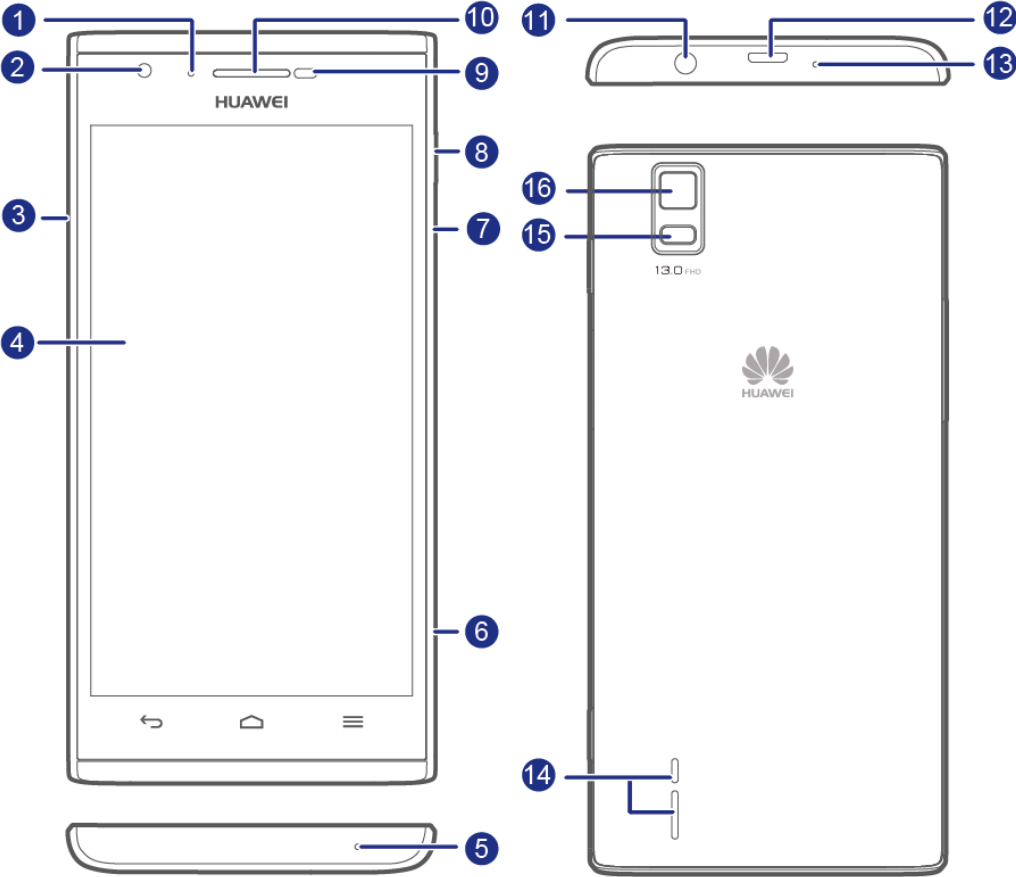

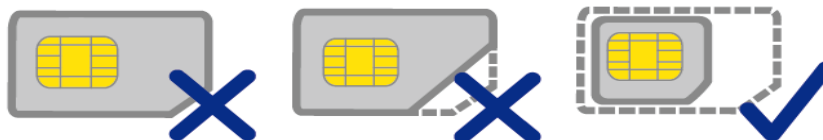

1.4.1 How Do I Open the Battery Cover?

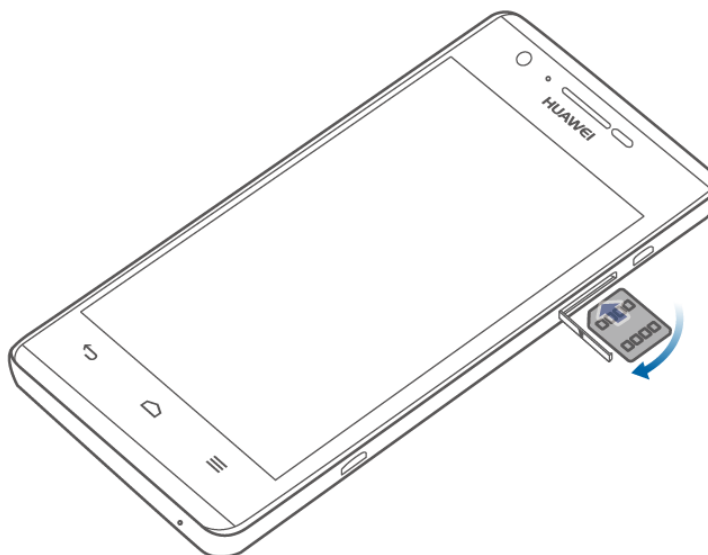

Install the SIM card according to the following figure.



Press the SIM card to the card slot completely.

1.4.3 Installing a MicroSD Card

P2-6070 does not support the microSD card.

1.4.4 Installing the Battery

The battery is not removable.

1.5 Home Screen

1.5.1 How Do I Add or Delete a Home Screen?

As shown in the figure, pinch together to quickly add/delete a home screen.

