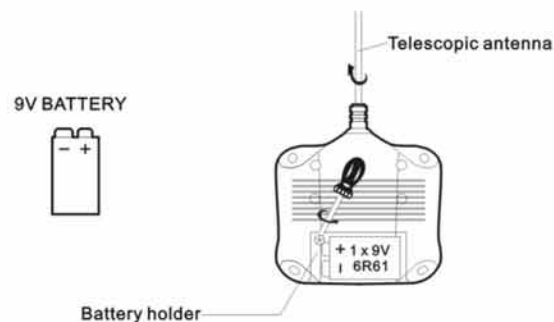

- Please note the user cannot modify this product.

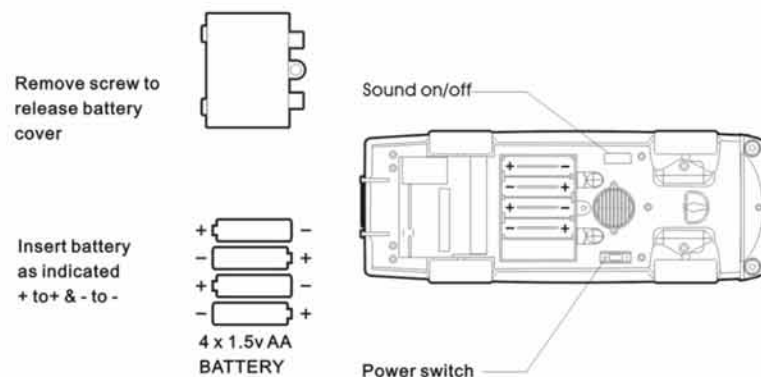
Battery Installation - Controller:

- Set power switch to "Off".
- Release screw on battery compartment cover and slide cover to open.
- Insert 1 x 9V battery and be guided with correct marking (+) & (-).
- Close battery compartment and fasten the screw.



Battery Installation - Vehicle:

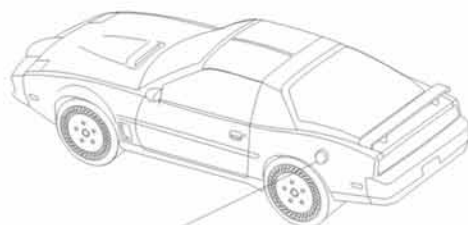
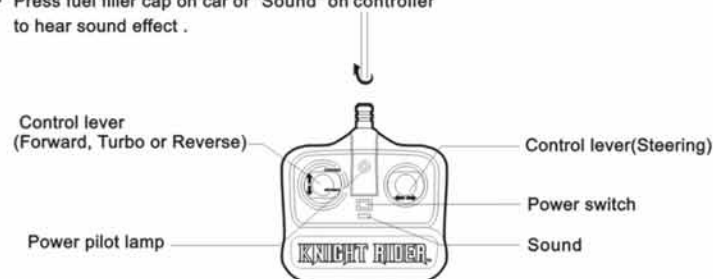
- Set power switch to "Off".
- Release screw to remove battery cover.
- Insert batteries with correct polarity.
- Close battery cover and fasten screw.





Operation Instruction on Hand controller and Vehicle:

- Set power switch of hand controller and vehicle to "On" .
- Set sound on/off switch on vehicle to "On" .
- Press **Left** control lever for **Forward, Turbo or Reverse**.
- Press **Right** control lever for **Right or Left** turns.
- Switch off controller and vehicle after use.
- Press fuel filler cap on car or "Sound" on controller to hear sound effect .



• Caution!

- Do not pick up the vehicle whilst product is switched on or in motion, keep fingers, hair and clothing clear from wheels.
- If a child under 8 operates the toy -- Adult supervision is required.
- To avoid accidental operation -- Remove Battery and 9V battery when not in use.
- Wires and antennas are not to be inserted into socket outlets.
- Do not put the car too close to ear when the sound effect is activating.

• Useful Hints and Tips:

- The vehicle can be operated up to 20 metres away over a flat open area.
- Range and performance of car can be affected / reduced by any surrounding structures and buildings.
- Battery life for controller is much greater than the vehicle's battery life and should last at least 120 minutes. Battery life depends on how the product is being used.
- Do not operate toy on sand, mud, water or thick carpets.
- Run on smooth flat surface.
- Remember to turn the controller and vehicle off after use.
- Sound effect can still be activated when the car is power off, remove batteries to prevent accidental activation or switch off the sound.
- Keep packaging for reference as it contains important information.



Trouble Shooting:

- Toy not responding to controller - Check if the battery is inserted with correct polarity and making good contact, or replace battery if suspected exhausted.
- Toy slow and less responsive - Replace batteries.
- If vehicle is still not operating properly the cause could be interference from another source, try operating in a different location.
- See important notes and ensure compliance.

Important Notes:

- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Only use 006P alkaline battery for transmitter only.
- Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
- The battery terminals are not to be short -circuited.
- Batteries are to be removed from the toy when not in use.
- Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed.
- Non rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Do not use rechargeable batteries.
