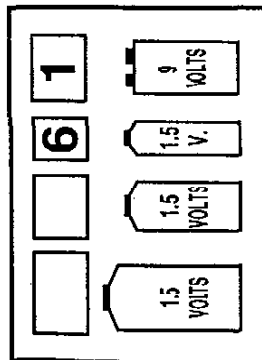

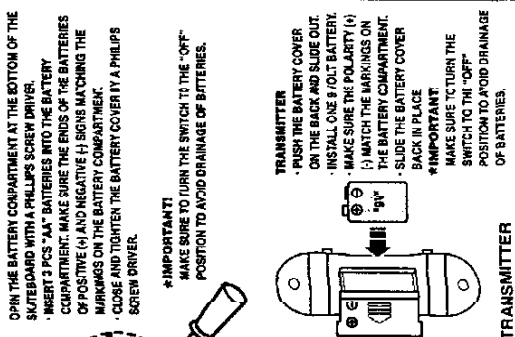
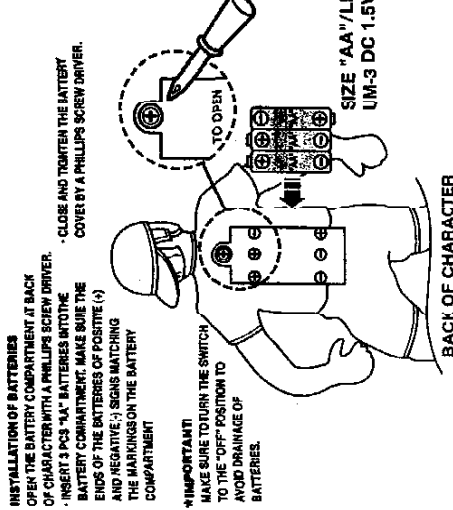

NOTICE:

- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (Carbon zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- Rechargeable batteries not recommended.
- Batteries should be replaced by adults because of small parts.
- Batteries are to be inserted with correct polarity.
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
- Don't operate your car in dangerous places.

- Don't put your car and transmitter near any source of HEAT.
- Don't run through water, including pools or puddles.
