



FM TRANSMITTER USER'S MANUAL

OPERATION MANUAL





FEATURES

- 1 FM transmitter.
- 2 Charges your device via USB port
- 3 Supports 3.5mm jack port
- 4 Flash drive port
- 5 LCD display screen

SPECIFICATIONS

- 1 Input voltage:12-24V, output power: 5V DC/2.1A
- 2 Supports MP3 and WMA format files

FM TRANSMITTER FUNCTION

- 1 Plug the FM transmitter into your vehicle's cigarette lighter
- 2 Connect your device to your FM transmitter using the supplied 3.5 mm jack.
- 3 Tune your radio to an unused FM station, then match the same frequency on your FM transmitter unit. To change frequency press the "CH" button on the side of your FM transmitter, then press the "▶▶ı" button to increase frequency, or "◄◄" to decrease frequency. The FM transmitter will play music through your car stereo.

Note: You can play music while charging your mobile phone.

CAR CHARGER FUNCTION

Connect your device into the USB power port of your FM transmitter via your charging cable.

2 For Ipad Users:

Insert the charging cable to the USB port before you connect the charger into cigarette lighter, then insert your FM transmitter to the cigarette lighter.

FCC NOTE:

QUICK GUIDE

FUNCTION ON FM TRANSMITTER

PLAY/STOP Press "PLAY" button : play the music

Press "PLAY" button a second time: stop the music

ADJUST THE Hold down "▶▶" button: increase the Volume VOLUME Hold down "I◄◄" button: decrease the Volume

CHANGE Press "CH" first, then press "▶▶I" button: increase the frequency

FREQUENCY Press "CH" first, then press "I◄◄" button: decrease the frequency

CHOOSE MUSIC Press "▶►I" button: play the next song;

Press " I◄◄ " button: play the previous song;

CHANGE PLAY Hold down "play/pause" button to switch the play modes:

MODE All, Folder, Random and One
