





Insert the pin from the supplied AC/DC Adapter to Adapter DC port on the rear of the unit. Plug the AC/DC adaptor to a wall power outlet (AC 100-240V 50/60Hz).

Batteries Installation

In first time use, remove the insulation tab from the battery compartment of the Remote Control.



Remote Control includes the battery (1 CR2025 Lithium battery); when battery is drained, replace

- battery as below:

 1. Pull the battery tray out of the battery compartment of Remote Control.

 2. Place new CR2025 button cell battery in the tray slot, as per the indicated polarity.

 3. Close the battery tray.



Effective Distance of Remote Transmitter

- When there is an obstacle between the speaker & the remote control, the transmitter may
- operate.
 When there is direct sunlight or an incandescent lamp, fluorescent lamp or any other strong light hits the Remote Control Sensor of the unit, the remote operation may not work well.

- Turn On/Off the Speaker
 To Turn "ON" slide the "POWER ON/OFF" switch to the ON Position.
 To Turn "OFF" slide the "POWER ON/OFF" switch to the OFF Position.

- Pairing your device with Bluetooth Speaker –

 The pairing name of our Bluetooth Speaker is "SL MINI TOWER", pair it with this device.
- 6. Select it from the list of Searched Devices.

- If required, enter the password '0000' to confirm to finalize pairing.
- 8. Once paired successfully, the Blue LED will stay ON.
 9. If you fail to pair it within the time frame or you want to pair it with a new device, please repeat the steps outlined above.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Low sound level	Source (Tablet, Mobile Phone, Laptop, etc.) volume too low.	Adjust source volume.
