

Charging your HTC BL R100

Before using your HTC BL R100 for the first time, you should give it a full charge. A full charge requires XX hours and XX minutes.

To charge your HTC BL R100, connect one end of the USB cable to the USB connector on the HTC BL R100, and the other end to the power source.

To turn your HTC BL R100 on or off, press and hold 🕝

Pairing your HTC BL R100 to your phone

- 1. On your HTC BL R100, press and hold @ to turn it on.
- 2. Press and hold to enter pairing mode.
- On your phone, turn Bluetooth on and then tap Bluetooth to see the list of available Bluetooth devices
- 4. Tap HTC BL R100 to pair.

When pairing is successful, you'll see • in the status bar and app icons on your HTC BL R100.

You only need to pair HTC BL R100 to your phone once. The next time you turn on your HTC BL R100, it automatically reconnects to your phone.



Locking the keypad

You can lock the keypad to prevent accidental button presses.

- To lock the keypad, press and hold
 Ou'll see
 In the status bar.
- To unlock the keypad press (a) twice.

Note:

When you lock the keypad, the screen will go into sleep mode. To show the screen, unlock the keypad or press (3).

What you can do with HTC BL R100

	View your call history and frequent callers. You can also use the lists to make calls.
=	View text messages and send a quick reply using a preset response.

View ongoing and upcoming calendar events.

See how many new emails you received and be notified if your phone's battery is critically low.

Remotely control the camera shutter on your phone, the Music app, and more.

(c) Access the settings for your HTC BL R100.

Some icons show the number of $\overline{\text{new}}$ notifications (such as number of missed calls on the Phone icon).

To select an icon, use the navigation control. The navigation control consists of an enter button and an outer ring. The enter button is used for selecting items. The outer ring is used to navigate up, down, left, and right.

Making and receiving calls

You can use your HTC BL R100 to answer incoming calls, redial, and more.

answer an incoming call	press ⊖
decline an incoming call	press 🕤
end a call	press 🕝
redial	press and hold ⊖
change in-call volume	press volume up or volume down
mute microphone on/off	While in a call, press to open Call options, and then select Mute on or Mute off.
speakerphone on/off	While in a call, press to open Call options, and then select Speak on or Speak off.

To make a phone call, you can:

- · Directly dial the number using the keypad.
- Select &, and then select an item in Call history or Frequent.

Reading text messages

Whenever you receive a text message on your phone, you'll see a notification over

Your HTC BL RIOO displays the 10 most recent messages.

To read a message, select ♥ and then select the message you want to read. Messages will be listed by contact name or phone number.

You can quickly reply to a message using a preset response. Press ① and then select a reply.

Viewing calendar events

You can view summaries of 10 ongoing and upcoming events in 🖱

To view an event, select pand then select the event you want to view. Events are listed in chronological order.

Checking other notifications

You'll see a notification over ① when:

- · You receive an email in your phone's Mail app.
- · Your phone's battery is critically low.

To clear the notifications, select ① and then select Clear notification.

Listening to music

Use your HTC BL R100 to remotely control your phone's Music app.

and then select
Media player

start the Music app	press 💿
play/pause	press •
change the volume	press volume up or volume down
fast forward	press and hold the right side of O
rewind	press and hold the left side Q
play the next song	press the right side of O
play the previous song	press the left side of O
	Note:
	If the song has been playing for over 3 seconds, pressing will replay the current song from the beginning.

Taking photos

You can use your HTC BL R100 to remotely operate the camera shutter on your phone.

- 1. On your phone, open the Camera app.
- 2. On your HTC BL R100, select and then select Camera.
- 3. To take a shot, press Q.

Finding your phone

Can't remember where you put your phone? Your HTC BL R100 can make your phone ring to help you find it.

Select @ and then select Find my phone.

Settings

When you select @, you'll find these settings:

Sleep time	set the display timeout
Sound	turn sound on or off
Vibration	turn vibration on or off
BT pairing	turn on Bluetooth pairing
BT disconnect	disconnect from your phone
Software upgrade	update the firmware
