1.Introduction

Congratulations, and thank you for choosing the Bluetooth Wireless Speaker. This manual will help you operate the Bluetooth Wireless Speaker, but you should first familiarize yourself with the Bluetooth functionality of your mobile phone or other devices before using the Bluetooth Wireless Speaker.

4.How to use

4.1.General Functions

Desired Result	Required Action
Turn on & Enter the pairing mode	Switch the On/Off button on the top.
Pairing	You should use a mobile phone with Bluetooth function or other Bluetooth Master Device to perform pairing action. (detail refer to the chapter about pairing)
Play / pause	Press ▶▶ to play when the device is paused and press ⏸ to pause when the device is playing.
Next	Press ▶▶▶ for next track.
Previous	Press ◀◀◀ to go to previous track.
Volume up	Long press the ▶▶ for volume up .
Volume down	Long press the ◀◀ for volume down .
Charging	Plug the charger into micro-USB port on the back of the device. (Red LED is on)

4.2.Pairing to Mobile phone or other device

To use your Bluetooth speaker, you must first pair your speaker with a phone or a computer. Once your Bluetooth speaker is paired to a specific mobile phone, they will remain paired and automatically recognize each other whenever they are within range.

Pairing to a phone and Entertainment:

- Turn on your phone and ensure its Bluetooth function is activated
- Turn on the speaker for pairing mode.
- Search your Bluetooth device on your phone by following the phone's instructions. Refer to your phone's user manual for more information.
- After a few seconds the phone will list the "IHIPBTWRSPKR" as a discovered device. Select it and follow your phone instructions to select this pairing.
- Your phone will confirm the pairing, and then press Yes/Ok.
- Finally, select to connect with "IHIPBTWRSPKR" from your phone.
- You can play music; watch TV/movies and play games with your phone, then you can hear all the sounds or music from the speaker. You can also control the player by operating the speaker. Example, volume up and next music.

4.3.Charging your speaker

The speaker is convenient to connect to USB charger via Micro-USB port. Make sure that your speaker is fully charged for at least 6 hours before initial use. Insert one terminal of your charger to USB port of PC and other terminal to Micro-USB jack. While charging, the red LED light constantly on. When charging is completed, the LED light turns off.

Warning:

- You must select a qualified charger from a regular manufacturer.
- You must charge the Bluetooth speaker if it has been not used for more than 12 months.

6.FAQ

- Why is there no power when the Speaker is on?
Ans: Ensure the battery has been charged for 6 hours before using the first time. The LED light turns on when the Speaker starts charging.
- There is no sound when playback is on.
Ans: Check the connection between speaker and phone or computer, if the connection is not established, please reconnect again. Make sure the speaker is paired and connected with your target phone or other master device.

7.FCC Statement
