## **Using the Main Menu**



- 1 Touch to find a destination.
- 2 Touch to view the map.
- Touch to make a call when connected to a compatible mobile phone. See www.garmin.com/bluetooth for more information.
- 4 Touch to adjust the volume.
- Touch to use tools such as settings, help, and weather.











- GPS signal status. Touch and hold to view satellite information.
- Bluetooth® technology status. Touch to change Bluetooth settings.
- 3 Usage mode indicator. Touch to select a usage mode.
- 4 Current time. Touch to change time settings.
- (5) Current temperature. Touch to view weather information.
- 6 nüLink! services signal status.
- 7 Battery status.

## **Setting Up Your Device**

When using the device for the first time, complete the following tasks:

- 1. Mount the device (page 3).
- 2. Charge the device (page 5).
- 3. Acquire satellites (page 5).

#### **Mounting your Device**

#### **↑** WARNING

- Remove the clear plastic from the suction cup. Place the suction cup on the windshield.
- 2. Flip the lever back toward the windshield.
- 3. Plug the vehicle power cable into the back of the cradle.
- 4. Snap the cradle onto the suction cup arm.



5. Plug the other end of the vehicle power cable into a power outlet in your vehicle.

- 6. Fit the bottom of your device into the cradle.
- 7. Tilt your device back until it snaps into place.

Your unit should turn on automatically if it is plugged in and the vehicle is running.









#### **Charging Your Device**

Charge your device for at least 4 hours before using it on battery power.

Your device can be powered three ways.

- Connect the vehicle power cable to the mount while the device is in the mount.
- Connect the USB cable.
- Connect an AC adapter (available on some device models).

#### **Acquiring Satellites**

- Go outdoors to an open area, away from tall buildings and trees.
- 2. Turn on your device.

Acquiring satellite signals can take a few minutes. The satellite icon indicates signal status. When at least one of the lines is green, your device has acquired satellite signals.

## Finding a Point of Interest

- 1. Touch Where To? > Points of Interest.
- 2. Select a category and a subcategory.
- 3. Select a destination, and touch **Go!**.
- 4. If necessary, touch **Start** to navigate the route.

To search for a location in a different area, touch **Where To?** 


> **=** > Near.

# Finding a Point of Interest by Name

- Touch Where To? > Points of Interest.
- 2. Select a category and a subcategory.
- 3. Touch **Q**.







Your route is marked with a magenta line. As you travel, your device guides you to your destination with voice prompts, arrows on the map, and directions at the top of the map. If you depart from the original route, your device recalculates the route.

Touch and drag the map to view a different area of the map. A speed limit icon could appear as you travel on major roadways.



- 1 Touch to view the Next Turn page or Junction View page.
- 2 Touch to view the Turn List.

- 3 Touch and to zoom in and out.
- Touch to return to the Main menu.
- 5 Touch to change the data field.
- 6 Touch to view the Where Am I? page.
- Touch to view the trip computer.

#### Adding a Stop

Before you can add a stop, you must be navigating a route.

- Touch sto return to the Main menu.
- 2. Touch Where To?.
- 3. Search for the extra stop.
- 4. Touch Go!.
- Touch Set as Via Point to add this stop before your final destination.





Before you can take a detour, you must be navigating a route.

- 1. Touch **5** to return to the Main menu.
- 2. Touch Detour.

### Using nüLink!™ Services

Your device comes with a subscription to Garmin nüLink! services, which allows you to receive current information on weather, fuel prices, flight times, and more.

For more information on nüLink! services, touch **Tools** > **Help**, or refer to the *nüvi 1695 Owner's Manual* at www.garmin.com.

#### **Finding Local Businesses**

Local search enables you to search for the most up-to-date location information.

In addition to searching by spelling the name of a location, you can also search for a specific category of location, like hair salon or art gallery.

- 1. Touch Where To? > Points of Interest > Local Search.
- 2. Enter the location name or category.
- 3. Touch Done.

- 4. Select a location.
  - Touch the Google® tab to perform a local search over the nüLink! connection.
  - Touch the Garmin tab to search the pre-loaded Garmin POI.
- 5. Touch Go!.

