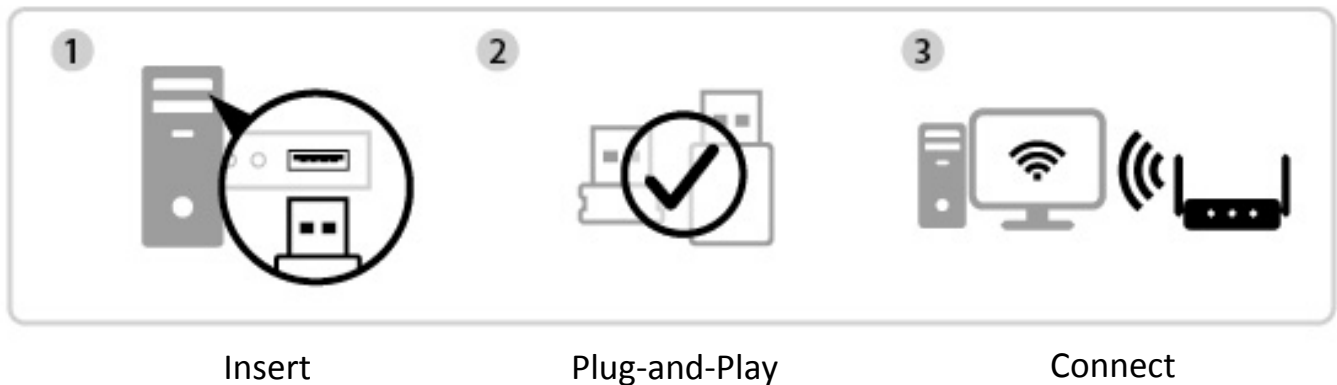

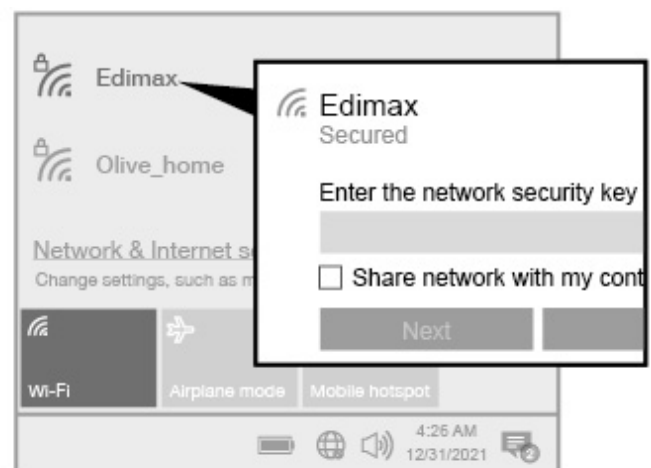

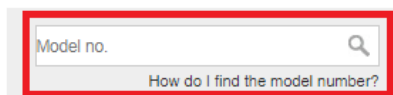

1. Download the driver from web page at www.edimax.com/download/. Please search the model name to enter the according page.

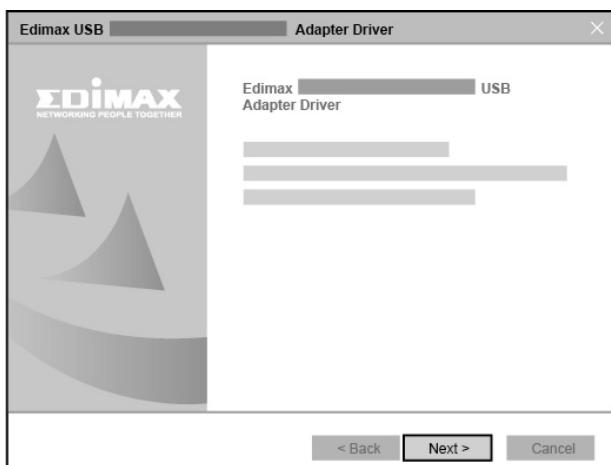

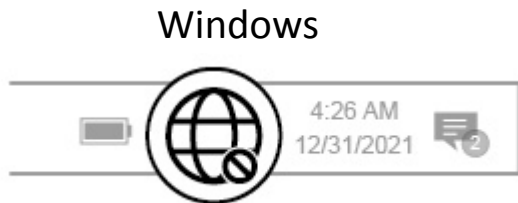

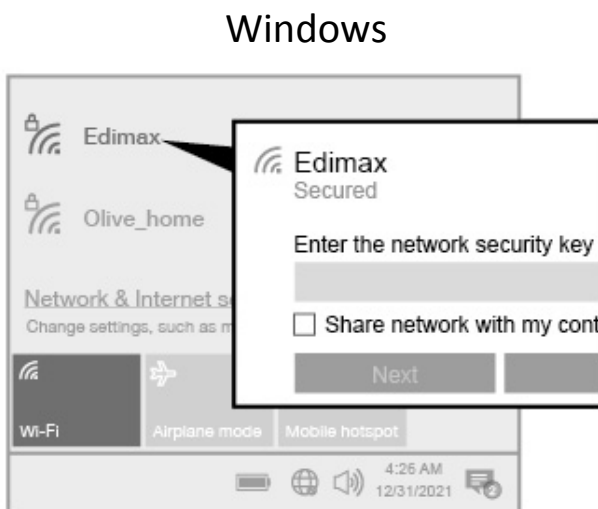


II-3. Select & Connect Wi-Fi Network




