

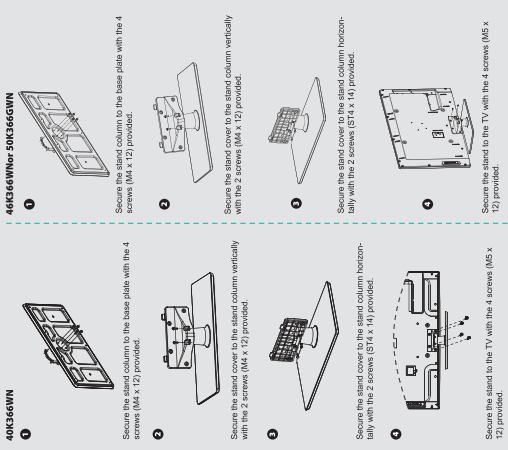

### 2 INSTALLING THE STAND

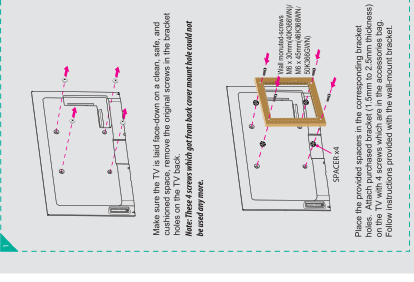
Follow the illustrations below to complete the installation steps.

### 3 INSTALLING A WALL-MOUNT BRACKET

If you want to attach the TV to a wall-mount bracket (not provided), you should first remove the stand (if it is pre-attached) (see Step 1).



Make sure the TV is laid face-down on a clean, safe, and level surface. Do not touch the screen surface with your hands. Do not touch the screen surface with any sharp objects. **Note:** These screws will not fit from back cover mount their end for best any case.

Place the provided spacers in the corresponding bracket holes on the TV back. Attach purchased bracket (1.5mm to 2.0mm thickness) on the TV with 4 screws which are in the accessories bag. Follow instructions provided with the wall-mount bracket.

**Power:** Turns the TV on or off.

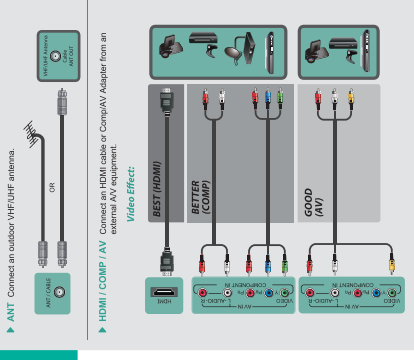
**Input:** Select source to watch.

**Hi-Smart:** Press to browse the services apps in Hi-Smart Home UI. The apps in the Home UI let you watch movies, listen to music, and much more.

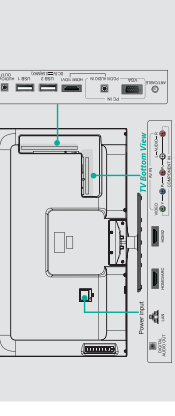
**Netflix:** Press to launch NETFLIX instant video streaming.

### 8 Turning the TV On for the First Time

**MENU OPERATIONS**

- Please press [ENTER] then press [▲▼] to select your language. English, Spanish or French, select [Next] to confirm enter the Welcome screen.
- In the Welcome screen introduced the available input devices and interfaces.
- Please press [▲▼] to select the country where you will operate the TV.
- Select the local time zone according to your region.
- Daylight Saving: Set the Daylight Saving time for your area.
- Select your Mode Setting: Home Mode or Retail Mode.
- Home Message Adapters: Are you sure to change to retail mode? Select "OK" to continue, or select "No" to change your selection.
- Home Mode is the recommended setting which offers full functionality of the television. If you selected Retail Mode, Energy Saving is not available.

**Note:** If you are using a cable or satellite box and you have connected to the TV using a Coaxial cable, you should select the cable option. Be sure the cable or satellite box is powered on before starting the Channel Scan. If you are using a satellite box connected to the TV, Component or HDMI, you don't need to start for channels.

When there is something wrong with your TV, you can try turning off the TV and restarting it. You can also refer to the following chart for problem and solutions. If the problem cannot be resolved, please contact Hisense for additional assistance.

SYMPTOMS	POSSIBLE SOLUTIONS
No sound or picture	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Confirm power cord is plugged into the AC outlet and the AC outlet is getting electricity.</li> <li>• Attempt to power on using the power button on both the TV and the Remote.</li> </ul>
Picture is normal, but no sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check the volume settings.</li> <li>• Check if mute mode is set "on".</li> </ul>
I have connected an external picture and/or audio device	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check network physical connection, make sure connection is correct.</li> <li>• Enter "Menu", "Network", "Configuration", "Connection Test" to make sure that network connection test is successful.</li> <li>• Check network physical connection, make sure connection is correct.</li> <li>• Check network physical connection, make sure configuration is correct according to your network service provider.</li> <li>• Enter "Menu", "Network", "Applications", "Netflix", "Description" to reset "Netflix" account.</li> </ul>
Network connection fail.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• You need a broadband (high speed) internet service with speed of no less than 1.5 Mbps.</li> <li>• Check network physical connection, make sure connection is correct.</li> <li>• Check network physical connection, make sure configuration is correct.</li> <li>• Check network physical connection, make sure configuration is correct according to your network service provider.</li> <li>• Before calling for services, check the following information for possible solutions to problems you may experience.
