### Basic operation

#### Charging the battery:

Connect the tablet to a wall outlet using the included AC adaptor.

#### Turning on the tablet

Press and hold the **Q** button until the startup screen appears.

#### Power off the tablet

Press & hold the **Q** button until the "Power off" option appears.

#### Lock the tablet (standby)

Briefly press the **Q** button. Lock the device to conserve the battery.

#### Unlock the tablet

Slide the "Lock icon" to the right.

#### Battery Tip:

- Turn off Wi-Fi when it's not in use.
- Lock the tablet the device is off to shorten charging time.
- To optimise battery time and performance, adjust the "Brightness" and "Screen timeout" options in the Settings app.

### Connecting to Wi-Fi

#### Setting up Wi-Fi

To browse web sites, use e-mail and download apps, you must first connect the tablet to the internet.

- Swipe the Home screen to the left to access the Settings widget.
- Select "Wi-Fi".

#### Micro SD card

The tablet supports Micro SD cards up to 32GB (not included). To install a Micro SD card into the tablet, insert the card as shown below, into the card slot and slide and lock into place.

### Downloading apps

#### Downloading apps & other app stores

Your tablet includes an app store with access to a large selection of free & paid apps and games. However, for your convenience, we have provided links to several other app stores that can be easily accessed by selecting the "Download App Stores" option on the Settings widget.

- After successfully connecting the tablet to Wi-Fi, select "Download" on the Settings widget.
- Select an app store, and follow the instructions to download and install it on the tablet.

#### Using the wireless Bluetooth® keyboard

#### Power indicator light

#### Turning the keyboard on / off

Slide the switch as shown above, the indicator light will briefly turn on.

#### Pairing the keyboard to the tablet

- Turn on the keyboard.
- Press the **Pair** button, the Bluetooth indicator light will blink and the keyboard is ready to pair with the tablet.

#### Charging the keyboard:

Connect the keyboard to a wall outlet using the included AC adaptor or connect directly to a PC.
