


Bluetooth Earphone



User Manual


Pairing



- Step 1. Long press the "Power button", you will hear "Power on" voice prompt, keep pressing the "Power button" until you hear "Pairing".
- Step 2. Activate Bluetooth on your device and keep it within 3 feet from the headphones while pairing.
- Step 3. Search "S39" on your device and click to connect, you will hear "Connected".

Earphone Function



Function	Icon	Operating method	Indicator
Power on	⏻	Long Press ⏻ Power button	Red and blue light flash alternately.
Power off	⏻	Long Press ⏻ Power button	Indicator turns red for 1 second.
Volume+	⏪	Click ⏪ button	Blue light flashes every 5 seconds.
Volume-	⏩	Click ⏩ button	Blue light flashes every 5 seconds.
Play/pause	⏮	Short press ⏮ button	Blue light flashes every 5 seconds.
Previous track	⏮	Long press ⏮ button	Blue light flashes every 5 seconds.
Next track	⏭	Long press ⏭ button	Blue light flashes every 5 seconds.
Answer the call	☎	Short press ⏻ button	Blue light flashes 2 times.
Reject the call	☎	Short press ⏻ button	Blue light flashes 2 times.
Redial last number	☎	Double click ⏻ button	Blue light flashes.

Sync Between 2 devices


1. Turn off the bluetooth of the 1st device, and restart the pairing mode.
2. Turn on the bluetooth of the 2nd device and search "S39", click pairing to connect;
3. Turn on the bluetooth of the 1st device again, and click pairing to finish pairing.

Activate Siri

1. Long press and hold the power button for 2 seconds, and then release.

Charge the headphones



1. Low battery: Red light will flash and with voice prompt;
2. Charging status: Red light will turn on when charging mode;
3. Finish charging: Blue light will turn on after fully charged.



Wearing Method

① Select and assemble the earbuds



Ear-hook


Earbuds

- ① Select your right size earbuds and ear-hooks.

- ② Respectively attach the ear-hooks and earbuds to the headphone (As shown).

Note: There are "L" and "R" marks on the ear-hooks. when attach, check the left or right, do not mix it.

② Wearing the earphone

Get the earbuds assembled together, insert the correct earbuds into your ear canal, adjust the earbuds to a suitable angle until you have a tight and snug fit.

Clean and maintenance

1. Please do not disassemble or modify the headphones.
2. Please keep the headphones away from liquid.
3. Please do not use the headphones in thunderstorm.
4. Please hold the headphones plug when unplug the power cord.
5. Please do not press the headphones wire too hard.
6. Please keep the headphones clean and dry when not using it.

Troubleshooting

1.The headphones is not comfortable to wear, feel pain , easy to fall ?

- Please choose the suitable earbuds .
- Make sure the left and right earbuds assemble correctly.

2.Can not turn the headphones ON

- Please make sure the headphones are charged. If not , charge them, and try again.

3.Can not connect the headphones to your device

- Make sure the headphones are fully charged.
- Go to your device's Bluetooth menu and delete all saved devices from the list by clicking "Forget this device".
- Turn OFF bluetooth, then turn ON.
- Enter the headphones into the pairing mode and follow instructions for connecting.

4.Do not have sound

- Please check if the headphones connected with the device, if connected, adjusting volume of device or headphones volume.

Troubleshooting

5.Frequent disconnection and noise

- Please check if the headphones or the device already low power;
- Ensure the distance between your device and the headphones is within 33 feet/10 meters.
- Ensure nothing is blocking the signal between your device and your Bluetooth headphones.

6.The headphones cannot reconnect automatically

- Ensure the distance between your device and the headphones is within 33 feet/10 meters.
- Please simultaneously long press button "volume +" and "volume-" until the red and blue light flash 3 times alternately, then reconnect the headphones.

7. Can not charge the headphones

- It takes about 20 minutes for charging to be activated to realize normal charging;
- The internal components of the headphones or the phone have been damaged, we advise to replace the other device.
