1. General Information

Setup precautions

- Finding a suitable location
 - Place this unit on a flat, hard and stable surface. Never place the unit on a carpet.
 - Never place this unit on top of other equipment that might heat it up.
- Space for ventilation
 - Place this unit in a location with adequate ventilation to prevent internal heat build up. Allow at least 5 cm clearance from the rear and the top of this unit and 5 cm from the left and right to prevent overheating.
- Avoid high temperature, moisture, water and dust
 - This unit must not be exposed to dripping or splashing.
 - Never place any object or items that can damage this unit .



3.1 Connection

Choose one of the options below to make the video and audio connection. **Suggest connecting with HDMI cable or YPbPr cable.**

1. HDMI


For a HDMI TV, connect the TV with HDMI cable.

2. YPbPr

For a progressive scan TV, connect the TV with the YPbPr cable and AUDIO OUT FRONT R/L cable.

3. CVBS


For a standard TV, connect the TV with the AV cable and AUDIO OUT FRONT R/L cable. Change the resolution to 480i/576i before connect with CVBS.







(3) 2.4 G Wireless Fly Mouse




(4) Android Mobile or Android Tablet PC

- ① Install RemoteIM.
 - RemoteIM.apk is in file “android” of “sdcard_int”. Copy it to your Android Mobile or Android Tablet PC and install.
- ② Connect WIFI.
- ③ Open RemoteIM.



3.3 Power on (Power off)

- Blue light: Power on. Red light: Power off.
- When the unit is on, press  on the remote control or press  button on the unit about two seconds to power off.
- When the unit is power off, press  on the remote control or press  button on the unit to power on.




4. Operation Menu

Main Screen Theme


Main Screen Theme shows the signs of “File Browser”, “Music”, “Video Player”, “Websites”, “Web sites”, “Gallery”, “settings” and “Android”.

Press ◀▶ to select. Press **OK** to confirm.

- If display position incorrect, please set your TV display position. “4.6.3 Display” is for your reference.
- Click left button of the mouse for long time to change the background if needed.



4.1 File Browser



- Click “File Browser”, manage or edit the files by the ◀ ▶ ▲ ▼ and **OK**.

The unit is with internal SD Card named “sdcard_int”. File “Android” includes some APKs: Flash player, RemoteIM, Office suite, Explore, etc. Backup them before “Upgrade” or “Factory data reset” .


4.2 Music

The audio files are divided by types, such as: “Artists”, “Albums”, “Songs”, “Playlists”, and “Now playing”. Select by ◀▶.

- When listing the audio files, it displays the files with the formats can be read only.
- Press ▲ ▼ to select and press **OK** to confirm.
- Press **VOL- VOL+** to adjust the volume.
- Press ◀▶ to last song. Press ▶▶ to next song.
- Press ▶▶ to play/pause the music. Press ■ to stop the music.
- Press **SETUP** on the remote control or click ≡ with the mouse to enter the menu as below.



- Get in the UI of Android system, then press ▶▶ to play the songs. It plays the song in the last operating by default. You can select or play the songs by ▶▶ ◀▶ ▶▶▶▶.



4.3 Video Player

- When browsing the video files, it displays the files with the formats can be read only.
- When playing, press **SETUP** to get or cancel the menu.



- Select ●●● on the menu, and get in the sub-menu. It includes the signs of “Resume Mode”, “Play Mode”, “Audio Track”, “Subtitle”, “Display Mode”, “Brightness”, and “File Information”.





- Press **▶▶** to fast forward. Press **◀◀** to fast rewind. Press **▶** to play/pause the video.
- Press **VOL- VOL+** to adjust the volume.
- Press **◀◀** to last video. Press **▶▶** to next video.
- Press **RETURN** to return to previous menu.

4.4 Websites


- Press ▲ ▼ to shift cursor to select sorts of webs. Press **OK** to confirm. It lists default internet service. Sorts are on the left and show all details on the right. Press ▲▼◀▶ to select the different webs and get in the internet services.
- Get in “Website”, and press the key **www** on the remote control. Type the website you want and press **OK** to confirm (with IR Input Method).
- Get in the “Website”, keep pressing the key **OK** or keep clicking the left button of the mouse to get the menu as bellow.




- Get in “Website”, and press **SETUP**. Shows bellow menu, including “New window”, “Bookmarks”, “Windows”, “Refresh”, “Forward”, and “More”.



- ◇ Select “Bookmarks”, you can add new bookmarks or select the bookmarks. Select “Most visited” or “History”, you can visit previous websites.



- ◇ Change the input method: Get in the input field, and keep pressing the key **OK** or keep clicking the left button of the mouse, can get in “select input method”.



The English letters on the remote control can not be input directly. It is only for numbers. If need to input the English letters, change the input method to “IR Input Method” and press **▲▼◀▶** and **ok** to select the letters.
