1. Appearance and Keypad Operations



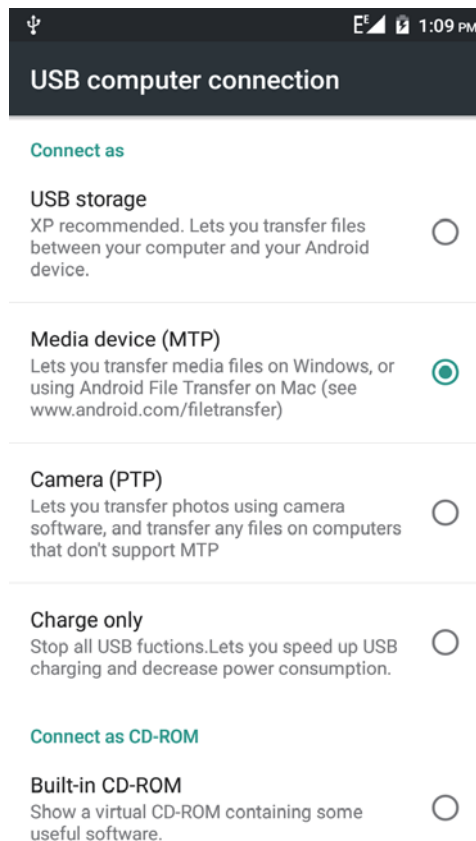
Keys	Functions
1. Home	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Press this button to return home from any application or interface. Press it to open recently opened application window.
2. Recent	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Press it to open a list of recent applications.
3. Back	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Press it to return to the previous interface, or to close dialog box , options' menu、 notification panel or the keypad.
4. Power	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Press it to open the phone's menu, then you could choose to lock the screen、 turn off the phone.
5. Up	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Press it to increase the volume Press it to turn the phone to vibration mode from the silent mode.
6. Down	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Press it to decrease the volume. Long press to Camera when screen locked
7. Back Camera	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Entering the camera interface
8. Front Camera	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Entering the camera interface, switched to the front camera can photo yourself.
9. TP	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Double touch screen unlock, default off

2. Using Memory Card as Default Storage

If you want to send music, pictures or other files to the phone's memory card from the computer, you should set memory card as u disk first.

2.1 To transfer data from computer

- 1) Connect the phone to the computer with USB cable. The notification icon will appear in the status box.
- 2) In the notification panel, touch USB is connected ,then touch "Media device"



3. WIFI


Wi-Fi provides as far as 300 feet (100M) range of wireless network access. If you want to use internet you should connect to wireless access point or hotspot.

Notices: The availability and coverage of Wi-Fi signal depend on wireless router.

3.1 Open Wi-fi and to connect to the wireless network

1) Press home>menu, then touch System settings>Network(WIRELESS&NETWORKS)>Wi-Fi.

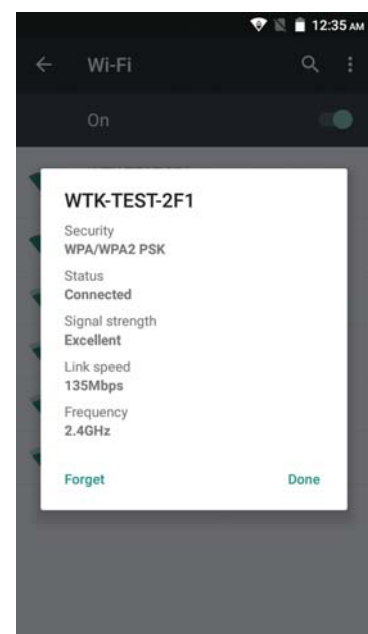
2) Select the wi-fi box to open Wi-Fi. Phone will automatically scan for available wireless networks.

3) Touch Wi-Fi settings. Then a list of Wi-Fi network will show the founded network name and security settings. (open network or WEP、 WPA/WPA2 with password).If you enable the notification in Wi-Fi settings, The status box will show this icon () when open available wireless network founded.

4) Touch one of the Wi-Fi choices to connect the network. When you choose open network, phone will connect to it automatically. If you choose WEP、 WPA/WPA2 with password, you should type the password first, then touch to connect it.


