

Warnings (continued)

- 3. Use the right tool for the right job. Do not attempt to force a small tool or attachment to do the work of a larger industrial tool. There are certain applications for which these tools were designed. Do not modify these tools and do not use these tools for a purpose for which they were not intended.
- 4. Avoid working alone. If an accident happens, an assistant can bring help.
- 5. Keep work area clean. Cluttered areas invite injuries.
- 6. Keep children away. Children must never be allowed in the work area. Do not let them handle machines, tools, or extension cords.
- 7. Store idle equipment. When not in use, tools must be stored in a dry location to inhibit rust. Always lock up tools and keep out of reach of children.
- 8. Dress properly. Do not wear loose clothing or jewelry as they can be caught in moving parts. Protective, electrically nonconductive clothes and nonskid footwear are recommended when working. Wear restrictive hair covering to contain long hair.
- 9. Do not overreach. Keep proper footing and balance at all times. Do not reach over or across electrical cables or frames.
- 10. Stay alert. Watch what you are doing; use common sense. Do not operate any tool when you are tired.
- 11. Replacement parts and accessories. When servicing, use only identical replacement parts. Use of any other parts will void the warranty. Only use accessories intended for use with this tool. Approved accessories are available from Harbor Freight Tools.
- 12. Do not operate tool if under the influence of alcohol or drugs. Read warning labels on prescriptions to determine if your judgment or reflexes are impaired while taking drugs. If there is any doubt, do not operate the tool.
- 13. Before each use, inspect the router bits for cracking or other damage. Never use a damaged router bit.
- 14. Mount the bit securely and be sure all guards are in place.
- 15. Failure to follow all safety instructions and warnings can result in serious bodily injury.
