Bluetooth Connection:

1. Turn on the unit and a message "Bluetooth MODE" will be heard.
2. Search and pair your Cellphone/Computer/Other Bluetooth devices to this Bluetooth speaker "BT-IRIS"
3. Decrease or increase the volume to your desired level by simultaneously pressing the button -V / I ◀◀ or ▶▶ I / V+.
4. ▶ II: Play or pause current track.
5. Press -V / I ◀◀ to previous track or ▶▶ I / V+ to next track.

Phone Call Hands Free:

1. Please make sure your device is well paired to the speaker. (Distance between your device and BT-IRIS < 10M)
2. Answer or Hang up the call by pressing ▶ II.
3. Keep distance < 30CM between your device and the speaker for better using.

Play Music from USB/Micro SD Card:

1. Plug in your USB disk or Micro SD card in the appropriate slots provided on the unit.
2. Turn on the power; the LED indicator will come on.
3. Decrease or increase the volume to your desired level by simultaneously pressing -V / I ◀◀ or ▶▶ I / V+.
4. Press ▶ II: Play or pause current track.
5. Press -V / I ◀◀ to previous track or ▶▶ I / V+ to next track.
6. Press "M/LED" for media switching."

FM Radio Scanning:

1. Switch the MODE to FM Radio activation and status.
2. Simultaneously Press ▶ II for auto scanning from 87.5-108MHz.
3. Press -V / I ◀◀ or ▶▶ I / V+ to access the preset stations up or down.

LED Disco Light Control:

Simultaneously press "M/LED" for turn ON/OFF the LED disco light.

AUX: Use the attached cable to connect the unit with the external device.