3.2 Notices :when the phone is connected to the wireless network,

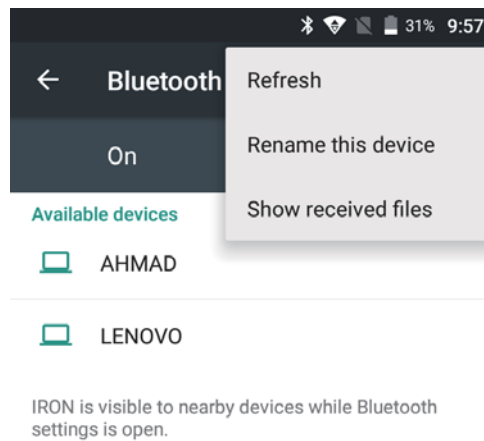
The status box will show this Wi-Fi icon, and the approximate signal strengthen (the number of lit bars).



4. Bluetooth

4.1 Turn on Bluetooth so it can be detected by other available devices.

- 1) Press menu, the touch system settings then Bluetooth.
- 2) Touch Network (wireless and networks), then choose Bluetooth box to open the Bluetooth function. After started, the status box will show this icon (). Touch "scan for devices" in the setting then it starts to scan for all devices within range.
- 3) All the devices founded will display in the list of available devices.

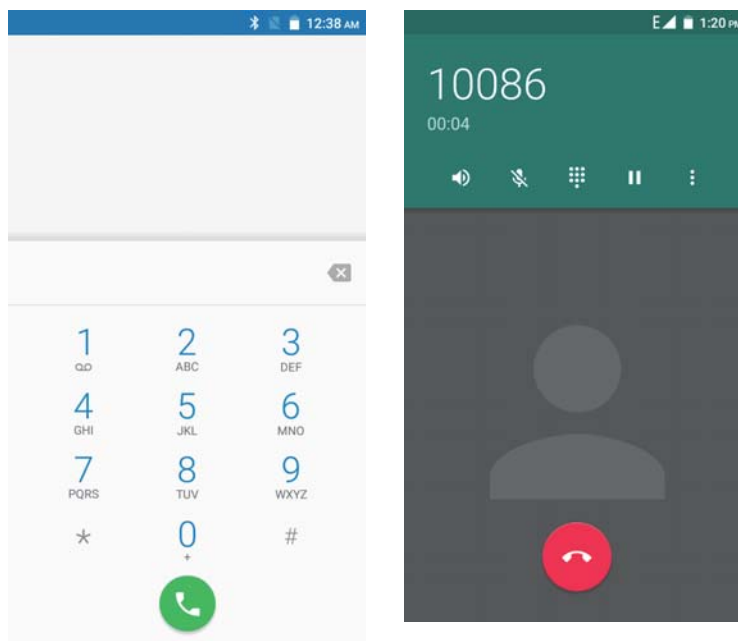


5. Dialling

Using this function, you could dial or receive calls. The signal bar on the top right corner show the strength of network signal.

5.1 Start dialing

Open application's main menu>dial. You could choose SIM to do the dialing.



5.2 Dialing

At the dialing Keypad, enter the phone number, and then click the dialing key, after that, you should choose one SIM card if 2 SIM cards are available in phone.

5.3 Phone calls in the call log

Every telephone number dialed and received will be saved in phone's menu of call log. All numbers in the call log can be dialed by clicking the button "dial" on the screen. When number list appearing, click it to catch details, you can also edit, delete, save the number or do other operations.

5.4 Receive calls

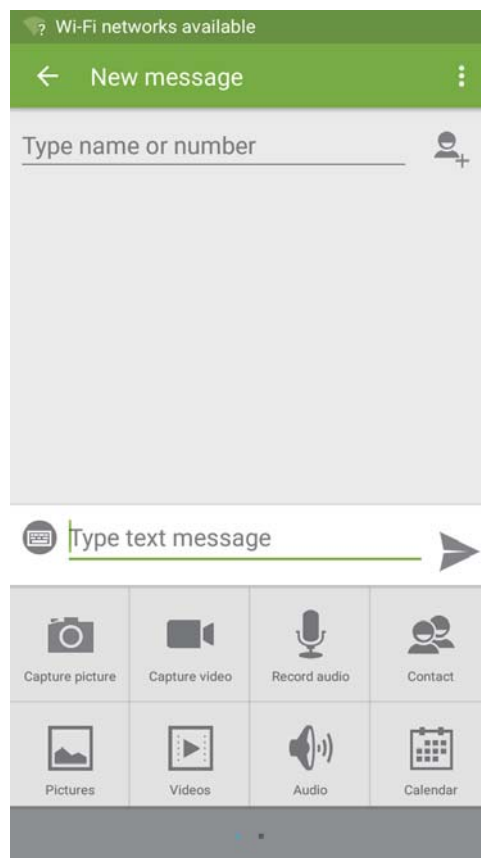
When call comes press "Answer" to receive call.