# Finding a Destination Using Phone Book Listings

- 1. Touch Where To? > White Pages.
- 2. Select an option:

- By Name—Touch to search for a listing using first and last names.
- **By Phone Number**—Touch to search for a listing using a phone number.
- Use the on-screen keyboard to enter a name or a phone number, and touch **Done**.
- 4. Select a listing in the search results, if necessary.

- 1. Touch Where To? > Fuel Prices.
- 3. Select a station.

## **Checking Movie Times**

1. Touch Where To? > Movie Times.

2. Touch **=** > **Select Day** and select an upcoming day.

- 3. Select **Find By Movie Title** or **Find by Theater Name**.
- 4. Select a movie title or a movie theater.

## **Finding Local Events**

- 1. Touch Where To? > Local Events.
- 2. Select a category.

When you are receiving traffic information, a traffic icon appears

in the upper-left corner of the map page. The traffic icon changes color to indicate the severity of traffic conditions on your route or on the road you are currently traveling. If a severe traffic delay occurs on your route while you are navigating, the device automatically recalculates the route.

- Touch Tools > Weather.
  The weather for your current location appears.
- 2. Select an option to view weather:
  - Touch a day in the forecast to view the weather information for that day.
  - From the Weather page, touch Current Location to change your current location.

- From the Weather page, touch Current Location > Add City to view weather information for a different location.
- From the Weather page, touch
  > Favorite Cities to view
  a list of cities you have added.
- From the Weather page, touch > Weather Radar to view a map that displays precipitation (if any) near your current location.

**NOTE:** The weather radar is an optional service. For more information about purchasing nüLink! subscriptions, please see the *nüvi 1695 Owner's Manual*.







To use the hands-free features, you must pair your phone and your device. To pair and connect, your phone and the device must be turned on and within 33 ft. (10 m) of each other.

#### **Pairing Your Phone**

- 1. Enable the Bluetooth component on your phone.
- 2. On your device, touch **Tools** > **Settings** > **Bluetooth**.
- 3. Touch Bluetooth.
- 4. Touch **Enabled** > **Save**.
- 5. Touch **Add Phone** > **OK**.
- 6. Select your phone, and touch **OK**.
- 7. Enter the Bluetooth PIN (1234) for your device in your phone.

#### **Calling a Number**

- 1. Select **Phone** > **Dial**.
- 2. Enter the number, and touch **Dial**.
- 3. To end a call, touch **⊘** > **End** Call.

#### Receiving a Call

When you receive a call, the Incoming Call window opens.

- Touch Answer to answer the call.
- Touch **Ignore** to ignore the call.







- Press and quickly release the **Power** key to view additional options:
  - Touch and drag the scroll bar to adjust screen brightness.
  - Touch Lock Screen to prevent accidental screen touches.
  - Touch Power Off to turn off your device. You can also turn off the device by holding the Power key for 2 seconds.
- 2. Press and quickly release the **Power** key to exit the menu.

## **Resetting Your Device**

If your device stops functioning, reset your device by pressing and holding the **Power** key for 10 seconds.


## **Securing Your Device**

- Ensure that you are at your security location and that your device is receiving satellite signals.
- 2. Touch Tools > Settings > System > Garmin Lock.
- Touch Lock Device.
- 4. Touch **Enabled** > **Save**.
- 5. Enter a four-digit PIN.
- 6. Touch Set.

**NOTE**: If you forget your PIN and your security location, you must send your device to Garmin to get it unlocked. You must also send a valid product registration or proof of purchase.







- Go to http://my.garmin.com, and click **Register**.
- Follow the online instructions to install the myGarmin Agent<sup>™</sup> and register your device.

## **Updating the Software**

- Connect the device to your computer using the micro-USB cable. The AutoPlay menu opens.
- Double-click ▲ to open the myGarmin Agent Web page. If the AutoPlay menu does not open, or you are on a Mac<sup>®</sup> computer, go to www.garmin .com/agent.
- 3. Follow the on-screen instructions. After you have installed myGarmin Agent, you will be prompted to open myDashboard each time you connect your device to your computer. myDashboard checks for current

software updates and provides additional information about your device.

## nüMaps Guarantee™

To receive one free map update (if available), register your device at http://my.garmin.com within 60 days of acquiring satellites while driving with your device. You are not eligible for the free map update if you register by phone or wait longer than 60 days after the first time you acquire satellites while driving with your device.