Figure 1-1 Home screen editing

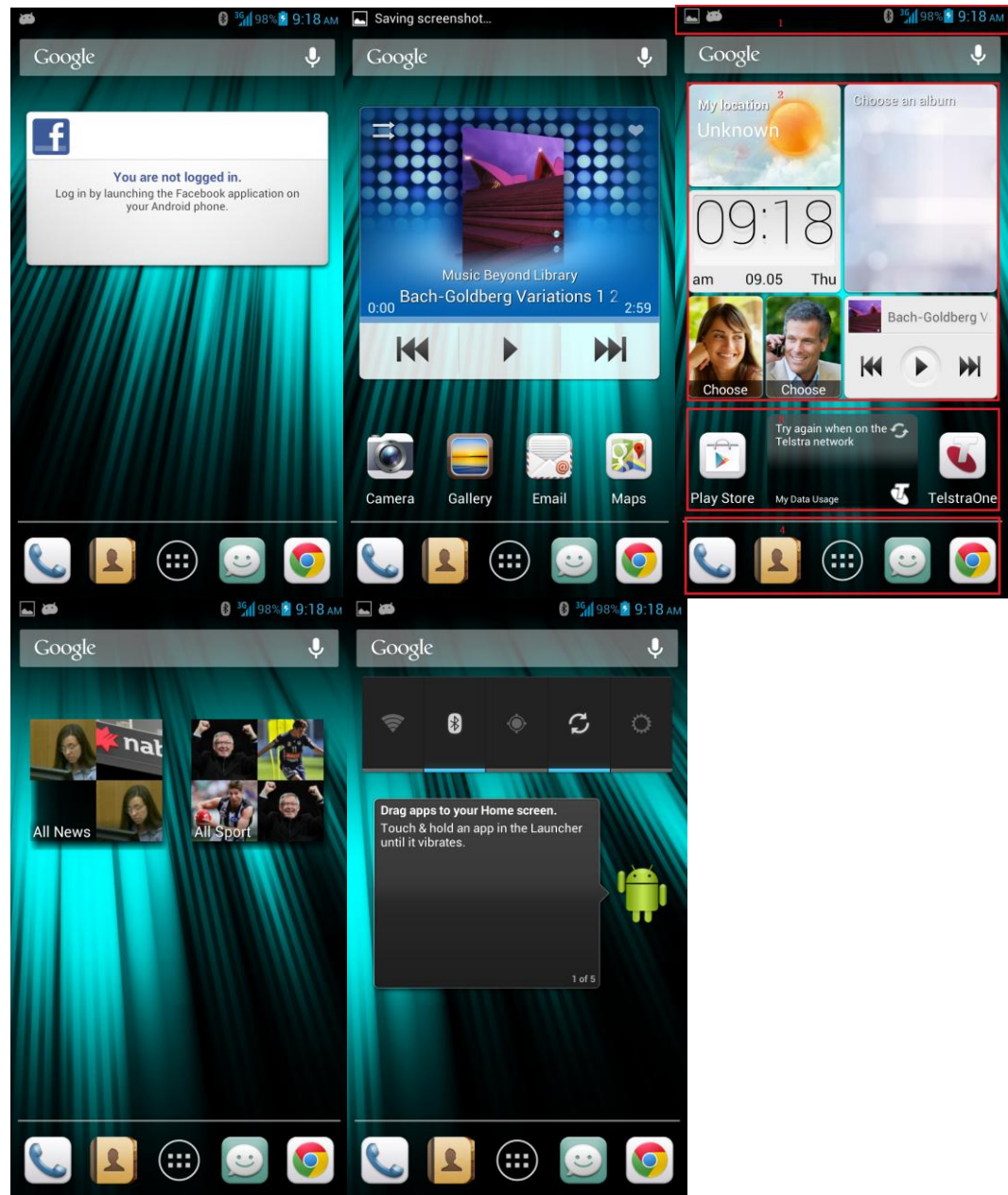


2D/3D switch: P2-6070 does not support 3D desktop.

1.5.2 The home screen

P2-6070 uses the Android UI. The home screen is the idle interface. By default, there are four screens. You can slide the screens. You can create shortcuts for applications and widgets on the Home screen, and touch the corresponding icon to open the application or widget. Figure 1-2 shows the screenshot of the home screen. Number 1 is the signal area. Number 2 is the widget area. Number 3 is the shortcut area. Number 4 is the dock area, where shortcut icons are placed. These icons do not move as the screen moves.

Icons on the home screen can be application shortcut icons and widgets. To create a folder, drag an application icon onto another shortcut icon. A folder containing both applications is then created.

Figure 1-2 Application list

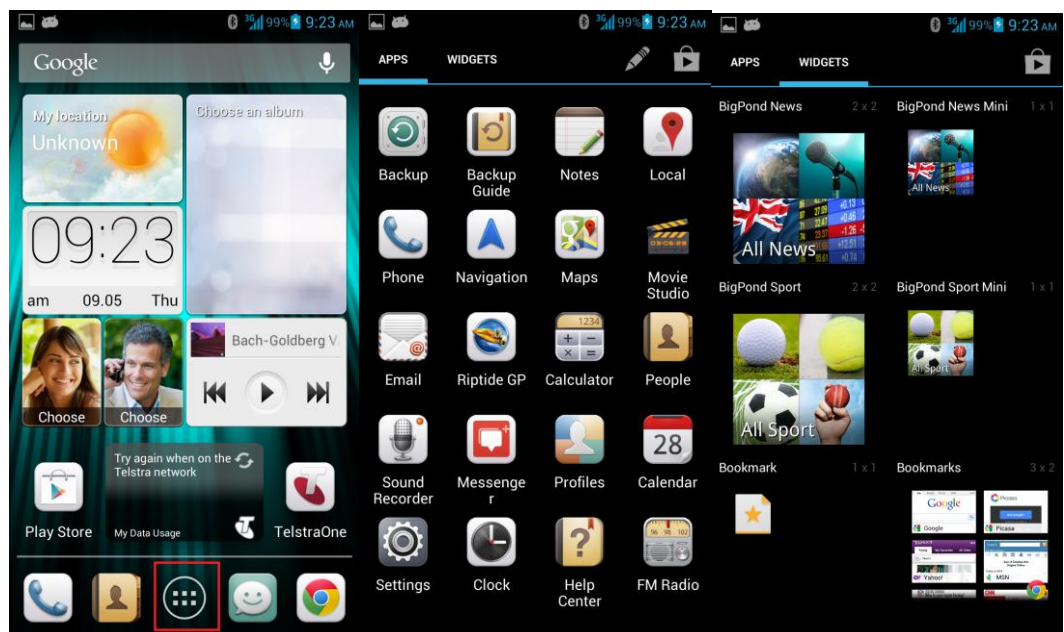
1.5.3 Application List Editing

You can long press the icons and widgets to edit them, including dragging to location as shown in the figure and deleting the item.



1.5.4 How to Add Shortcut Icons to the Desktop

On the application list, Long press a app or a widget and drag it to the blank area.

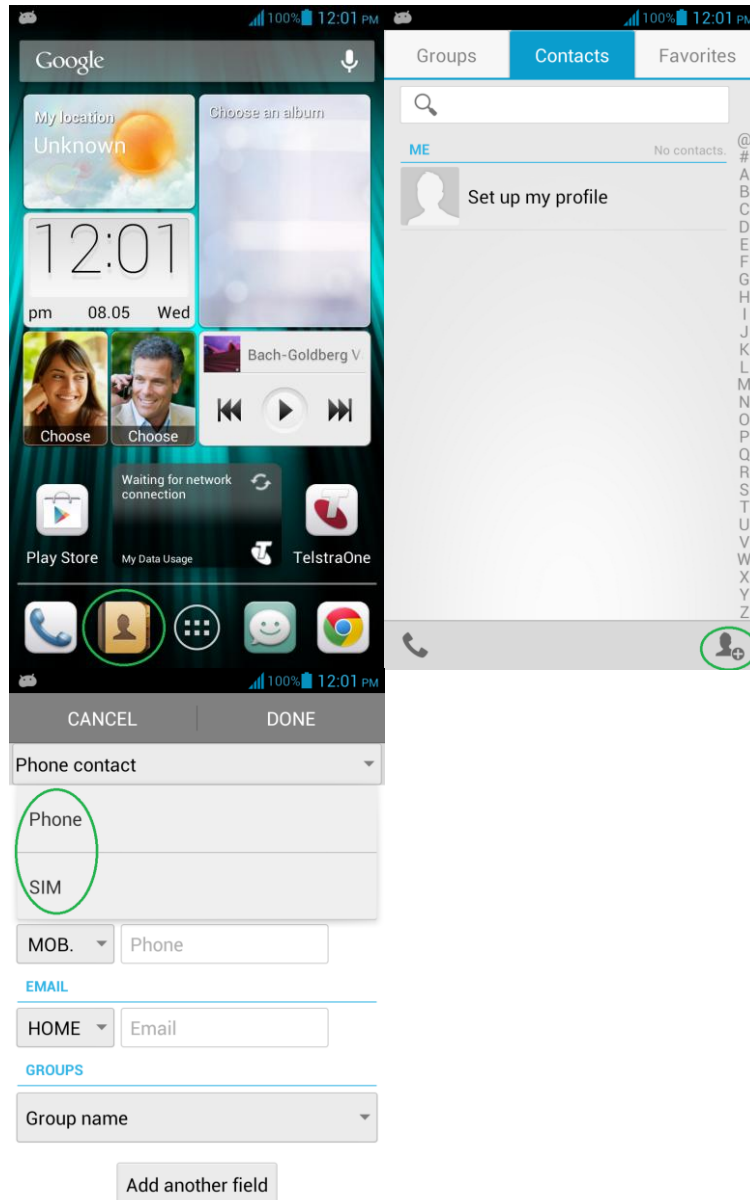


1.6 Contacts

1.6.1 How Do I Create a New Contact or a Fullscreen Caller?

1. Creating a contact

Open **People** > **Add a contact**, and select the storage directory. Enter the contact editing interface, enter the contact information, and touch **DONE**.

