

1.Introduction

This manual will help you operate the Bluetooth Wireless Speaker, but you should first familiarize yourself with the Bluetooth functionality of your mobile phone or other devices before using the Bluetooth Wireless Speaker.



4. How to use

4.1.General Functions

	Desired Result	Required Action
	Turn on & Enter the pairing mode	Switch the On/Off button at the back.
	Pairing	You should use a mobile phone with Bluetooth fuction or other Bluetooth Master Device to perform pairing action. (detail refer to the chapter about pairing)
	Play / pause	Press ▶II/M to play/answer a call when the device is pausing and press ▶II/M to pause/hang up a call when the device is playing. Press and hold to switch between Bluetooth and AUX.
	Next	Press ▶I for next music.
	Previous	Press I◀ for previous music.
	Volume up	Long press the VOL+ for volume up .
	Volume down	Long press the VOL — for volume down .
	Charging	Plug the charger to micro-USB port at the back of the device. (Red LED is on)
	Light up effect change	Press * to change the light up effects.

4.2. Pairing to Mobile phone or other device

To use your Bluetooth speaker, you must first pair your speaker with a phone or a computer. Once your Bluetooth speaker is paired to a specific mobile phone, they will remain paired and automatically recognize each other whenever they are within range

Pairing to a phone and Entertainment:

- Turn on your phone and ensure its Bluetooth function is activated
- Turn on the speaker go to the pairing mode.
- Search your Bluetooth device on your phone by following the phone's instructions.

 Refer to your phone's user manual for more
- After a few second the phone will list. the "BT-BLAZE" as a discoved device.
 Select it and follow your phone instruction to select this pairing.
- · Your phone will confirm the pairing, and then press Yes/Ok.
- Finally, select to connect with "BT-BLAZE" from your phone.
- You can play music; watch TV/movies and play games with your phone, then you can hear all the sounds or music from the speaker. You can also control the player by operating the speaker. Example, volume up and next music.

Pairing to a computer and Entertainment:

- If there is no Bluetooth function supported by your computer, a Bluetooth adapter is necessary. Fix the adapter with your computer and ensure its Bluetooth function is activated
- · Turn on the speaker to get into the pairing
- · Open the Bluetooth software (such as BlueSoleil) installed on your computer, and select "Search your Bluetooth devices" function. Refer to user manual of the Bluetooth software for more information.
- · After a few second the "BT-BLAZE" will list in Bluetooth software of your computer as a discover device. Select this icon and click the right button of mouse to select "pairing" item, then select "connect with audio device" with same operation.
- · Open your media player software to play music, watch TV/movies and play games, then all the sounds will be playbacked on vour speaker.

4.3. Charging your speaker

The speaker is convenient to connect to USB charger via Micro-USB port. Make sure that your speaker is fully charged for at least 6 hours before initial use. Insert one terminal of your charger to USB port of PC and other terminal to Micro-USB iack. While charging, the red LED light constantly on. When charging is completed, the LED turns off.



Warning:

- You must select a qualified charger from a regular manufacturer.
- You must charge the Bluetooth speaker if it has been not used for more than 12 months

6.FAQ

- 1. Why is there no power even when the Speaker is on?
- Ans: Ensure the battery is being charged up to 6 hours for first time using. The LED is lighted when it starts charging.
- 2. There is no sound when playback. Ans: Check the connection between speaker and phone or computer, if the connection is not established, please reconnect again. Make sure the speaker is paired and connected with your target phone or other master device.
