


Fame Bluetooth Speaker Instruction Manual SM-3955

Thank you for choosing our wireless Bluetooth Speaker! Before you use the speaker make sure to completely charge the device, and become familiar with the Bluetooth functions on your paired devices.

How to use the Bluetooth Speaker

A. The General Features



1. On/Off Switch

Switch the On/Off button from left to right to power the device ON or OFF

2. Charging & Line-in interface

- Make sure to charge device while not in use. Plug the USB power or adapter power to charge the speaker.

3. PREV/Volume Plus Button

Click the "+" button to play the previous track. Hold in the "+" to add volume

4. NEXT/Volume Less Button

Click the "-" button to play the next track. Hold in the "-" to lessen the volume

Pairing with Mobile Device

The speaker needs to be connected with a Mobile Device to use the wireless Bluetooth functions. If the mobile device has paired with a bluetooth speaker previously, the match will finish automatically.

- Activate Bluetooth mode on mobile device and turn speaker ON. Speaker will automatically enter pairing mode.
- Search for the Bluetooth Speaker from your mobile device
- Mobile device will display the Bluetooth speaker as "Fame" in list of available devices. Select pair.
- Follow instruction on mobile device to complete pairing. If pass-code is needed, enter "0000"
- After the Mobile Device and Bluetooth Speaker connect, sound can be controlled from the Volume Buttons (3, 4).
