Mounting Instructions



Read the **ENTIRE IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION** section at the beginning of this document including all text under subheadings therein before set up or use of this product.

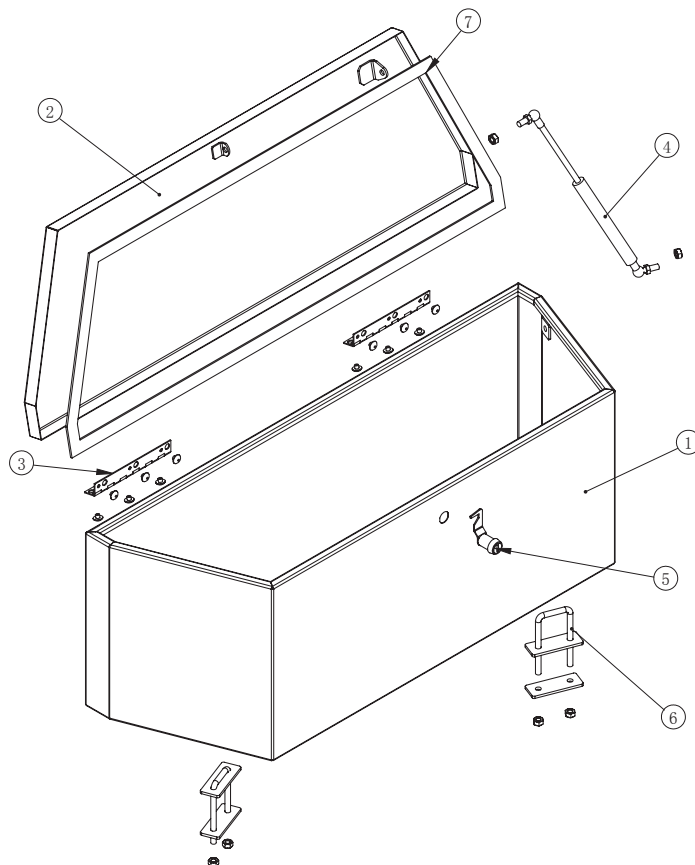
1. Place the Box on the trailer tongue (not supplied) with the wider part near the trailer.
 2. Insert a "U" bolt through one of the Plates. Insert the legs of the "U" Bolt through the holes in the bottom of the Box to straddle the trailer tongue bar. Repeat with the other "U" Bolt.
 3. Fit a Plate over the legs of a "U" Bolt and hold in place with two Nuts. Repeat for other side.
 4. Tighten all 4 Nuts, firmly clamping the Box onto the trailer tongue.
- NOTE:** Two keys are provided. Keep these in a safe place when not in use.
5. Occasionally apply a lock lubricant to the lock to keep it in good condition.