6. Messaging

You can use Messaging to exchange text messages (SMS) and multimedia messages (MMS) with your friends on their mobile phones.

6.1 Sending a message

- 1). Touch message icon on the home screen and touch new message icon to edit a new message.
- 2) Enter a contact's name or call number in the field. As the information is entered, all matching contacts appear. Touch a suggested contact or multiple contacts as message recipient(s)
- 3). Touch Enter message to compose your message.
- 4). After completing the message, touch Send icon to send your message.



7. Contacts

7.1 Add contact

To add contacts Click "Add Contact" Icons, to create New Contacts. Select save contacts to phone or a SIM card.

You can also perform the following operations:

- 1) Delete contact: you can delete one or multiple contacts from here.
- 2) Contacts to display: you can select the contacts on different group to display.
- 3) Import/export: you can import/export the contacts form SIM card or storage; you can also share the visible contacts.
- 4) Accounts: you can sync with your account.
- 5) Settings: you can set the display options in this interface.
- 6) Groups: you can edit or delete a groups
- 7) Share Visible Contacts: you can share contacts from here.

8. Browser

You can use Browser to view web pages and search for information on the web. When you open Browser, your home page opens. The web address (URL) of the current page is displayed at the top of the window. Touch the URL box at the top of the Browser screen. Enter the address (URL) of a webpage

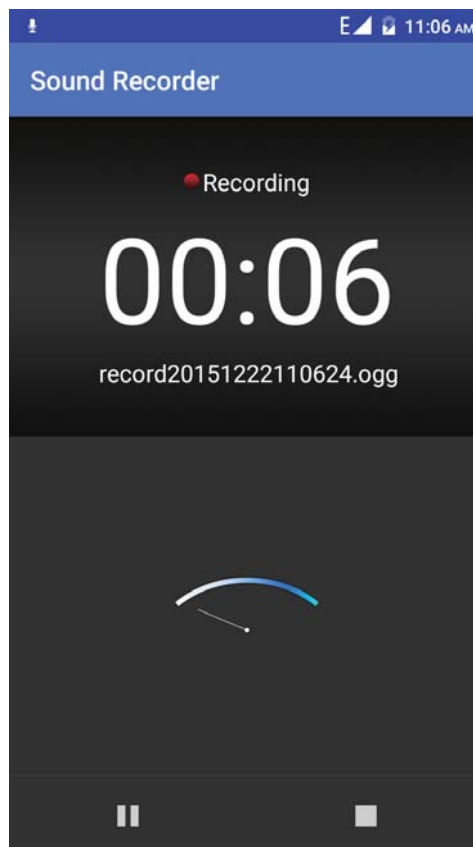


9. Sound Recorder

Recorder can record voice, and send it quickly via Bluetooth or MMS as well as make it as ring tone.

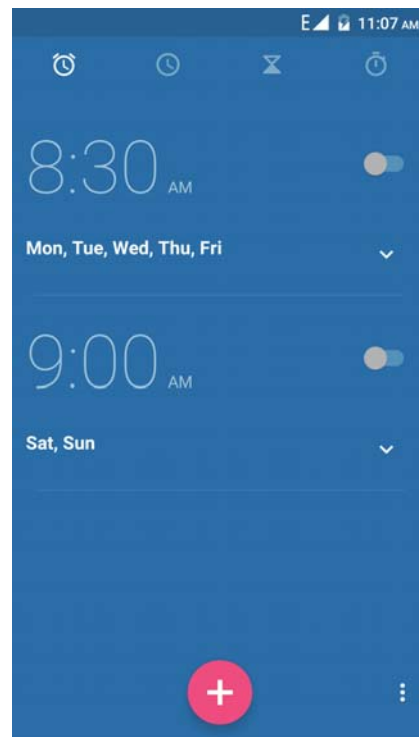
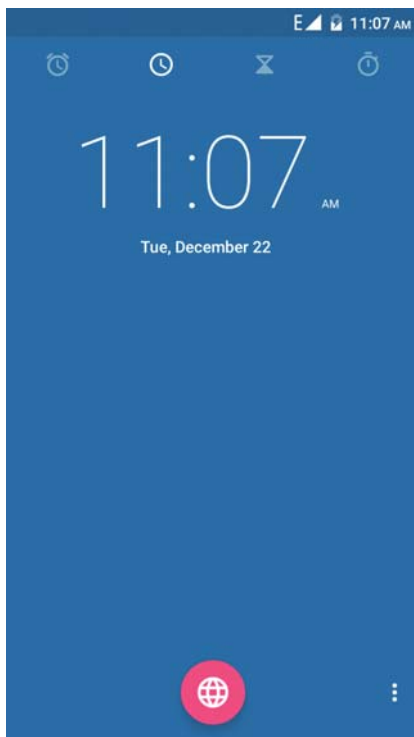
Notices: recorder can save the audio files as 3GPP and ogg format.