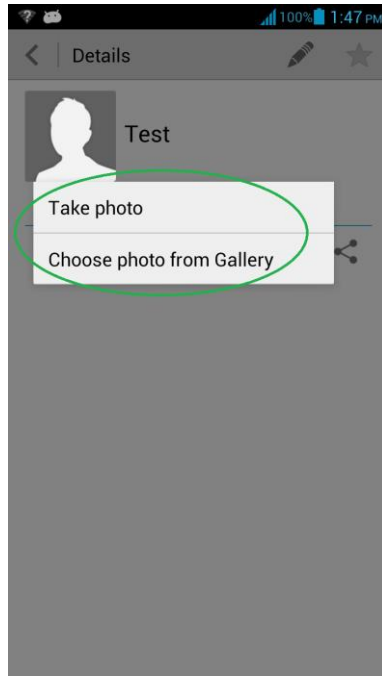


2. Creating a fullscreen caller (FScaller)

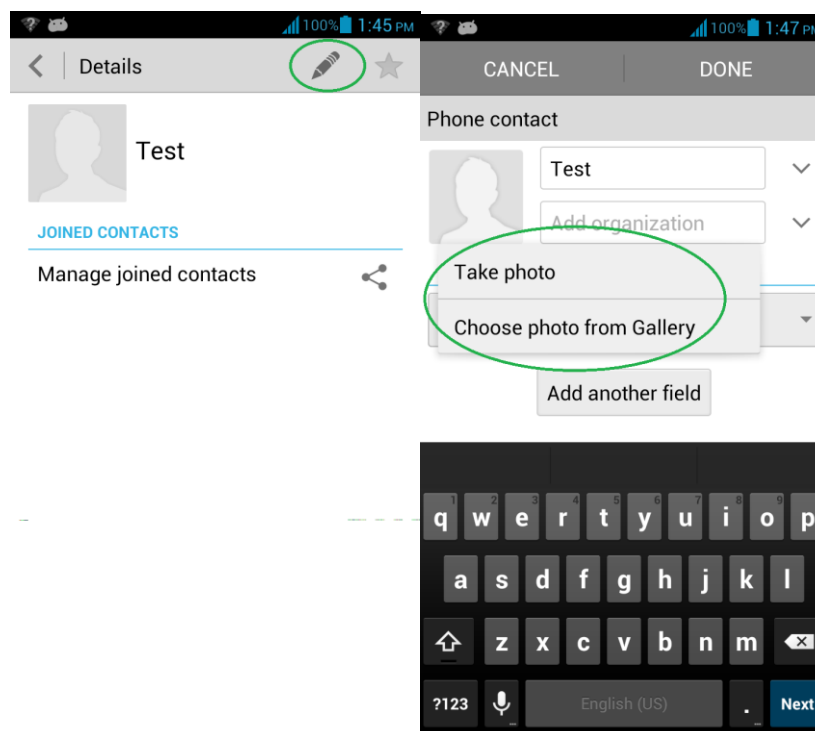
 NOTE

FScaller is not supported for contacts stored in the SIM card, but is supported for contacts stored in the phone.

Method 1: Open **People**. Click the profile picture of the contact and choose a picture from the gallery or take a photo for the contact.



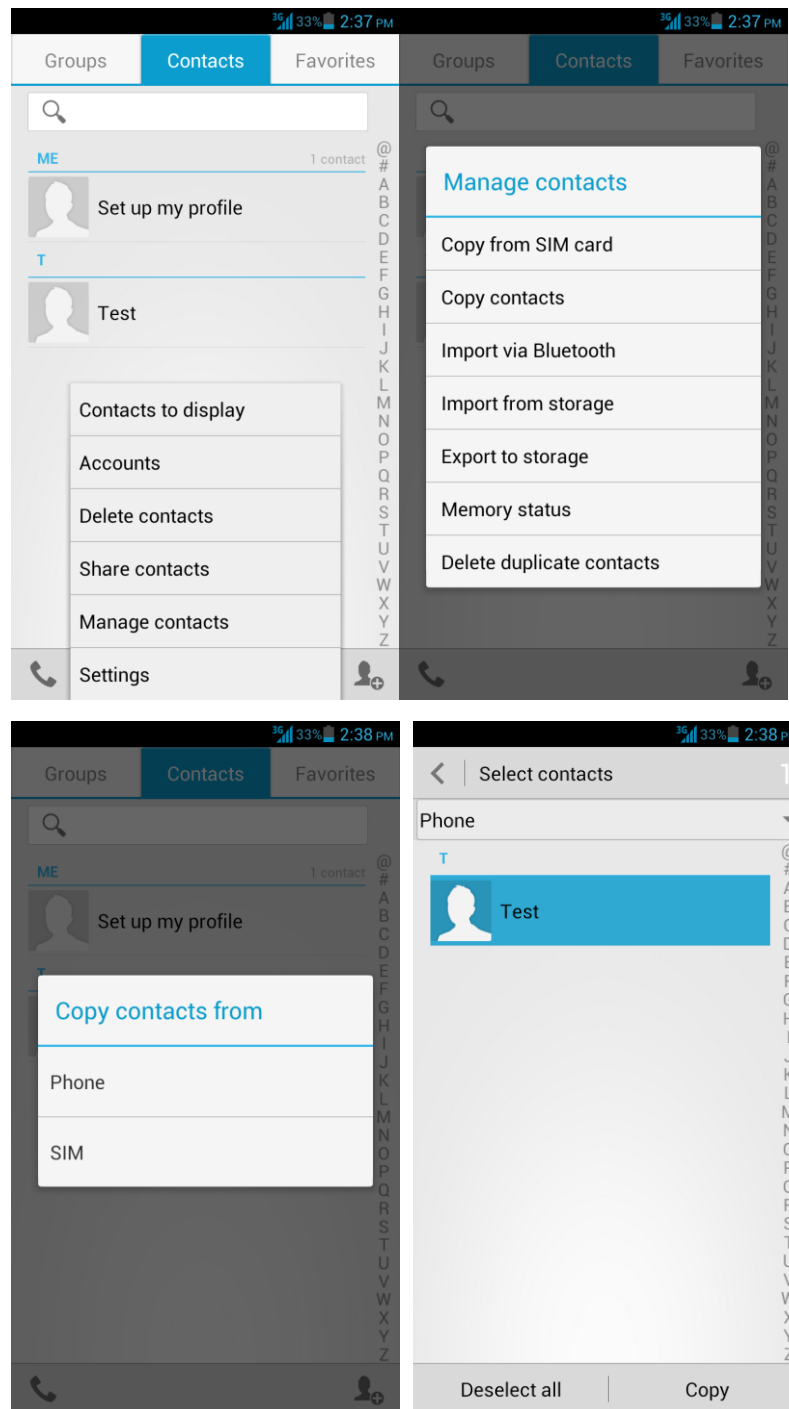
Method 2: Open the profile of a contact and click the modify button. Click the profile picture of the contact and take a photo or choose a photo from the gallery as the FScaller for the contact.

