

Getting Started

The figures in this document are provided only for your reference. The phone that you have purchased may differ from that shown.

Front View



1	Left function key	Press this key to select the menu option in the lower left corner of the screen.	
2	Navigation keys	In standby mode, press OK to access the main menu. In standby mode, press a navigation key to access the specific shortcut menu. During a call, press left or right navigation key to adjust the call volume.	
3	Right function key	Press this key to select the menu option in the lower right corner of the screen.	
4	Power indicator	The power indicator is steady red when the phone is connected to a power supply.	
5	End key	End a call or reject an incoming call. Press and hold this key to power the phone on or off. In non-standby mode, press this key to return to the standby mode.	

6	Hands-free key	Make or answer a call without lifting the handset. Cancel the dialing, when dialing a number in the hands-free mode. End the current call during a call in the hands-free mode.	
7	Call key	Make or answer a call. View the call history in standby mode.	
8	Number and Symbol keys	Press the keys to input numbers or characters. Key 1: In standby mode, press and hold this key to access voicemail. Key 2 to 9: In standby mode, press and hold these keys for speed dialing. Key *: In edit mode, press this key to open the symbol list. Key #: In edit mode, press this key to switch the input method.



Installing

Installing the SIM Card

Before installing the SIM card, ensure that the phone is powered off and disconnected from the power adapter.

When installing the SIM card, ensure that the gold contact area faces down, that the beveled edge of the SIM card aligns with that of the SIM card slot, and that the SIM card is fully inserted.








Do not frequently remove or insert the SIM card when using the phone.

Installing the Battery

Before installing the battery, ensure that the phone is powered off and disconnected from the power adapter. Ensure that the battery cable is correctly connected and that the battery poles are not reversed.





Charging the Battery



- Remove the battery if the phone is left unused for a long period.
- The battery supplies power for only a limited period. Ensure that the battery has been fully charged before using the phone without the line power supply connected.
- If the battery has not been used for a long time or the battery is exhausted, the screen of the phone may not function when you charge the battery again. This is normal. After the battery is being charged for a while, you can power on the phone for use.

Power on the Phone

To power the phone on, press and hold the 0 until the screen lights up. In standby mode, press and hold to power off the phone. **Call Functions** 1. In standby mode, press the number keys to input the phone number.

Making a Call

- Press ot to call the number.
- Press (t) to end a call or cancel the dialing.
- In standby mode, press ot to view the call history. Select number and press to make the call. In Phonebook, select a contact and press to make the call.

Answering or Rejecting a Call

When there is an incoming call, press ot to answer the call; press to reject the call.

Messages

Creating a Message

- Select Short Message > Write message.
- Write the message.
- Press ok and then add a recipient using the following methods:
- Enter the recipient's phone number.
- Add the recipient from the phonebook.
- Press or to send the message.

Reading a Message

The phone stores received messages in the inbox.

1. Select Short Message > Inbox.

- 2. Press to scroll to a message in the list.
- 3. Press $(o\kappa)$ to read the message.
- 4. Press the left function key to manage the message.

Input Method

Switching Between Input Methods

In edit mode, press # key to switch between text input methods.



- In edit mode, press the right function key to delete the character to the left of the cursor, press and hold the right function key to delete all characters.
- In the s ABC or s abc input mode, press 0 key to enter a space. In the ABC, abc or Abc input mode, press 0 key once to enter a space, twice to enter "0"
- In any input mode, press * key to open symbol list.

s ABC/s abc

Enter a word in **s ABC** or **s abc** input mode, do the following steps:

- Press the keys labeled with the letters required to spell the desired word once according to the spelling sequence of the word.
 As you enter letters, the phone attempts to predict the desired word and displays candidate words.
- 2. Press to select the desired word.
- 3. Press to confirm the selection and press to enter the word. You can also press the **0** key to confirm the selection to enter the word followed by a space.

ABC/abc/Abc

In ABC, abc, or Abc input method, press the number keys to enter letters. Press a number key repeatedly until the desired character appears. If the next letter you want to enter is on the same key as the current one, wait until the current letter is entered, and then enter the next one.

Number Input

- In 123 input method, enter a desired number by pressing the number key.
- In other input method, enter a desired number by pressing and holding the number key.

Symbols

- 1. In any input mode, press * key to display a symbol list.
- 2. Press the navigation key to select the desired symbol.
- Press to enter the symbol.

FM Radio

To listen to the radio, select Extra > FM radio. Press to change channel, press to decrease or increase the volume.

You can select Options for the following options:

- Radio On/Off: To turn the radio on or off.
- Channel list: To display the channel list.
- Manual input: To input a frequency manually.
- Auto search: To search channels automatically.
- Settings: To set whether to play the radio in background.

Settings

Speed Dial

To set status and numbers for speed dial, select **Phonebook > Options > Phonebook settings > Speed dial**. Press and hold **2** to **9** number keys to dial the saved number directly in standby mode.

Phone Lock

To set the phone lock, select **Settings > Security settings > Phone security**. You can change the default code (**1234**) to any number string of four to eight digits.



When restoring the phone to factory settings, you must enter the correct phone lock code.

PIN and PUK

A personal identification number (PIN) protects your SIM card from unauthorized use.

If you incorrectly enter the PIN a pre-defined number of times, the PIN is blocked and the phone prompts you to enter the PIN unblocking key (PUK). If this occurs, enter the PUK to unblock the blocked PIN.

Both the PIN and the PUK are provided with your SIM card. For details, contact your service provider.
