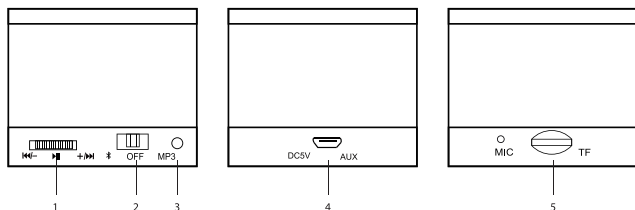


HB031 Bluetooth Speaker Instruction Manual

Thank you for choosing our wireless Bluetooth Speaker! Before you use the speaker make sure to completely charge the device, and become familiar with the Bluetooth function on your paired devices.

How to use the Bluetooth Speaker

The General Features



1. Volume Knob:

- (1).Volume control : Long-turn left or right the knob to reduce or add volume
- (2).Last and next music control : short-turn left or right the knob to change to the previous or next track
- (3).Short press inwards to stop playing and short press again to play.
- (4).Phone call control : Long-press inwards to reject the call;short-press inwards to answer call

2. On/Off Button:

Bluetooth mode: Pull the switch to "Bluetooth" to enter into Bluetooth mode.

Aux-in mode: Pull the switch to "MP3" to enter into Aux-in mode.

FM mode: Pull the switch to "MP3" and long press inwards the knob "1" to enter into FM mode.

3. Status light.

4. Charging port: Plug the provided cable into this port and other side (USB) to DC 5V power source.

5. TF card playing: After inserting the TF card, the product will get into TF card the product will playing mode. It can ready to play music with MP3 or WAV format.

Pairing with Mobile Device

The speaker needs to be connected with a Mobile Device to use the wireless Bluetooth function. If the mobile device has paired with a Bluetooth speaker previously, the match will finish automatically.

- Active Bluetooth mode on mobile device and turn speaker ON. Speaker will automatically enter pairing mode.
- Search for the Bluetooth Speaker from your mobile device
- Mobile device will display the Bluetooth Speaker as "HB031" in list of available devices. Select pair.
- Follow instruction on mobile device to complete pairing. If pass-code is needed, enter "0000"
- After the Mobile Device and Bluetooth Speaker connect, sound can be controlled from the Volume Buttons(1)
