



1.0 Product Introduction

- The PAMKUU edutainment contest robot aims to provide such different game plays as fighting and racing by utilizing robot joint motion module, electronic scoring system, and APP controls.
- Chassis, which is composed of 4 omnidirectional wheels and metal skeletons running through omnidirectional wheels, helps achieve swerving and advancing in an all-around and multi-directional manner.
- Players operate PAMKUU robot and control the movement and customize the skill movements to fight through the APP.



- * 1) Prior to using PAMKUU robot, you are kindly requested to visit official website (<http://pamkuu.walkera.com>) to watch the video tutorial and carefully read the User Manual, so as to avoid property loss and personal injuries caused by misoperation.
- 2) PAMKUU robots are suitable for players that are at least 14 years old. The Robot should be used at a separation distance of 20cm at least to the body.
- 3) MODIFICATION: Any changes or modifications not expressly approved by the grantee of this device could void the user's authority to operate the device.



Software supports **iOS 9.0 / Android 5.0** and later versions.


For IOS system, please go to APP Store to download and install it.



For Android system, go to official website (<http://pamkuu.walkera.com>) or Google Play to download and install it.




3.3 Battery installation



1. Properly insert batteries from back to front

2. Connect power cable.




3.5 Connection method


PAMKUU connects to mobile devices directly through WiFi.

The connection steps are as follows:


- 1) PAMKUU will automatically give off WiFi signal one minute after it is activated.
- 2) Enter the WiFi setting interface of the mobile device.
- 3) On the WiFi setting interface of a mobile device, initial display of PAMKUU WiFi is "PAMKUU_xxxxxx", where "xxxxxx" is a unique number corresponding to every set of machine.
- 4) Click to select it and enter password (default password: 12345678).
- 5) Just open APP.




3.4 Sword and handgun mounting



1. Mount sword and tighten screw (M2.5x12).



2. Mount handgun and tighten screw (M2.5x12).



3. Connect handgun cable.


4.0 APP Activation




1. Tap the icon on the mobile phone screen.




2. Select "PAMKUU" and click "OK".



3. Click "START".



4. The dialog box will automatically pop out if the robot is unactivated. Disconnect your device from the robot WiFi, then connect the device to an open network and click 'Registration'.



5. Connect the robot WiFi (PAMKUU_xxxxxx) and click "Robot activation"



6. Click "Done" to enter the control interface. Please follow the operation steps again should you fail to activate.

5.0 Operating Instructions

5.1 Basic controls: Control Interface



1. Electric quantity: in percentage, to decrease from right to left.
2. Hit Point: to decrease from right to left.
3. WiFi connection status button:
Two states: blue (successful connection), red (connection loss)
When the button is red, the connection tutorial will automatically show up.
When it is blue, click it to open or close the interface icon explanation.
4. Set button: click it to pop up [Setting Menu].
5. Skill interface: to display 4 melee attack skills and a ranged weapon button.
6. Rotate button: to control clockwise or anticlockwise rotation of the robot.
7. Two sets of preset skills are switchable.
8. Quickly reset the robot posture: quickly restore the robot to the default posture.
9. Directional joystick.


5.2 Basic Operation: Menu Settings




1. Skill pool: click it to enter the skill pool interface.
2. Audio & Vibrate: click it to ON or OFF.
3. Robot Selection: Click to select the robot model.
4. Language Selection: to select Chinese or English.
5. Boot & Preview: click it to enter the Boot & Preview interface.
6. About: Display of company and software related information and the Fight Tutorial.

5.4 Basic operations: skill setting interface




1. Back button: back to previous interface.
2. Skills List: click it to edit this skill, scroll up to view more skill icons.
3. Skill settings: click it to enter the skill setting interface.
4. Add skill: click it to enter the skill edit interface.



1. Skills list: skill demonstration.
2. No. of preset skill sets: Two sets of preset skills marked with 1 & 2 respectively.
3. Skill setting operation: click any skill in the list of skills on the left side, and then click one of the preset skills on the right side to change.
4. Save button: save the newly set skill.
5. Cancel button: not modify.


5.5 Basic operations: Add skill interface




1. Back button: back to previous interface.
2. Skill icon: click it to select skill icon
3. Skill name: click it to edit its name, better less than 6 characters.
4. Servo part indication: When adjusting servos corresponding to each part of the robot, the corresponding part is highlighted.
5. Delete or Revert default: there will be a delete button on the newly added skills, click it to delete the skill. There will be a revert default button, click it to revert factory defaults for the skill, and click save to complete.
6. Perform: click it to perform the skill once.
7. Save: click it to save a new skill.
8. Servo adjusting slider
9. Add action: click it to add a new action, click "Action" to modify action parameter.
10. Speed adjustment: to adjust speed.
11. Action: Click icon \otimes to delete this action, click "Action" to modify parameters, robot can act accordingly.

6.0 Game Rules




At least 2 sets of PAMKUU robot are needed to battle against each other. When PAMKUU's sensor is attacked by a weapon, a certain HP shall be lost.
A PAMKUU robot is judged to lose the battle when its HP reduced to zero.

ranged weapons: front chest




Effective attack scope of

7.0 Online Upgrade

Online upgrade is available on official website (<http://pamkuu.walkera.com>).

- 1) Remove the PB1.7x6 screws, open decoration cover at the rear of the robot.
- 2) Connect the USB data cable to robot USB port and computer USB port.
- 3) Mount the decoration cover when the upgrade is complete.



8.0 Attentions

8.1 Non-warranty conditions

- 1) Damage resulting from use of accessories not provided by Walkera;
- 2) Damage resulting from users' unauthorized refit;
- 3) Unavoidable damage (such as dropping, waterlogging, collision, electric shock and burn) resulting from improper operation or use of products;
- 4) Damage resulting from natural disaster;
- 5) Damage resulting from disassembly, maintenance by unauthorized agencies or maintenance sites.

8.2 Battery

- 1) Batteries must be stored in a dry, ventilated place with ambient temperature of 18-25°C .
- 2) Repeated charging and excessive discharging must be prevented to improve batteries' service life.
- 3) Prior to long-time storage, charging maintenance must be done to batteries, i.e. charge up to 50-60% the saturated volume before storage.
- 4) Never dismantle or alter circuits, nor puncture batteries. Never place it onto inflammables or leave it unattended during charging.
- 5) Always keep charger's output voltage identical with battery voltage.
- 6) Keep the battery out of reach of children

Maintenance Instructions

Furious collisions are inevitable for fighting robots during the game, there will be some injuries on some parts of the robot. Players are advised to practice the operations of PAMKUU robot before a fight with other players. In the mean time, try to alternatively use melee and ranged weapons to increase the service life of the robot.
