### 1. General product information

#### 1.1 What is Autodesk Plant Design Suite 2015?

Autodesk® Plant Design Suite 2015 provides comprehensive plant design, modeling, and review software in an economical package that helps customers to design more efficiently, innovate ahead of the competition, and communicate with greater clarity. Use it to help keep projects on schedule and within budget. Building on the power of Autodesk® AutoCAD® software and Autodesk® 360 cloud services, the suite adds plant-specific content and functionality to help drive greater productivity and better project coordination. Three editions of Autodesk Plant Design Suite are available to help meet your workflow needs: Standard, Premium, and Ultimate.

- The Standard edition supports foundational drafting and P&ID plant design workflows, enabling users to utilize available AutoCAD expertise and resources to streamline layout, drafting, and P&ID work.
- The Premium edition provides additional software for modern 3D modeling, including piping design, structural design, isometric/orthographic generation, and project-wide model aggregation, as well as advanced tools for visualization and construction simulation
- The Ultimate edition builds on the capabilities of the Premium edition with the addition of specialized software to support 3D plant equipment and skid design, as well as tools to help identify clashes early in the process.

# 3. Installation, configuration, and licensing

#### 3.1 What are the licensing options for Autodesk Plant Design Suite 2015?

It has never been easier to get the Autodesk software you want with a variety of purchase options to meet the unique needs of your business. You can license Autodesk Plant Design Suite via pay-as-you-go plans (Desktop Subscription) as well as perpetual licenses. Pay-as-you-go enables you to license software on a short-term basis with monthly, quarterly or annual plans—a great choice for customers who have short-term project and staffing needs and want to ramp up their business quickly. A perpetual license is ideal for customers who need ongoing access to Autodesk software.

#### 3.2 Do all products in Plant Design Suite 2015 need to be used on the same workstation?

Yes, the software applications within an Autodesk Plant Design Suite license can only be installed on a single computer. They cannot be split across multiple workstations.

#### 3.3 What if I have more than one computer? Can I use my software on multiple machines?

Autodesk recognizes that some users may need to operate the software when they are away from their usual work location. To accommodate this need, the product activation technology, and certain license types, enable an employee to install the software on a second computer owned by the employee's company, provided it is for use away from the employee's usual work location, the software is used only by that employee and no other, and only one of the two copies of the software is ever in use at any one time.
