

Before starting, your toy requires (1) 9 volt battery, (4) "AA" alkaline batteries and a Phillips screwdriver (not included) for assembly.


How to install the Batteries

Remote Control




- A. Unscrew the battery cover on the back of the Remote Control, using a Phillips screwdriver and remove.
- B. Insert (1) 9 volt alkaline battery into the battery compartment carefully noting the direction of the (+) and (-) symbols as shown.
- C. Replace the cover and tighten the screw.

Step(2) **Dump Truck**



- A. Take Dump Truck and turn it upside down.
- B. Unscrew the battery cover on the bottom and remove.
- C. Insert 4 "AA" size alkaline type batteries into the battery compartment as shown, carefully noting the direction of the (+) and (-) symbols.
- D. Replace the cover and tighten the screw.

How the Vehicle works How to turn the vehicle ON




A. To turn Dump Truck "ON". push in the Button on the front hood of the vehicle as shown.

Note: This button is not an "ON-OFF" switch. The vehicle will automatically turn itself off after 3 minutes of not being used.

Step(4) How the Remote Control Works

Pressing the top arrow will make the vehicle go forward. Pressing the bottom arrow will make the vehicle go in reverse.


When you press this button a car horn will sound. Note: The remote control has no ON-OFF switch but instead has a sleep mode which turns itself ON automatically when you start playing with the buttons.



Step(5) How to snap the track together

- A. The track pieces snap together easily by holding an end with Slots over an end with Locking Tabs.
- B. Carefully line up both ends as shown and push the track with the Slots down firmly until they lock together.

Note: Always assemble your track on a hard, flat surface.



Step 6 Assemble the entire track layout as shown below

Assemble all the track, as shown at right. being very careful to match the correct Letters that are engraved on the ends of each track section.

For example: Attach A to A end and the B to B end; etc, of the various tracks.


Note. Assemble the accessory pieces to the track layout after you assemble the entire layout.





HOW TO ASSEMBLE ACCESSORIES

Step (7) Accessories

- A. The Construction Set comes with special signs that are "keyed."
- B. Insert the signs in their stands. Because they are keyed, they can only be inserted in one direction.
- C. The signs will snap into place when inserted correctly.
