




Battery and Antenna Installation

For Vehicle

1. Switch OFF the power
2. Unscrew the screw on the battery cover
3. Open the battery cover
4. Install AA battery pack with correct polarities (+/-) as shown inside the battery compartment
5. Close the battery cover
6. Tighten the screw on the battery cover

Battery Requirement

1. Tank: 6 x AA Batteries
2. Remote: 1 x 9V battery



For Remote

1. Switch OFF the power
2. Unscrew the screw on the battery cover
3. Open the battery cover
4. Install 1 new 9V battery with correct polarity (+/-) as shown inside the battery compartment
5. Close the battery cover
6. Tighten the screw on the battery cover
7. Insert the antenna into the top of Transmitter, tighten it by rotating clockwise (viewing from top of Remote)

Use of alkaline batteries is recommended.

Rechargeable AA batteries can also be used.

Performance of the tank may vary due to rechargeable batteries.

Some brands may not be recommended.

Please check before use.

Operation and running times are approximate.

Performance of the tank may vary upon: battery used, road conditions, way of operations, etc.

Incorrect use of rechargeable batteries will lead to leakage, fire, overheat, etc.

Please beware of the following:

- Please follow the charger instruction when charging.
- Please do not short circuit. It is very dangerous for the large current flow.
- Please do not put into fire, decompose, remodel the battery.

Incorrect use of batteries will lead to leakage, fire, overheat, etc.

Please beware of the following:

- Please do not mix with old batteries and new batteries.
- Please correctly place the polarity - (+) and (-).
- Please make sure the power is switched off and batteries are taken out from the car and remote after play.
- Please do not short circuit, put into fire, heat and decompose the batteries.
- If leakage gets into the eye(s), please rinse the impacted eye(s) with plenty of water immediately and consult with physician.
- If leakage adheres to skin and /or clothing, please rinse the impacted area with water immediately.

- Please always turn off the power switches on the car body and remote after playing. Forgetting to turn off the power will cause current flow and use up of the batteries.

- If there is a time delay on the control, please replace the batteries with new ones.



How to Play Switch ON the Tank / Switch OFF the Tank after playing



Performance Tips

1. Do not drive on grass, dirt, sand, dust, carpet or go through water
2. Do not drive in windy or rainy weather
3. Remember to switch OFF the power of the Tank and Remote after playing
4. Play on smooth surface to have the optimum performance
5. The optimum control range is up to 50ft outdoor
6. Avoid direct impact the Vehicle with obstacles
7. Switch OFF the power when not in use to prevent damage of Vehicle and Transmitter due to leakage of electrolyte from batteries
8. Remove all batteries from the Vehicle and Transmitter when not in use for long period
9. Keep fingers, hair and loose clothing away from wheels
10. The operating range can be affected by a variety of factors
 - a) Low Voltage of batteries in Transmitter or Vehicle
 - b) Interference from other items that emit radio frequency signals
11. Outdoor usage is recommended in order to get optimum control range
12. Recommend to play the vehicle on a clean and smooth surface
13. Clean the battery compartment to make sure it is free from dust to prevent poor contact of batteries

Cautions

1. Do not attempt to disassemble the Tank or Remote
2. Do not operate the Tank with same frequency with other player(s) in same location that will interfere and make the Tank out of control.
3. Make sure the batteries are installed with correct polarities (+/-) as shown inside the battery compartment
4. Remove the package and take out all accessories before giving the Tank and Remote to child to play
