

- Requires three "AA" (LR6) **alkaline** batteries (not included) for electronic toy operation.

- who is not able to climb out
- who weighs less than 25 lbs. (11.3 kg) and is less than 32 inches (81 cm) in height.







Hint: You may want to install batteries in the electronic toy before beginning assembly. Please refer to the Battery Installation section.

Assembly

IMPORTANT! Before assembly and each use, inspect this product for damaged hardware, loose joints, missing parts or sharp edges. DO NOT use if any parts are missing or broken. Contact Fisher-Price® for replacement parts and instructions if needed. Never substitute parts.




• Insert and "snap" the whale toy, spinning disc, electronic toy, spinning ball and hippo toy into the slots on the seat ring.




- Place the bases on a flat surface.
- While pressing the button on the short tube of a base, insert it into the long tube on another base. Continue to slide the short tube into the long tube until you hear a "click".
- Repeat this procedure to assemble the remaining base to the base assembly.

Hint: The final base assembly of this product is a circle.

Assembly



- Position the seat so that the inside (ribbed side) is up and the star marking \Re is toward you.
- Lay the pad under the seat with the monkey head facing down, as shown.
- Locate the button holes in the tab edge of the pad. Fit the pad button holes onto the seat pegs on either side of the star marking ⅔.




• Pull the pad through the seat. Wrap the edges of the pad around the outside of the seat.




• Fit the other six button holes in the seat pad onto the corresponding pegs on the seat.

Assembly




- While pressing the button on a frame tube, insert it into a base tube. Continue to slide the frame tube into the base tube until you hear a "click". Pull up on the frame tube to be sure it is secure.
- Repeat this procedure to assemble the two remaining frame tubes to the base tubes.



• Insert and "snap" the seat with pad into the seat ring. Pull up on the seat to be sure it is secure.

Battery Installation

Hint: We recommend using **alkaline** batteries for longer battery life.





 Protect the environment by not disposing of this product with household waste (2002/96/EC). Check your local authority for recycling advice and facilities (Europe only).



- Loosen the screws in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver and remove the battery compartment door.
- Insert three "AA" (LR6) **alkaline** batteries into the battery compartment.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screws.
- If this product begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Slide the power/volume switch off and then back on.
- When sounds or lights become faint or do not work at all, it's time for an adult to replace batteries.

Battery Safety Information

In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:





Seat Height Adjustment




 Place your child in the seat. Check the distance between your baby's feet and the floor. Your child's toes should touch the floor (without bouncing). If your child's entire foot is touching the floor or the toes are not touching the floor at all, adjust the height to any of three positions (one for the smallest child and three for the tallest child).


Seat Height Adjustment




- Remove your child from the seat.
- Lift the seat ring so the bottom faces you.
- Locate the strap bar and pull it open.



• Pull the strap to the desired height **123**.



• Fit the strap bar into the desired slot in the strap.




- Push to "snap" and fasten the strap bar.
- Repeat this process to attach the other two straps to the seat ring.

 $\ensuremath{\mathsf{IMPORTANT!}}$ Make sure $\ensuremath{\mathsf{all}}$ three straps are adjusted to the same height.


Mode Select Button

Power/Volume Switch

- Slide the power/volume switch to:
 - On with low volume
 -))) On with high volume
 - O Off
- Press the mode select switch for short play; press again for long play.
- Short Play Baby's jumping activates lights and music. Press the alligator or roll the spinning toy for lights and fun sounds.
- Long Play Mom can choose this mode to play up to 20 minutes of continuous music. After 20 minutes, the mode switches back to short play. Press the mode button to return to long play mode again.

Care

- The seat pad is machine washable. Wash it separately in cold water on the gentle cycle. Do not use bleach. Tumble dry separately on low heat and remove promptly.
- The frame, seat, seat ring, straps and toys may be wiped clean using a mild cleaning solution and damp cloth. Do not use bleach. Do not use harsh or abrasive cleaners. Rinse clean with water to remove soap residue. Do not immerse the electronic toy.



Remove the Seat and Pad

• Lift the seat ring. While pressing near any notch on the seat, pull the seat from the seat ring. Turn the seat over. Remove the pad slots from the pegs on the seat. Remove the pad.
