

FCC NOTICE

This equipment has been tested and found to comply with the limits for a Class B digital device, pursuant to Part 15 of the FCC Rules. These limits are designed to provide reasonable protection against harmful interference in a residential installation. This equipment generates, uses, and can radiate radio frequency energy, and, if not installed and used in accordance with the instructions, may cause harmful interference to radio communications. RF EXPOSURE INFORMATION

When used in a fixed configuration (the radio and antenna are non-mobile) the antenna should be located at least 2 meters from normal human proximity. If used in a mobile configuration the antenna separation must be at least 20 centimeters.
