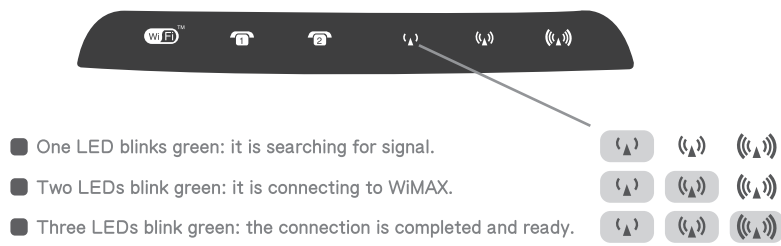


## Set up WiMAX Connection

**Step 1 Power On**  
Connect your WiMAX CPE to power with the power cord and plug. Then, the LEDs will blink for a few seconds and go off.



**Step 2 Establish WiMAX Connection**  
Once powered on, the CPE will automatically connect to your subscribed WiMAX service. The operation to setting up connections takes place in the following orders:

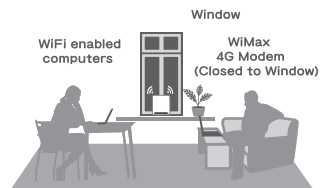


Note: Do not disconnect power during this process. It may take a few minutes to complete modem initialization.

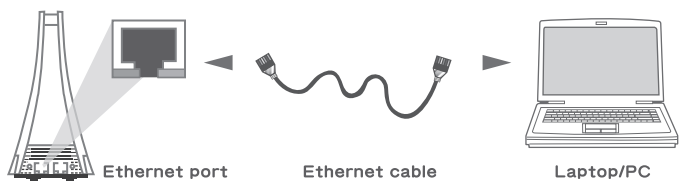
**Step 3 Modem Placement**  
Adjust the location of the WiMAX CPE for optimized signal reception.

- One green LED: the signal is weak. (1 bar)
- Two green LEDs: the signal is good. (2 bars)
- Three green LEDs: the signal is excellent. (3 bars)

Tip: You can try several spots in the house for an optimal location. Usually, it is recommended to place the indoor modem next to window, facing the base station.



**Step 4 Network and Connectivity**  
Use the LAN cable to connect the modem and your laptop/PC. Once connected, the Ethernet port LED lights up in green. If the Ethernet port blinks in yellow, it indicates data transmission is in process.

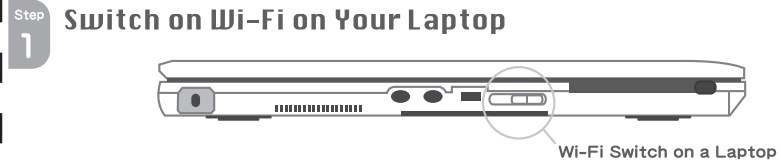


**Step 5 Click on the Internet Browser**  
Now you are able to connect to the Internet.



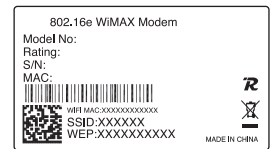
## Set up Wi-Fi Connection

If you have Wi-Fi devices in your home, you can connect them to the Internet with your WiMAX modem. When the Wi-Fi LED lights up it indicates that Wi-Fi is enabled. When the Wi-Fi LED starts blinking, it indicates that data is being transmitted.



**Step 2 Find the Wireless Network**  
Right-Click on the Wireless Network Connection icon at the bottom right of the screen and select "View Available Wireless Networks".

**Step 3 Enter security password**  
In the list of available networks, choose the one that matches the SSID Key. Click "Connect". You will be prompted to key in the WEP password. \*The SSID key and WEP password are printed at the bottom of your modem.



**Step 4 Click on your Internet browser**  
Now you will be able to connect to the Internet.



**Security Notice**  
If you want to change the default SSID or WEP key, open any Internet browser and type in the URL address to access the "Graphic User Interface" at <http://10.1.1.254>, click on the "Networking" to start the further setting.
