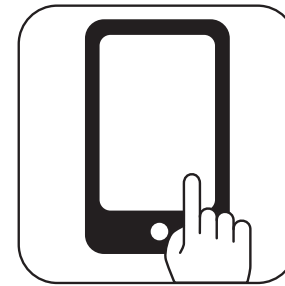
- 
- A. Power On/Off
  - B. Bluetooth Status Light
  - C. Volume/Play/Pause
    - Press to play/pause audio
    - Press once to answer call/end phone call
    - Press twice to reject phone call
    - Press front end to skip song
    - Press rear end to skip to previous song
    - Press and hold front end to increase volume
    - Press and hold rear end to decrease volume
  - D. Charging Port (Micro USB)
  - E. Charging Indicator LED (inside Port)
  - F. Microphone Port

## PAIRING

The Headset must be paired with your phone before operating.

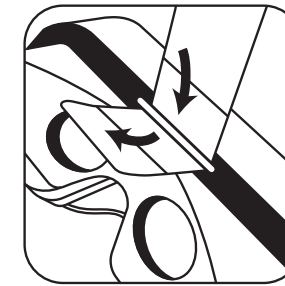
1. Make sure that Bluetooth® is enabled on your phone.
2. Turn the Headphones on by sliding Switch (A) to the on position. The Headphones will alert that they are "Waiting for Device"
3. On your phone, select "BT-VR HEADSET" from the list of available Bluetooth devices.
4. The Headphones will state "Paired" when they connect. The Bluetooth Status Light (B) will slowly flash blue.

## SET UP:



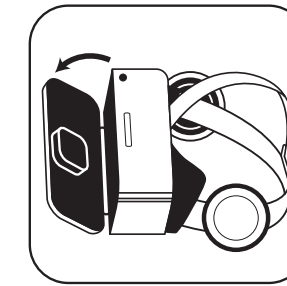
Download or open your favorite VR App or Video\*.

**Note: Please remove your phone case before inserting your phone into the VR Headset.**



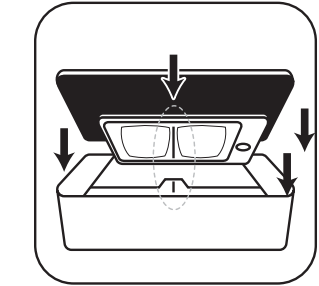
Insert top strap through the top of the VR Headset then through the Side Strap's buckle. Adjust with the hook-and-loop.

Note: Top strap can be removed completely for handheld viewing.



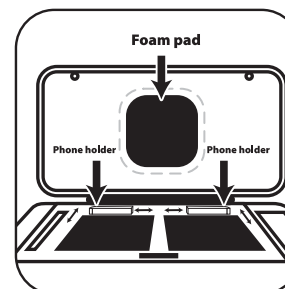
Open the front part of the VR Headset.

Ensure the center line on screen is aligned with center line on viewer



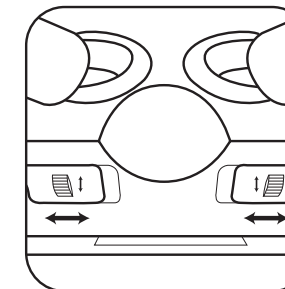
Place your phone flat onto the lens portion of the VR Headset compartment and close the compartment. **Make sure your phone's split screen line matches up with the line found inside of the VR Headset.**

**Note: If your viewing experience is blurry please make sure the phone is properly aligned with the center line.**

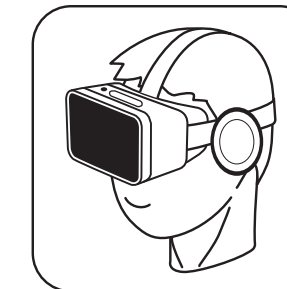


Phone holder can be adjusted from up and down, from left to right to make sure the phone screen fits in the viewer and touch the conductive rubber pad well.

Foam pad included on the door ensures the phone fits well when closed.



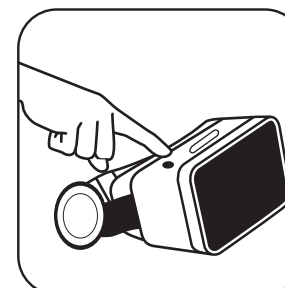
Before putting on your Headset, use the adjustments on the bottom so that you see a single, clear image.



Using the adjustable straps, secure the VR Headset to your head.

Note: For optimal performance the phone should not move inside of headset.

## USING YOUR HEADSET:



Press the top button on the VR Headset to select objects in your app or video (not supported by every app or video). Certain screen protectors may interfere with the top button function.



Move around to explore apps and videos (not supported by every app or video).
