

Use Instructions



Read the <u>ENTIRE IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION</u> section at the beginning of this document including all text under subheadings therein before use of this product.

Note: This is a delicate instrument. The Micrometer should be handled carefully. Dropping this product could damage it, and may affect accuracy.

- Use a clean, lint-free cloth to clean the Anvil faces of the Micrometer and the object being measured.
- Open the Micrometer, by rotating the Thimble counterclockwise, until it is wider than the object to be measured.
- Place the Anvil around the object, then turn the Thimble clockwise until the Anvil just touches the object.
- Turn the Ratchet Stop clockwise to close the Anvil on the object being measured until it clicks.

Note: To avoid damage to either the Micrometer or the workpiece, only use the Ratchet Stop to close the Anvil of the Micrometer on the object.

- Turn the Thimble Lock clockwise to lock the measurement and carefully withdraw the Micrometer from the object.
- This Micrometer measures items in thousandths of an Inch. View the Display underneath the Thimble Lock to see the results.
- To calculate ten thousandths of an inch, refer to the number line on the Thimble. Add the number indicated onto the end of the number in the Display.

- · loose screws,
