
Step 5 Fit Backs to Unit

Step 6 Secure Top to Unit






Use the Small shelf to test for squareness before securing the Backs to the Unit in Step 9.

Step 8 Secure Backs to Partition







Step 9 Fit Shelf supports & Shelves










Step 11 Fit Doors to Unit




Ensure the Bump ons are in line with the Shelves and Base when the Doors are closed. Refer to Door attachment & adjustment overleaf.


- Position the Door Hinge onto the Hinge Mount.




• <u>NOTE:</u> Before each adjustment step, please ensure that you open and close each Door to check for any obstructions between the Door and vertical panels of the Unit.



Lateral adjustment Side to side


The adjustment is made turning the screw on the hinge arm.






Horizontal adjustment In & Out


This is done by turning the adjustment screw

The adjustment requires that the mounting screws be loosened, the door moved and the screws re-tightened.



Surface Care Instructions

A little care and attention will extend the life and good looks of your furniture. Take care when using materials which might spill or sharp or abrasive objects which could damage the surface of your furniture.

Normal Cleaning

For normal dusting use a soft, dry, clean cloth.

Glass Cleaning For Frosted Glass

Do not use glass cleaner or solvent based cleaners on the surface of the glass that has the frosting effect.

Spills and Soiling

Most spills and soiling maybe removed with a non-abrasive multi surface household cleaner. Apply a small amount onto the surface then remove with a soft, clean cloth.

NB: It is recommended that your multi-surface cleaner is first tested on an unseen patch prior to cleaning.

Marks, Scratches and Surface damages

As with all furniture, these can never be properly repaired.

CAUTION

Under no circumstances must any form of abrasive be used as this will damage the surface.

Do not use solvents, solvent based cleaners, scouring pads, steel wool, furniture wax or scrubbing brushes.

As with all indoor furniture, this unit should not be exposed to direct sunlight, extreme temperatures or moisture, as this can result in serious irreparable damage.

NB: The sooner a stain or spill is cleaned, the easier it will be to remove.
