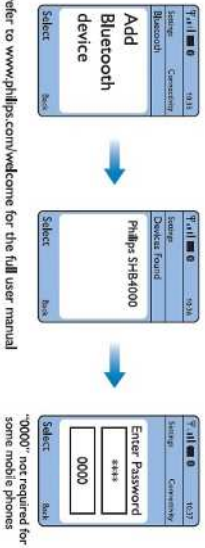

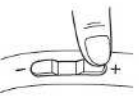

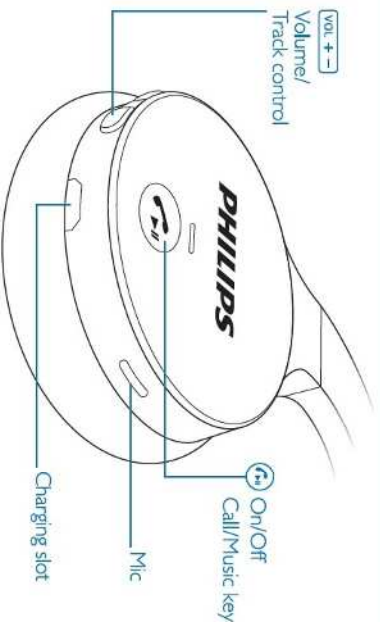

Call/Music key

- Turn headset on: Press **(+)** for 1 sec
- Turn headset off: Press **(+)** for 4 sec
- Play/Pause/Pick up call/Hang up: 1 press **(+)** / Long press **(+)** for 1 sec until "gr" sound
- Reject incoming call: 2 press **(+)** / Long press **(+)**
- Redial: Long press **(+)**
- Switch caller while in a call: Long press **(+)**
- In pairing mode: White and blue LED flashing alternately
- Paired and connected mode: Blue LED flashing at every 6 sec
- Fully charged: White LED goes out once it is fully charged when cable is connected
- Low battery: White LED flashing
