2. Apps & notifications

① Recently opened apps

You can see recently opened apps in the list.

② All apps

You can see Apps info in it

- a. Storage
- b. DISABLE / FORCE STOP
- c. Setting notification

③ Notifications

On lock screen: you can choose one setting below based on your need.

- a. Show all notification content
- b. Don't show notification at all

④ Allow notification dots

Turn it off if you don't want to see the dot when notifications arrive.

⑤ Default notification sound

You can choose the sound you like.

⑥ Do Not Disturb

- a. Sound & vibration: When "Do Not Disturb" is on, sound and vibration will be muted, except for the items you allow. (Alarms / Media / Touch sound)
- b. Notifications:
 - 1) If "No sound from notifications" is turned on, your phone won't make a sound or vibrate when notifications arrive.
 - 2) If "No visuals or sound from notifications" is turn on, your phone won't show new or existing notifications, and won't make a sound or vibrate. Notifications won't appear when you swipe down from the top of your screen. (Keep in mind, critical notifications for phone activity and status will still appear)
 - 3) Custom restrictions:
You can hide notification dots, icons if you don't want to get notification notices.
- c. Do Not Disturb Duration:
Until you turn off
For 1 Hour or more (Click – or + to adjust the time)
Ask for every time.

3. Battery Setting

- a. You can see the battery situation, estimated standby time, last full charge and screen usage since full charge.

- b. Some features may be limited when battery saver is on.
- c. When Battery Manager detects that apps are draining battery, you'll have the option to restrict these apps. Restricted apps may not work properly and notifications may be delayed.

Please note that battery usage data is approximate and can change based on usage.

4. Display

① Brightness level

You can adjust the brightness level from 0% to 100%

② Adaptive Brightness level

When "Adaptive Brightness" is turned on, your screen brightness will automatically adjust to your environment and activities. You can move the slider manually to help adaptive brightness learn your preferences.

③ Wallpaper

You can choose wallpaper from Live Wallpapers, Photos and Wallpapers.

④ Sleep

Setting the automatic sleep time for Never, 15/30 second, 1/2/5/10/30 minutes.

⑤ Advanced

- a. Auto-rotate screen: The screen will rotate automatically if turn it on.
- b. Font size: Make the text on screen smaller or larger. (Four levels)
- c. Display size: Make the items on your screen smaller or larger. Some apps on your screen may change position. (Four levels)
- d. Screen saver
- e. Device theme: Automatic (based on wallpaper), Light, Dark, choose the one you want.

5. Sound

① Sound setting:

You can increase or decrease the volume below:

Media volume / Call volume / Alarm volume / Notification volume

② Do Not Disturb (Turn on or Turn off)

③ Shortcut to prevent ringing (On / vibrate)

Press Power & Volume Up together (On / vibrate)

④ Default notification sounds

⑤ Default alarm sounds

⑥ Screen locking sounds

⑦ Charging sounds

⑧ Touch sounds

6. Screenshot

- a. Select delay time to capture the screen (15/30 seconds later, 1/2/5/10/30

minutes later)

- b. Show the screenshot button in the status bar. (On or Off)

7. Storage

- a. Storage situation(used and free)
- b. Storage manager by category: Phone & videos, Musical & audio, Games, Movie & TV apps, other apps, Files and System.

8. System

① Language & input

1) Language

- a. Click languages (You can see the default language)
- b. Add a language if you can't see that in default language, search it on the top of your screen.
- c. Long press the right lines to move the language position. (Put it on the first place if you want to set it by this language)

Parents can create specific media files for kids, which kids can enjoy their own music, photos and video.




2. Content and management

① Applications Recommendation


iWawa Home will recommend some educational games and applications that are suitable for kids. The recommended contents will be regularly updated and can be downloaded for free.

selected by parents. Similarly, children can open the "Gallery" and "Music" application and see pictures or listen to songs which are previously prepared for kids.




3. Behavior Restrictions

iWawa can restrict kids' behaviors through Child Lock, Consumption Restriction, Time Limit, and Behavior Report, thus children can't disturb parents' desktop any more, and unexpected consumption and games addiction can be avoided effectively.

① Child Lock:

Without the permission of parents, children will not be able to login the child desktop. Not only ensure that kids stay in a safe environment, but also ensure that kids do not have access to parents' desktop applications.




② Consumption Restraint

This function can effectively prevent kids' unexpected consumption from clicking wrong button, because all the purchases require parents' confirmation by entering the password.


③ Time Limit


① Personal Style

unexpected conditions easily.




④ Setting WIFI:

- Click WLAN on the page, it will automatically search and connect to WIFI.






1) Kids Video

2) Parent Remote Control




Parents can download the iWawaParent App to remotely control the tablet with iWawaHome App for time limit and network filtering.