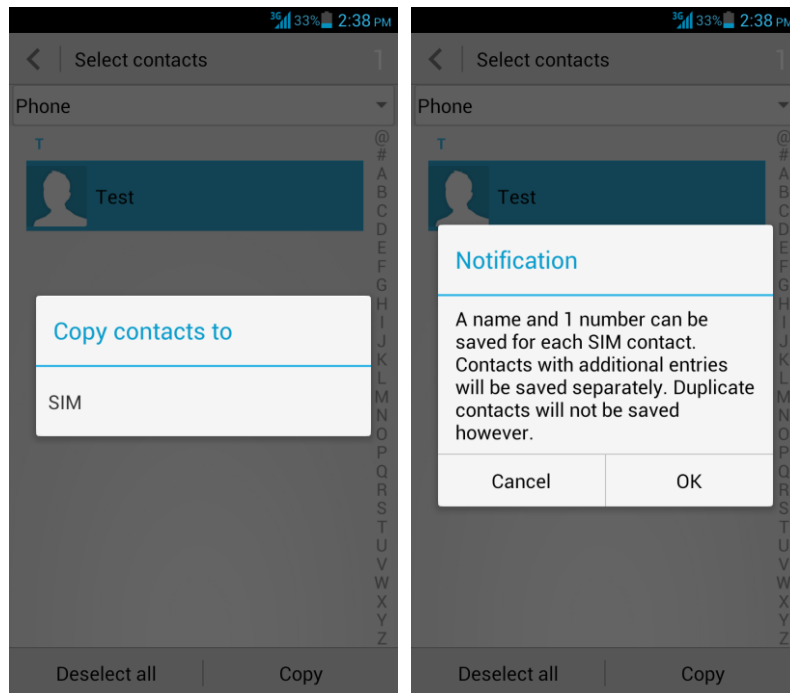


1.6.2 How Do I Import Contacts from or Export Contacts to the SIM Card?

1. Export contacts to the SIM card.

Enter **People > Menu > Manage contacts > Copy contacts > Phone**. Select the contact to be copied and click **Copy > SIM > OK**.





2. Import contacts from the SIM card.

Enter **People > Menu > Manage contacts > Copy contacts > SIM**. Select the contact to be copied and click **Copy > Phone > OK**.

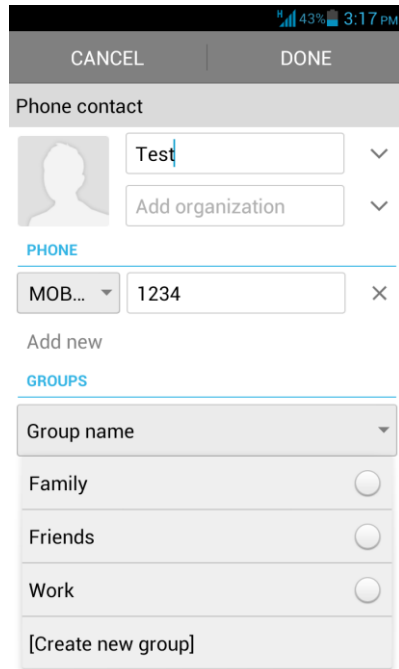
1.6.3 How Many Contacts Can I Save to My Phone?

The phone is alleged to support no less than 2000 contacts. The number of contacts supported by a SIM card is determined by the storage space of the card.

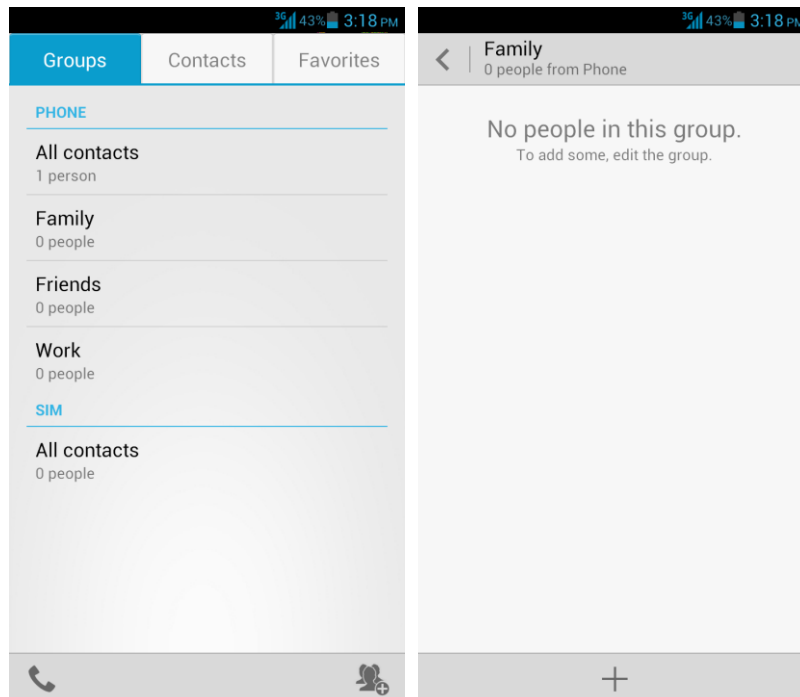
1.6.4 How Can I Create a Contact Group?

There are two methods to add a contact to a contact group:

Method 1: Select **Group** in the contact editing interface.



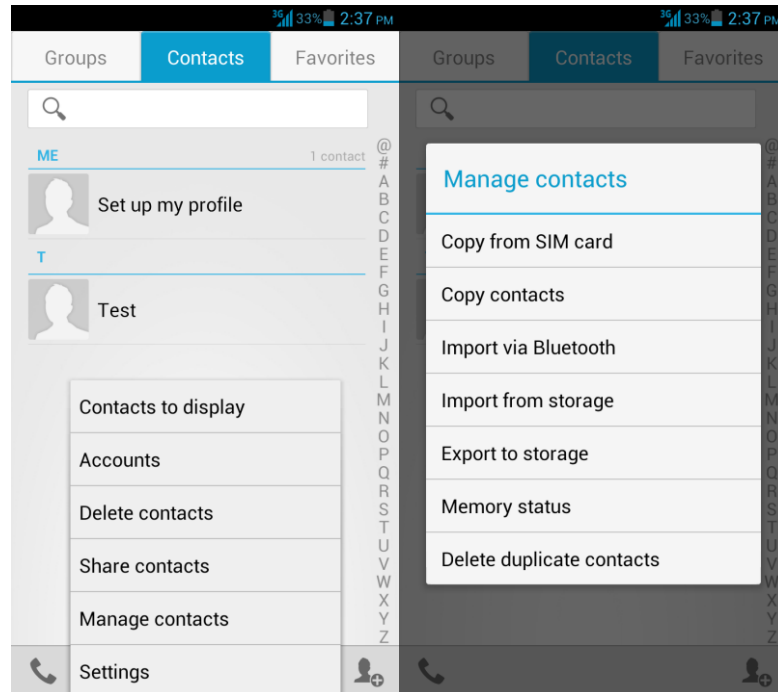
Method 2: Open **People** > **Groups**. Select the group and press “+” to add contacts to a group.



1.6.5 How Do I Manage Contacts (Copy and Backup)

Open **People** > **Menu** > **Manage contacts**.

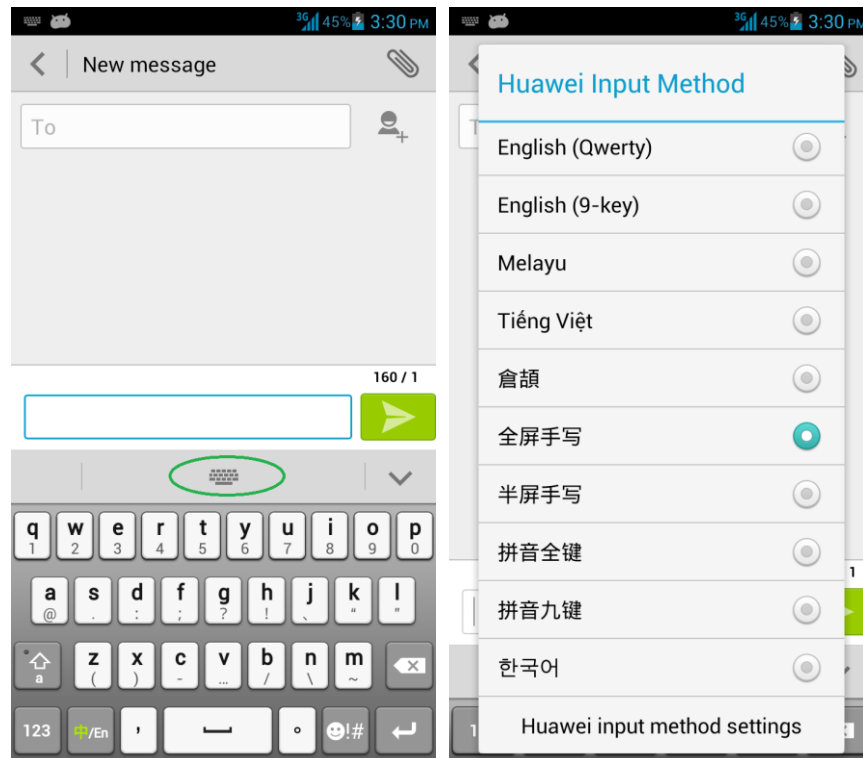
Users can copy, export, import, view the storage status, and delete duplicate contacts.



