


Friends Talk and Share

Power/Volume Switch



Hint: If your child does not actively play with this toy for a few minutes, it turns off automatically (sleep mode) and the ready light turns off. Press the "radio" button to restart.



Battery Replacement



For best results, we recommend replacing the batteries that came with this toy with four, new "AA" (LR6) alkaline batteries.

- Locate the battery compartment on the bottom of the toy.
- Loosen the screws in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver.
 Remove the battery compartment door.
 Throw the exhausted batteries away.
- Insert four "AA" (LR6) alkaline batteries. **Hint:** We recommend using **alkaline** batteries for longer battery life.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screws with a Phillips screwdriver.
 Do not over-tighten.
- When sounds or lights from this toy become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries!



Battery Safety Information

Batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your toy. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
