



TRANSMITTER

- INSTALL ONE 9 VOLT BATTERY.
- MAKE SURE THE POLARITY (+) (-) SIGNS MATCH THE MARKINGS ON THE BATTERY COMPARTMENT.
- SLIDE THE BATTERY COVER BACK IN PLACE.



HOW TO OPERATE:


- 1. Turn **ON/OFF** switches on bottom of car and the transmitter.
- 2. Extend transmitter antenna to full length when in use.
- 3. **FORWARD DRIVE**: Push left joystick to position 3 to move forward. Joystick will automatically return to Neutral position when released.

4. **REVERSE DRIVE:** Move left joystick to position 4 to move in reverse. Joystick will automatically return to Neutral position when released.

5. **LEFT/RIGHT STEERING:** Move right joystick left or right for desired direction while operating Forward/Reverse function.









SCREW THE ANTENNA ON THE CAVITY OF THE TRANSMITTER.

WHEEL ALIGNMENT




IMPORTANT NOTICE:








- 1. Do not mix old and new batteries.

- 15. Don't leave your car and transmitter outside overnight. Night dampness will cause harm.
- 16. Don't forget to remove batteries from your car and transmitter if you are not going to operate the car again that day.
- 17. If malfunction occurs, replace batteries.