- 1) Click the recorder application.
- 2) Keep the phone's microphone near the voice source.
- 3) Click recorder to record voices, and click to stop.



10. Clock

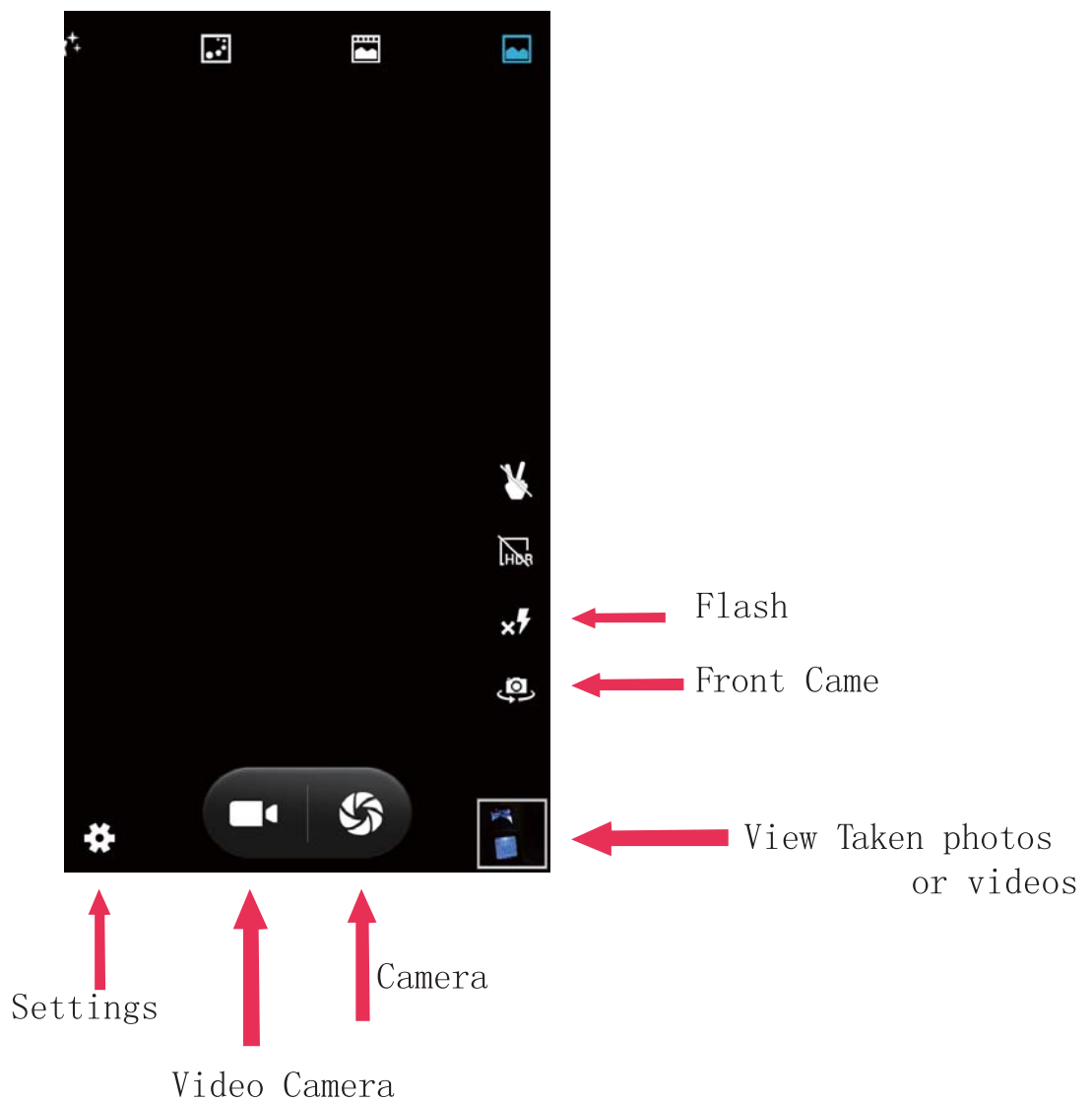
Touch the Clock icon on the Home screen or in the main menu interface. You can set an alarm by modifying an existing alarm or by adding a new one. You also can use world time, Timer and Stopwatch.