1.7 Text Messages

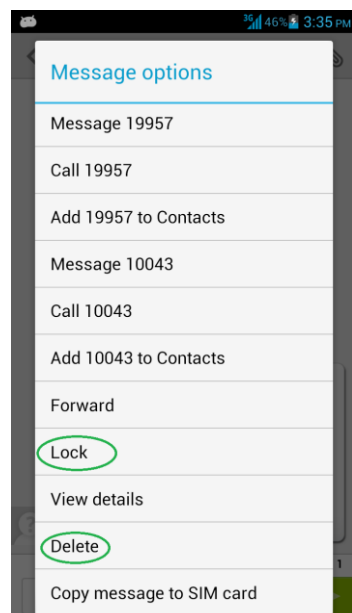
1.7.1 How Do I Switch to the Handwriting Input Method?

Create a new message and click on the input box. Click the displayed Huawei input keyboard and select.

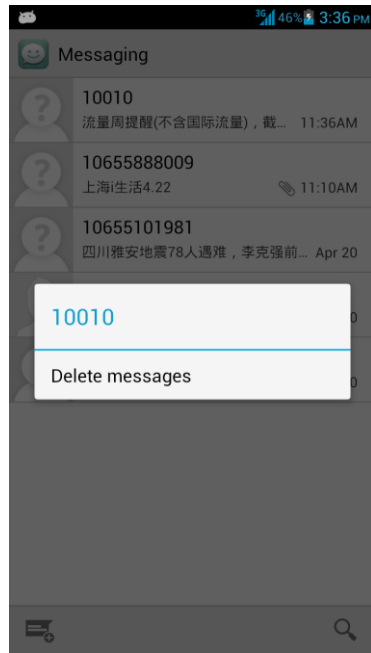


1.7.2 Delete or Lock Messages from a Specific Sender

Enter the message inbox, long press a message and select **Lock** to lock the message, select **Delete** to delete the message.

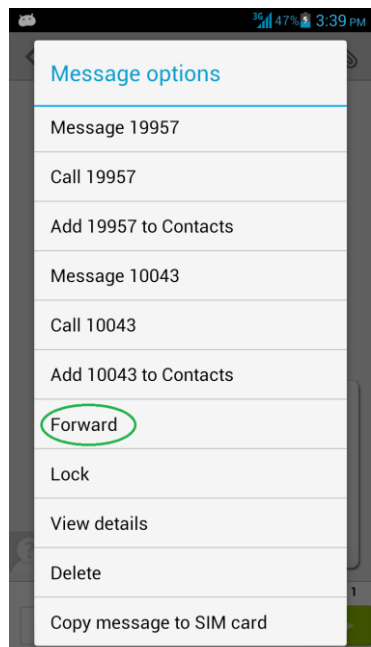


Long press a sender and select **Delete Messages**, and you can delete all the messages from this sender.



1.7.3 How Do I Forward a Text Message or Send a Text Message to Multiple Recipients?

Message forwarding: Long press a message and select **Forward** to forward the message to a receiver.



Group sending: Create a new message, click  to add receivers, and press **Add** to send the message to a group of receivers.

1.7.4 How many English and Chinese Characters Can Be Contained in a Long Text Message?

English: 1440. Chinese: 630

1.7.5 How Many Text Messages Can Be Saved on My Phone?

A maximum of 5000 text messages or 5000 multimedia messages from one sender are supported (You can modify the maximum number in settings.)

The number of messages the phone can store is determined by the storage space of the phone.

1.7.6 How to Set the Number for Short Message Center?

P2-6070 does not support the editing of short message center number.

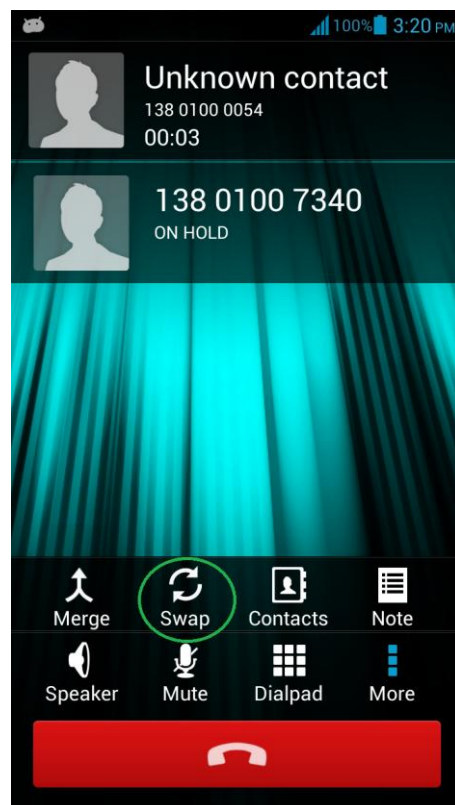
1.8 Calling

1.8.1 Calling Recording and Storage

P2-6070 does not support calling recording.

1.8.2 How to Switch to Three-Party Conversation During a Call?

See the buttons in the following figure. Touch  to switch calling during multiple calls.



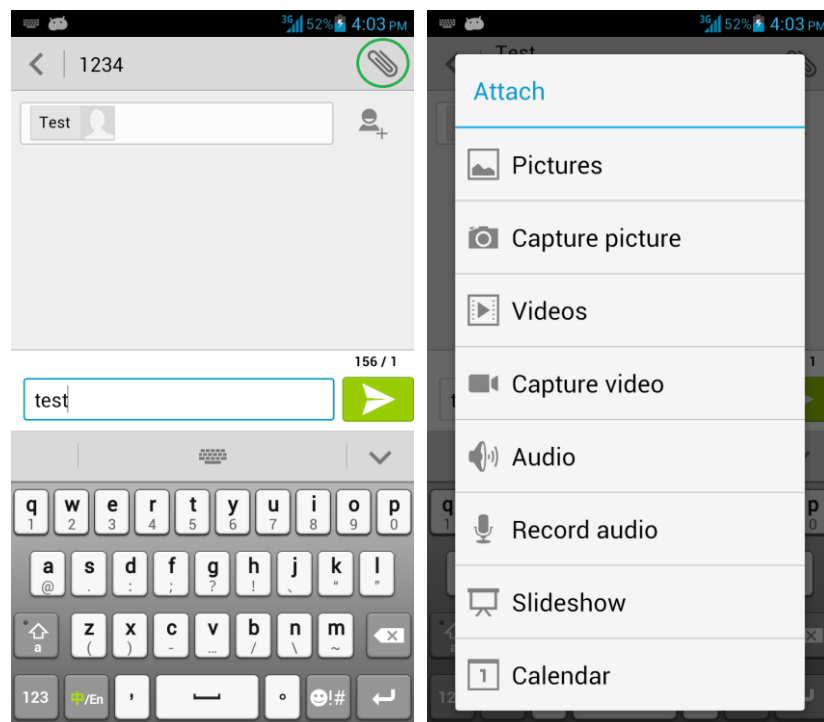
1.8.3 Does My Phone Support Dual Cards?

