

ParaShoot

Instructions

Step 1. Power On: gently press this bottom button until the flashing red light becomes solid.



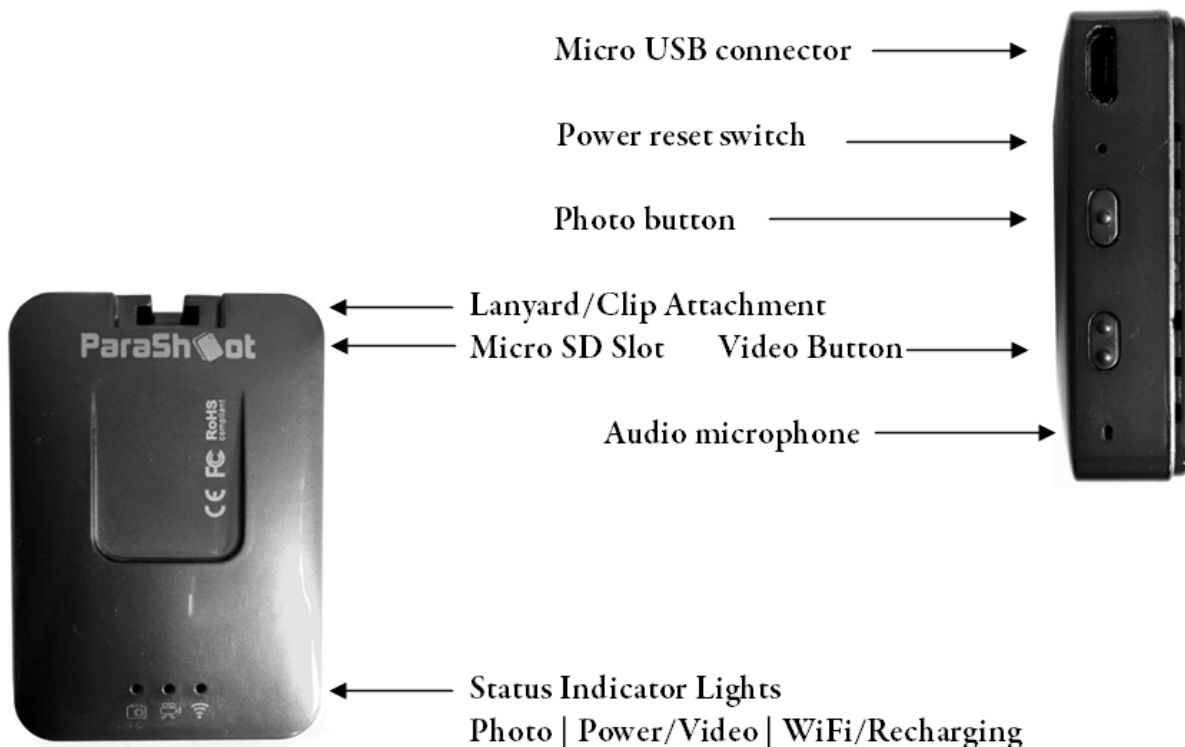
Step 2. Taking a photo or a video: press either the top button on the side of the camera (with the one notch) to snap a photo, or the one with the two notches below it to take a video.



Step 3. Using the ParaShoot app:

- Download the ParaShoot app from the iOS/Google Play store to your smart device.
- Make sure your ParaShoot is on and the red light is solid, then press the Power On button again gently for one second until the blue WiFi light starts flashing
- Go to your smart device WiFi settings and establish connection, the pwd is "1234567890"
- Open the ParaShoot app: preview in real time, snap a photo, record a video, change the settings of the camera, and download your photos and videos to your smart devices.