11. Camera

11.1 Taking pictures and videos

Touch  to enter the camera.



12. Gallery

Both pictures and videos taken by camera or stored in SD card can be viewed through this function.

12.1 Open Gallery

Press home>touch gallery> touch Photo's/Video's in gallery to view or play.

You can perform following functions;

- 1) Share: Using this function you can share your photos/Videos.
- 2) Delete: You can delete one or multiple photos/Videos here.
- 3) Details: You can check details about files here.

13. Music

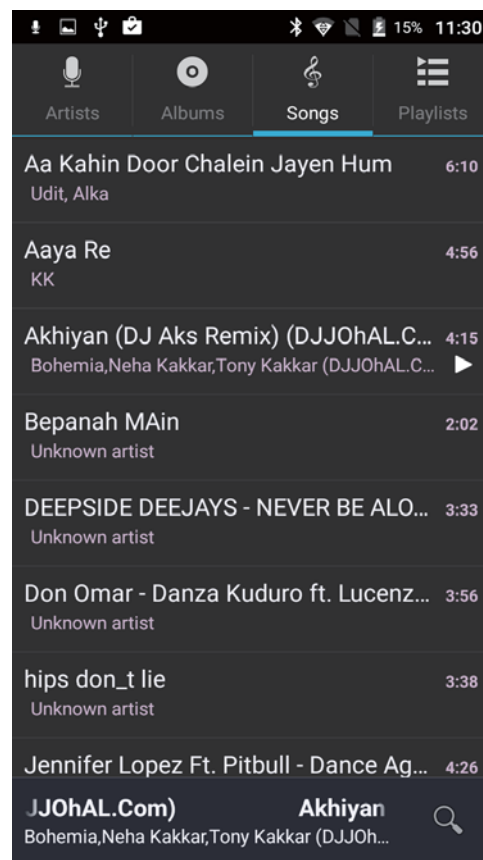
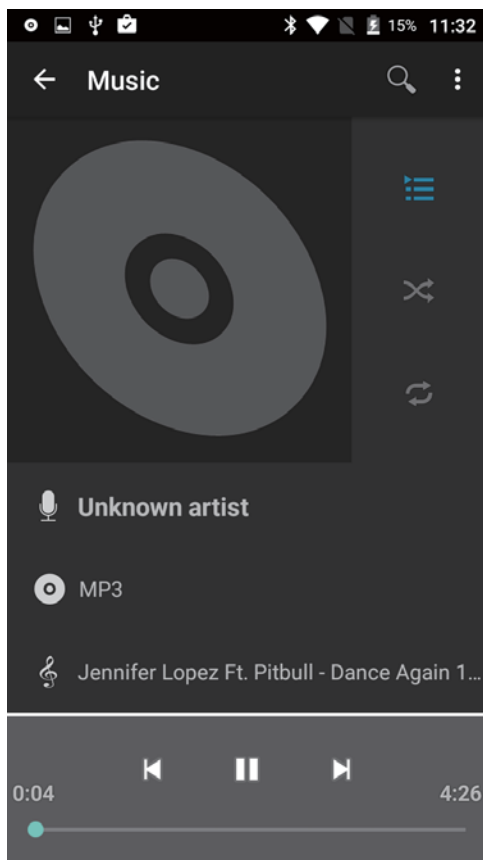
The phone can play digital audio files in memory card. The following formats are available :3GPP、 AMR、 MIDI、 MP3、 WAV

13.1 Open Music

Press home, touch the label of applications, touch music. Then the interface of Music Media appears.

