1. SAFETY INFORMATION FOR FIXED WIRELESS TERMINALS

POTENTIALLY EXPLOSIVE ATMOSPHERES

Turn your phone OFF when in any area with a potentially explosive atmosphere and obey all signs and instructions. Sparks in such areas could cause an explosion or fire resulting in bodily injury or even death.

INTERFERENCE TO MEDICAL DEVICES