P2-6070 does not support dual SIM cards.

1.9 Multimedia Messages

1.9.1 Sending a Multimedia Message

1. Enter **Message** and select **New message**.
2. Enter the recipient and the text message.
3. Touch the **Menu** key and select **Add subject** (Then the text message is changed to a multimedia message).
4. Touch the icon on the upper right of the interface to add pictures, audios, and videos (Then the text message is changed to a multimedia message).



5. After the editing, touch  to send.

1.9.2 I Cannot Send or Receive Multimedia Messages, Why? How Can I Solve This Problem?

Reason: The network condition or signal reception is poor.

Solution: Try again later.

- The message is denied by the network (MMS center).

Reason: The network side is too busy to process the MMS.

Solution: Try again later.

- The message is denied by the network (MMS center).

Reason1: The recipient number is invalid.

Solution: Check whether the recipient number is correct and try again.

Reason 2: The multimedia message exceeds 300 KB.

Solution: Delete some contents from the multimedia message to make sure that it is within 300 KB, and try again.

- The balance is insufficient.

Reason: Arrears

Solution: Top up your account and try again.

- Your phone's available storage is insufficient.

Reason: insufficient storage

Solution: Delete some files from your phone to free up at least 300 KB memory.

1.9.3 Is There Any Restriction on the Size, Format, or Resolution of the File to be Attached to a Multimedia Message?

If the size of a video or an audio file exceeds the specified size (generally 300 KB), the file cannot be added as an attachment. If a picture is too large, it will be compressed and its resolution will be affected before attached to the multimedia message.

1.9.4 Attachment Storage

The MMS attachment is automatically saved to the **Data** directory and is invisible to the user.

The user can manually save the attachment to the Download directory of the phone.

1.10 Music

1.10.1 What Are the Meanings of Artists, Albums, Songs, and Playlists?

Album: Songs belong to the same album are stored in the same directory.

Artist: Songs belong to the same singer are stored in the same directory.

Song: Songs are stored in a big directory according to naming rules.

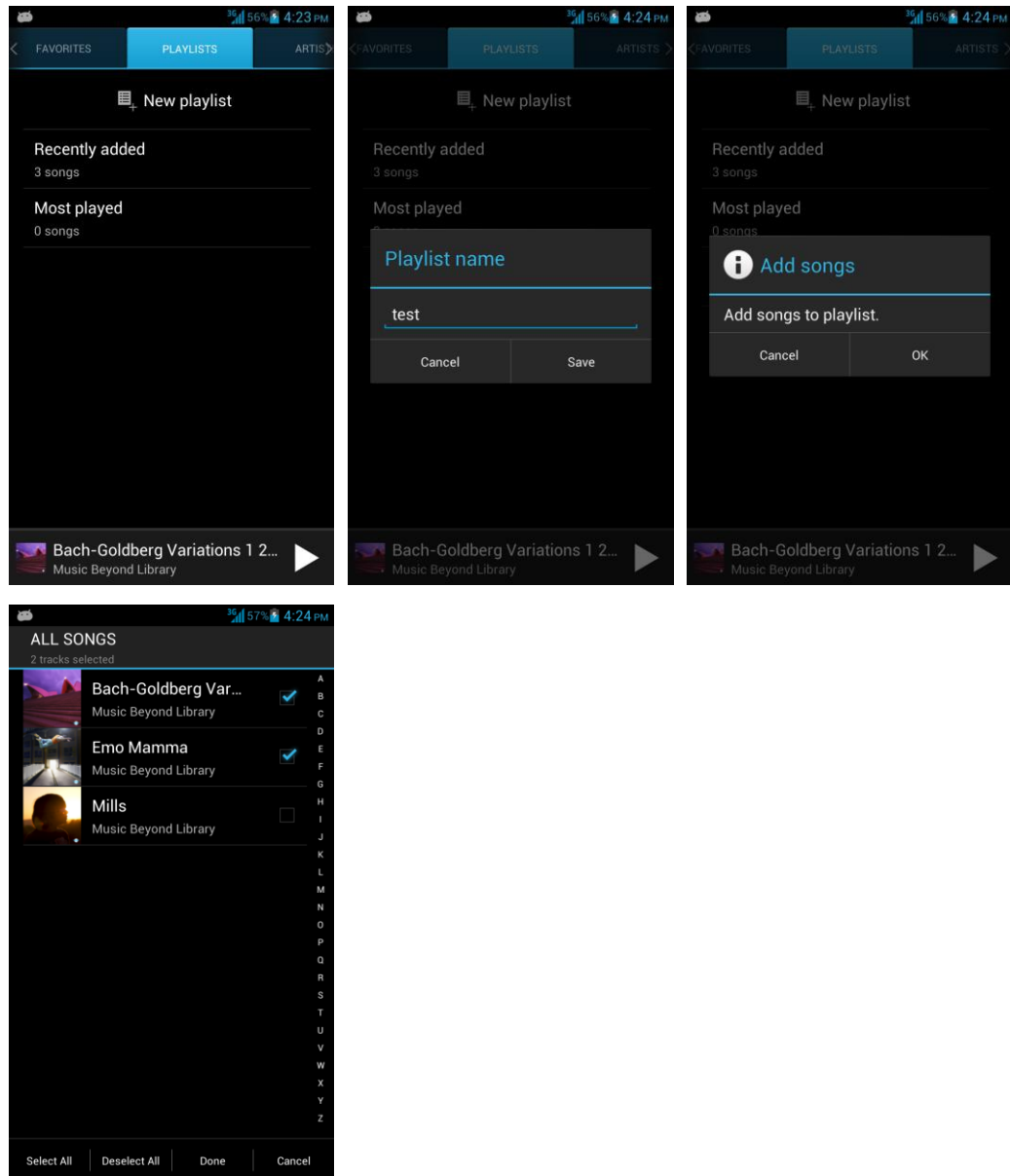
Style: Songs of the same style are stored in the same directory.

Playlist: You can define your own directory and add songs into it.

1.10.2 How Do I Create a Playlist?

1. Open **Playlists** > **New playlist**.
2. Enter a name for the new playlist and click **Save**.

3. A pop-up dialog box will be displayed, click **OK**. You can add songs to the new playlist and click **Done**.



1.10.3 What Playing Modes Does My Phone Support?

- Shuffle is off (by default): play all songs in a playlist in sequence and stop playing after all the songs have been played.
- Shuffle is on: play all songs in the playlist in a random order and stop playing after all the songs have been played.
- Repeat all songs: play all songs in a playlist in sequence and repeat the playlist in sequence after all the songs have been played.
- Repeat the current song: play the current song repeatedly.

1.10.4 How Can I Play Songs in the Background, Exit music, and View the Lyric When the Song Is Playing?

1. To play audio files in the background, touch the **back** or **home** key when playing an audio file using the music player.
2. To exit the music player, touch the **menu** key and select **Exit**.
3. When a song and its lyric are in the same directory, lyrics display is supported. In the music playing interface, touch the little triangle button to display the lyric. Touch the lyric and two buttons will be displayed. Press the two buttons and you can either fast forward or delay the lyric display by one second.

1.11 Camera

1.11.1 If My Phone Has No MicroSD Card Installed, Can I Use It to Take Photos or Record Videos?

Yes.

