LOCATION:
You need to place your EM7000 base within 3.5 feet of a socket outlet and telephone wall outlet so that the signal will reach. The socket-outlet should be installed near the equipment and should be easily accessible. Make sure that it is at least 1 foot away from other electrical appliances to avoid distortion or interference. Your EM7000 base, by sending radio signals between the handset and base, the strength of the signal depends on when you place the base. Having it as high as possible ensures the best signal.

HANDSET RANGE
The unit has a range of up to 200 yards outdoors when there is a clear line of sight between the base and handset. Any obstruction between the base and handset will reduce the range significantly. With the base indoors and the handset either indoors or outdoors, the range will normally be up to 100 feet. This concrete and stone walls can severely affect the range.

SIGNAL STRENGTH
The cell on your handset indicates that you are within range of the base. When out of range of the base, the cell disappears. If you are on a call, you will hear a warning beep. The base will ring up if the handset moves out of range of the base. Move closer to the base. The handset will automatically reconnect to the base.