13.2 Music Media

Your music files are classified according to the following four categories :Artists, albums, songs and play lists. Touch one of these categories; you can view the list inside.



14. Settings

The Settings application contains most of the tools for customizing and configuring your phone.

14.1 Wireless and Networks

1) you can use Wireless & Network settings to manage your SIM card, configure and manage connections to networks and devices by using Wi-Fi. You also can set Bluetooth, data usage, airplane mode, Default SMS app, tethering & portable hotspot, VPN and mobile networks in this interface

14.2 DEVICE

Display

1) You can set Brightness, Wallpaper, Auto-rotate screen, Sleep, Daydream, Font size and Font in this interface

Prompt & notification

1) You can make settings about the notification of call and messages etc.

Storage

1) Use the Storage settings to monitor the used and available space on your phone and on your SD card and to manage your Memory card.

Battery

1) You can view your battery status, battery level and battery use in this interface.

Apps

1) You can use the Applications settings to view details about the applications installed on your phone, to manage their data and force them to stop, to view and control currently running services, and to view the storage used by applications, etc. You can view the uninstal able application, you also can uninstall them.

14.3 PERSONAL

Location

1) You can turn on/off location and select High accuracy, Battery saving or Device only through this function.

Security

1) You can set the parameters about security through this function.

Accounts

1) You should add account first before using this function.

Language & input

1) Use the Language & input settings to select the language for the text on your phone and for configuring the input method.

By default English, Urdu and Persian are available in phone.

Factory data reset

1) You can backup your data and reset your phone in this interface.

14.4 SYSTEM

Quick Gesture Entry:

There are three Main types of gesture available and have more sub options:

Settings > Quick gesture Entry > all gestures available on this path.

- a. Gesture Motion
- b. Smart Motion
- c. Gesture Wake

Date & time

You can use Date & Time settings to set your preferences for how dates are displayed. You can also use these settings to set your own time and time zone, rather than obtaining the current time from the network,

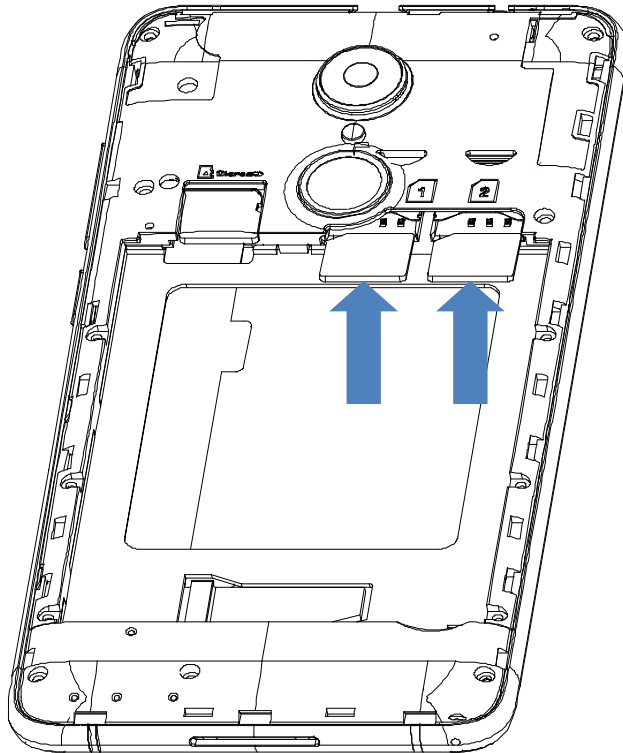
15. Precautions

This mobile phone is well designed with fine art. Please exercise special care when using it. The following suggestions will help your mobile phone survive the warranty period and extend its service life:

- 1) Keep the mobile phone and all its fittings beyond children's reach.

Charging your device

A rechargeable battery is used to power your phone. Charge the battery using the USB cable (power cord) and the charger (power outlet adapter) included with your phone. Make sure to fully charge the battery before using your phone for the first time.

WARNING! If the touchscreen won't function while the phone is in the process of charging, this may be due to an unstable power supply. If this occurs, disconnect the USB cable from the phone or unplug the charger from the power outlet.

Connect the USB cable to the travel adapter and insert the other end of the USB cable into the USB/Charging port.
