




3 Loading the Cassette



Open the paper cassette slow




The remaining paper criteria is displayed in the remaining paper window. When the printer runs out of paper, the remaining paper window will turn red. When this occurs, insert a new paper cartridge into the cassette.




While matching the positioning marks (gray) on the cassette and cartridge, insert the cartridge into the cassette, and gently close the cassette cover.

Reading the Index and Using the Direction Keys




① Displays the total number of pages and the number of the current page of the INDEX screen.

② Displays the number of images to be printed.




When the right direction key is pressed, the images are selected in (A)→(B)→(C)→(D) order. When the left direction key is pressed, the images are selected in the opposite order.


When the down key is pressed at the first page and the up key is pressed at the first page, the first and last pages are selected respectively.



The print mark is displayed on the images. The print mark can be displayed on up to 20 images by repeating this.



After the print mark is displayed, press the PRINT button.




Printing starts and the image being printed appears on the monitor screen.







1 Connecting the Printer

Printer uses normal type (B-20) or larger type (B-10S2, B-10S4, B-10S6) paper. The cartridge is vulnerable to direct sunlight and high temperature and humidity. Do not store it outside its protective package. Do not attempt to insert or remove paper into or from the cartridge. It will cause the paper to jam. Use unpacked cartridges as quickly as possible. The use of a cartridge that has exceeded its valid period may cause a drop in printing quality.




2 Inserting the Cartridge

- Connect the video output terminal (VIDEO-OUT) on the back of the printer to the video input terminal (VIDEO-IN) of the monitor using the accessory video cable (pin plug). *For information regarding the video input terminal (VIDEO-IN), refer to the manual that comes with the monitor.
- Insert the connector at one end of the power cable into the power socket on the back of the printer and plug the power plug at the other end of the power cable into a power outlet.

Remove the cartridge from the arrow package and peel off the grip. *The protective package of the cartridge is used to sit the cartridge. Do not throw it away.

*Do not get the acrylic window at the back of the cartridge or the code label on the front of the cartridge dirty. If the window or label gets dirty, images may not be printed at optimum sharpness.






Paying attention to the direction of the cassette, insert the cassette into the cassette slot.
If the printer will not be used for a long time, remove the cassette and store the cartridge in the protective package.



Turn on the monitor power and switch the printer to the connected monitor input mode.
* For information on monitor switching, refer to the manual that comes with the monitor.




Press the power button to turn on the power. When the power comes on, the message "Insert" appears on the monitor screen. Pressing the power button again turns off the power.
* When the power comes on, the printer enters the 1-FRAME print mode.



When SmartMedia is loaded, an image index is displayed on the monitor screen. The image photographed last is indicated by the cursor.

* If "WARNING" is displayed on the screen, remove and reload the SmartMedia.




When removing the SmartMedia, always grasp the SmartMedia out while pushing in the hood. ① While pushing in the hood, ② do not remove the SmartMedia.





■ Condensation




1 Previewing the Image to be Printed

* When the PRINT button was pressed, printing is performed in the set printing mode.

* The INDEX screen can be displayed at any time by pressing the PREVIEW button again.


* When the printing mode was switched, the display is automatically switched to the INDEX screen.



* In the 1-FRAME mode, the image indicated by the cursor is displayed and can be switched using the left and right direction keys.



* In the ALL FRAMES mode, one image is displayed over the entire screen and the images are sequentially displayed automatically.



* In the MULTI mode, the images are separated and displayed. Only individual images are sequentially displayed automatically.

The image to be printed (PREVIEW screen) can be viewed by pressing the PREVIEW button. The image can be printed by pressing the PRINT button while the PREVIEW screen is being displayed.

COPIES * Sets the number of prints made of the same image.

* When the printing mode is switched, the number of prints is set to one even if two or more sets. In the ALL FRAMES mode, the number of prints cannot be set.

DISPLAY SWITCHER • FILENAME : Selects DISPLAY or NO DISPLAY in the DISPLAY SWITCHER mode on the screen.
• INDEX : To display the index display from the first page, select BEGINNING, and to display display from the last page, select END.
• PREVIEW : To enable characters display on the PREVIEW screen, select CHARACTER; disable characters display, select NO CHARACTERS.

Menus common to 1-FRAME and ALL FRAMES modes

DATE PRINT Selects PRINT or NO PRINT in the DATE PRINT mode.

- The date is printed on the print in orange.
- If the image does not have any date data, the date is not printed. (Only a period is printed.)

SIZE

Selects the printing range.
• LARGE : Entire print area (The image is cut.)
• NORMAL : Entire image area (The white space on the printing surface increases.)

ALL FRAMES mode menu

PRINT SELECTION To print everything, select ALL FRAMES and to print protected frames only, select PROTECT.
* "Protect" is a function that can be selected with a digital camera.

MULTI mode menu

MULTI SAME : Uses the same image when printing separate prints.
RANDOM : Arbitrary images can be specified when printing separate prints.
INDEX : Outputs all the images in the SmartMedia on a 16-frame index print.

SEPARATE

PAPER 2-frame, 4-frame, or 16-frame can be selected only in the SAME or RANDOM.

Menu items selected only from the 1-FRAME and RANDOM MULTI modes

RESERVATION Selects DISPLAY or NO DISPLAY in the RESERVATION mode.
Checks which screens were selected and registers and cancels printing reservation. This random multi technique that is used only with the RESERVATION screen. (Refer to the pertinent section.)

Menu items selected only from the PREVIEW screen

SHARPNESS ADJUSTMENT When the SET button is pressed, the menu is switched.
• AUTOMATIC : Sharpness is optimally compensated according to the photographed scene.
For instance, for backlit scenes, the subject is often dark. This function compensates so the subject is beautifully printed.

- OTHER : Brightness and contrast can be adjusted without regard to automatic adjustment.

ZOOM

When the SET button is pressed, the printer is switched to the ZOOM mode. This can be executed in the 1-FRAME mode.
• SIZE (NORMAL) : The image can be magnified 1.0, 1.5, or 2.0 times. After magnification, can be trimmed using the direction keys.


When the PRINT button is pressed, the trimmed image displayed on the screen is printed.
At the end of printing, zooming is canceled and the INDEX screen is displayed.
* To cancel the ZOOM mode, open the menu again and press the SET button



Basic operation in the MENU uses the up and down direction keys to select the item and the left and right direction keys to change the setting.
Setting in the MENU is ended by pressing the MENU button again.




When the MENU button is pressed, a menu is displayed, and various printing settings can be selected. (The menus are described in the table at the right.)
* Only the setting items matched to the menu screen displayed are displayed.

* When all the images have been displayed, the automatic display (slide show) function returns to the INDEX display. Images can be printed even during slide display by pressing the PRINT button.


* When the CANCEL button is pressed when the PREVIEW screen is displayed, the display is returned to the initial display when the SmartMedia was loaded.

Display the menu and select **CLEANING** and press the **SET** button.
 * CLEANING cannot be selected from the **PREVIEW** and **RESERVATION** screens.



When the **SET** button is pressed at this screen, cleaning begins.