1.11.2 My Phone Cannot Open Some Photos or Videos. Why?

1. The phone does not support the file format.
2. The phone's RAM is insufficient.
3. The file has been corrupted.
4. Files of dcf format are protected by copyrights.
5. The phone's resources are insufficient. Close some applications to release resources.
6. Unknown errors occurred in the phone's OS or applications. Restart the phone and try again.

1.11.3 Where Are My Photos and Video Clips Saved? How Do I Change the Saving Directory?

The default saving directory of your photos is **File management > Internal > DCIM > Camera**.

1.11.4 How Do I Edit Photos or Videos or Add Frames to Photos?

- While browsing a photo, touch the menu key and you can rotate the photo to the right or left, tailor or edit the photo.
- Videos cannot be edited.
- You cannot add frames to photos.

1.11.5 Does My Phone Support the HD Video?

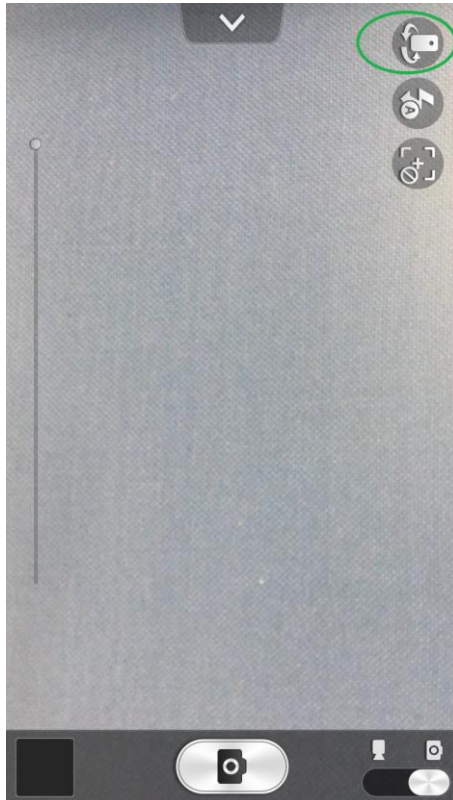
Yes. Your phone supports 1080p HD videos at 30 FPS.

1.11.6 Can I Turn Off the Shutter Sound?

No

1.11.7 How Do I Switch Between the Primary and the Secondary Cameras?

During the photo shooting, touch the shortcut key on the upper right to quickly switch between the cameras.



1.11.8 What Video Formats and the Size of the Video Does the Camera Support?

The video format is mp4. The size of the video is proportional to the remaining storage space of the phone or the SD card.

1.11.9 What Picture Formats and the Size of Picture Does the Camera Support?

The picture format is jpg and the size of the picture is not limited.

1.12 Streaming Media

1.12.1 Will My Phone Stop Playing Streaming Media When a Call Comes In? If Yes, Will It Resume Playing After the Call Is Ended?

- The mobile phone stops playing the streaming media when you have an incoming call.
- If the call is ended within three minutes, the stream media is resumed to play. If the call lasts more than three minutes, you need to touch a key to resume playing.

1.12.2 The Phone Cannot Play Some Streaming Media. Why?

- The phone does not support the file format.
The stream media supports the following coding and file formats:
 - Video coding formats: MPEG4, H263, H264
 - Audio coding formats: AAC, AMR-NB/WB
 - File formats: 3gp, mp4
 - Maximum code rate: 4 Mbps
- The network connection is unstable.
- The phone's RAM is insufficient.

1.12.3 What Causes Poor Quality of Online Streaming Media Played on My Phone?

- The source streaming media is of poor quality.
- The network connection is poor.
- The phone's hardware may be faulty, for example, the display is damaged. To check this, use another device to play the online streaming media for comparison.
- The phone memory is insufficient.
- The CPU usage is high.
- Too many applications are running.

1.12.4 When Playing online streaming media, will the phone's Internal Storage Become Insufficient?

No. When playing, the online streaming media occupies the RAM rather than the mobile phone memory.

1.13 Bluetooth

1.13.1 What Files Can Be Transmitted Using Bluetooth?

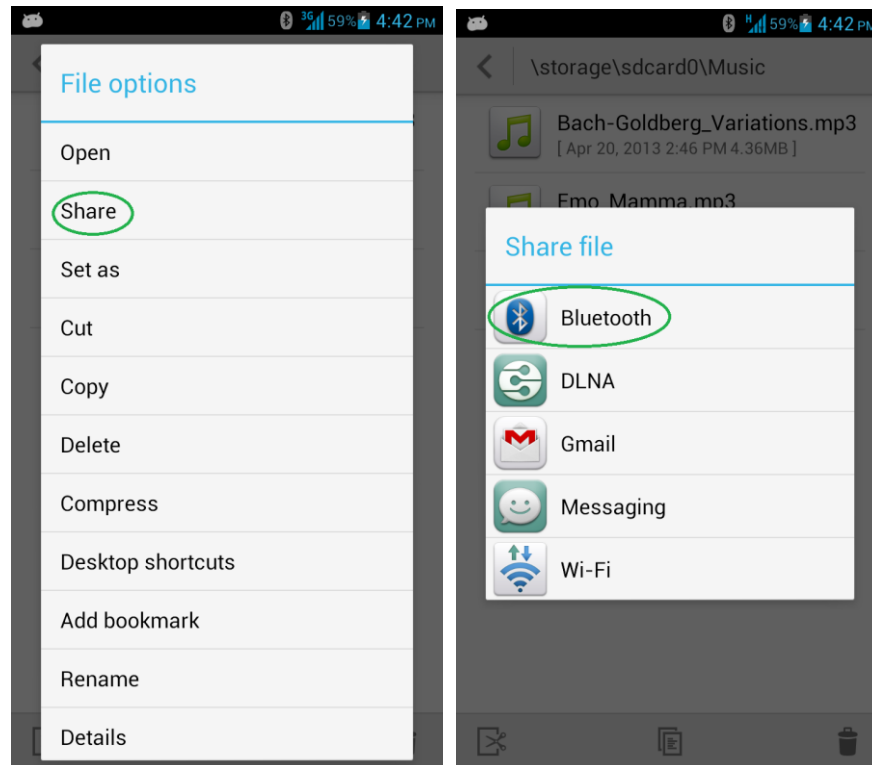
Pictures, audio files, videos, text files, web pages, or contacts can be transmitted via Bluetooth.

1.13.2 How to Transmit Data Files Using Bluetooth?

In the music playing interface or the photo gallery, long press a file and select **Share** > **Bluetooth** in the pop-up dialog box to transmit the file using Bluetooth.

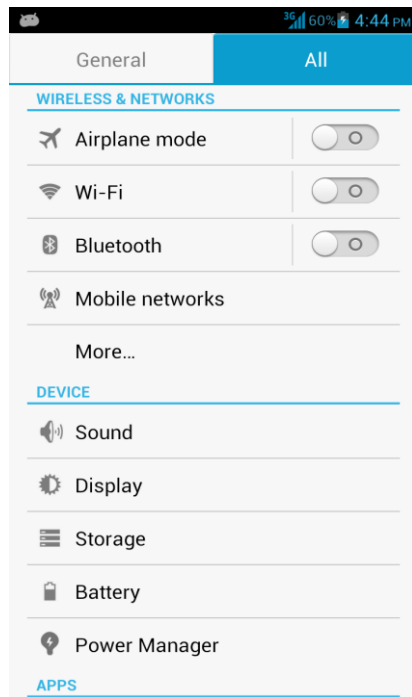
Open **Chrome**, press  > **Share...** > **Bluetooth**.

Enter **People** and press  > **Share contacts** > choose contacts > **Share** > **Bluetooth**.

