1. LOCK Button

- If the LOCK button is pushed, then TRANSMITTER sends the LOCK Data.

2. UNLOCK Button

- If the UNLOCK button is pushed, then TRANSMITTER sends the UNLOCK Data.

3. TAILGATE Button

- If the TAILGATE button is pushed, then TRANSMITTER sends the TAILGATE OPEN Data.

4. PANIC Button

- If the PANIC button is pushed, then TRANSMITTER sends the PANIC OPEN Data.

5. Remote Start Button

- If the RemoteStart button is pushed, then TRANSMITTER sends the Remote Start Data.

6. Forward Button

- If the Forward button is pushed, then TRANSMITTER sends the Forward Data.

5. Backward Button

- If the Backward button is pushed, then TRANSMITTER sends the Backward Data.
