WTX

Automatic Hole Recognition

- The WTX will automatically advance to the next hole as you play through the course.
- Please note, in rare instances, it may be necessary to manually advance to the next hole.



Manual Hole Selection

- To change from the current hole to the next hole in Play Golf Mode, swipe the screen from top to bottom.
- To change from the current hole to the previous hole in play Golf Mode, swipe the screen from bottom to top.



Exit Golf Mode

From Play Golf Mode, press and hold anywhere on the screen for 4 seconds to exit the game. Tap the "Yes" button to end the round.

Pin Placement

- You can access the Dynamic Green View and Pin Placement Mode by tapping on the green (R. After the pin placement, you can return to the golf screen by
- From Dynamic Green View screen, you may also change the placement of the pin on the green image by dragging the pin.



Measuring Shot Distance

- In Play Golf Mode, press and hold anywhere on the screen for 2 seconds to enter the Shot Distance screen.
- To start measuring your shot distance, tap the play button . The Shot Distance Mode will return to the Play Golf screen by tapping the screen or pressing the "Poewr/ESC" key and will measure the distances in the background.
- Once you have reached your ball, press and hold anywhere on the screen for 2 seconds and tap the pause button in to finish measuring and view the shot distance.



Settings

- In the Shot Distance screen, you can enter "SETTINGS" by tapping the image or swiping the screen from right to left.
- From the Settings Menu, you can change the unit of measurement between Yards and Meters as well as switch the backlight to ALWAYS ON/OFF.
- **Note: If "Screen Always On" is set to ON, the screen will always be on in Golf Mode, but the battery life will decrease faster.

Power On/Off

GETTING STARTED

- Press and hold the power button for 4 seconds to power the WTX watch
- If you experience incorrect yardages or unusual behaviour on the WTX, we recommend to do a RESET. To RESET: turn the WTX off and then back on.

Charging

- To charge the WTX, attach the USB clip by aligning the contact pins on the back of the watch. The battery indicator will display while charging and will show "100%" when fully charged.
- To disconnect the WTX, remove the charging cradle from the

BASIC OPERATION

• By tapping the distance number on the screen (see images below), you will be able to switch Golf screens.



Target / Hazard Information

- From the Play Golf Mode, tap the Di image or swipe the screen from left to right continuously to view the Hole Layout and Hazard Information.
- Tap the dimage or swipe the screen from left to right continuously to return to the previous screen.
- From Hole Layout screen, Tap the image or swipe the screen from right to left continuously to view Hazard Information.
- If more than 3 hazards are available, swipe the screen up or down to see more.



Quick Watch Mode(Sunrise/Sunset Time)

- In Play Golf Mode, tab the indication area at the top of the screen(outlined in red on the image to the right) to switch the Quick Watch Mode for the current time, sunrise and sunset time.
- The Quick Watch Mode will be display for 5 seconds and will automatically return to Play Golf Mode. Or, instead of waiting, tap the screen and it will return to Play Golf Mode immediately.