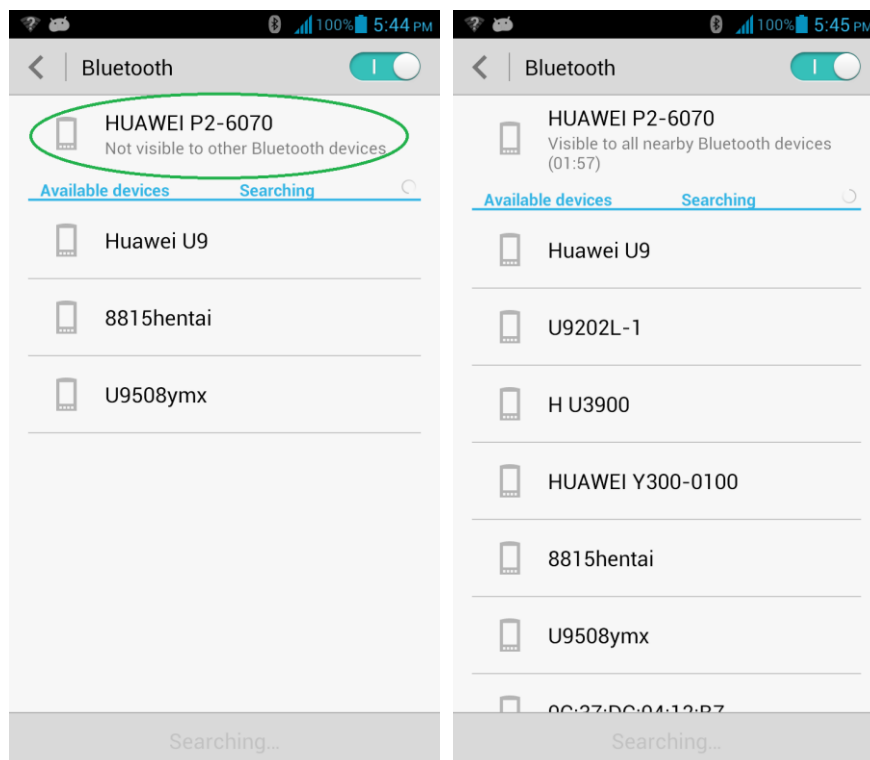


1.13.3 My Phone Cannot Be Discovered by Other Devices. Why?

- Bluetooth has been turned off on your phone.
Solution: Touch **Settings** and enable the Bluetooth.



- The phone is not set to discoverable after Bluetooth is turned on.
Solution: Touch **Settings**, turn on Bluetooth, and touch the first item.



1.13.4 What Is Bluetooth's Working Range?

10 meters

1.13.5 My Phone Fails to Pair with Other Bluetooth Devices. Why?

Your phone supports profiles, such as A2DP, HSP, HFP, PAN, HIDH, OPP, and PBAP. If the pairing device also supports these profiles but fails to be paired with, see the following solutions:

- Your phone cannot find other phones.
Solution: Check that Bluetooth on the other phone is turned on and the phone is discoverable.
- Your phone cannot detect a Bluetooth headset.

- Your phone cannot send files to other phones.
Solution: Check that the phone to be connected to is able to receive files and support the format of the sent file.

- The x digital subscriber line (xDSL) connection failed. If the Wi-Fi hotspot (such as a wireless router) to which your phone connects use the xDSL mode to access the Internet, your phone cannot access the Internet when the xDSL connection failed. Ensure that the Wi-Fi hotspot successfully connects to the Internet in xDSL mode.
- A domain name service (DNS) problem occurred. In this case, web pages cannot be opened, but you may still log in to QQ. Attempt to log in to QQ to verify that this may be the problem.
- The websites that the Wi-Fi hotspot can access are restricted. In this case, your phone cannot access the restricted websites.

2.2.4 I Have Turned on My Phone's Wi-Fi, but It Cannot Detect Wi-Fi Signals from a Wireless Router Like Other Devices. How Can I Solve the Problem?

- Check that the wireless router's service set identifier (SSID) is not hidden.
- Turn on your phone's Wi-Fi again.
- Restart your phone.

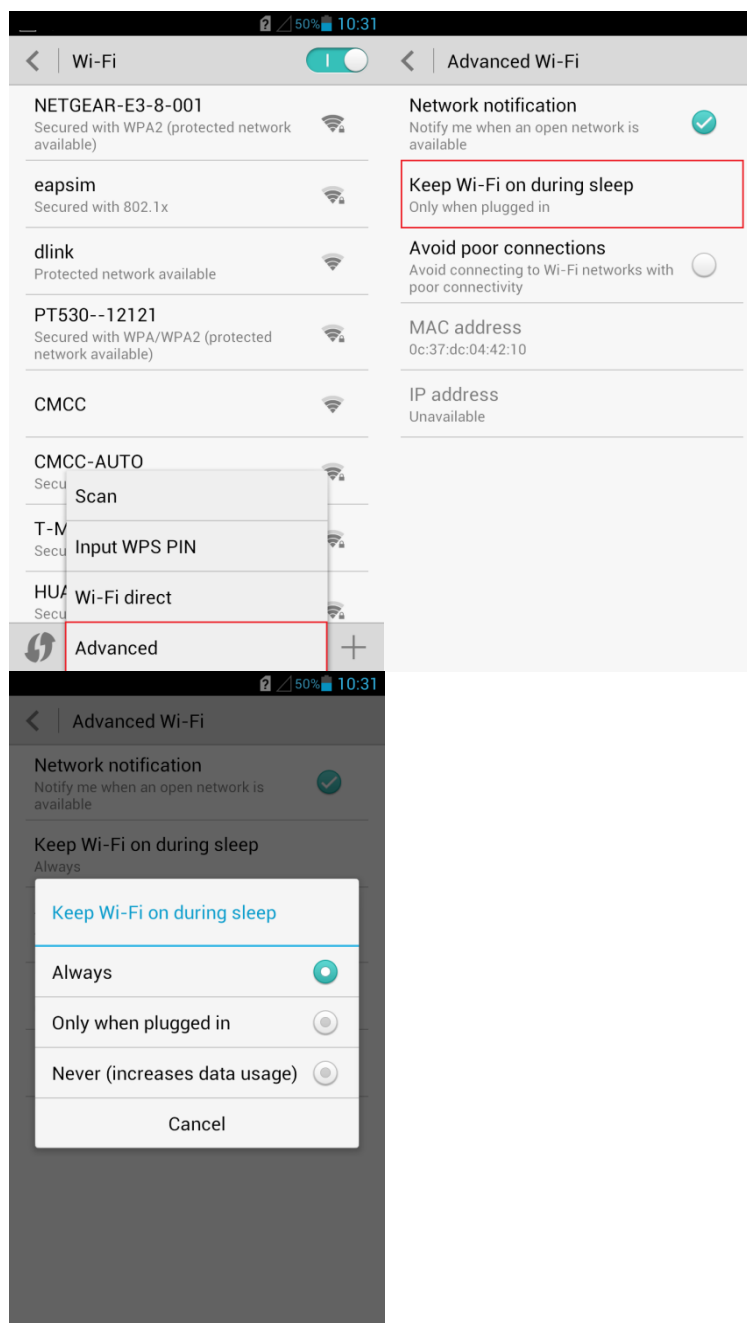

2.2.6 I Cannot Connect to a Wi-Fi Hotspot. Why?

- The password is incorrect. Note that the password is case-sensitive.
- The signal strength becomes weak or your phone is out of the Wi-Fi hotspot coverage.

2.2.7 My Phone's Wi-Fi Connection Automatically Disconnects After the Screen Times Out. What Can I Do?

You can set the sleep policy as required. In the application List, touch **Settings** > **WIRELESS & NETWORKS** > **Wi-Fi**, and touch . On the **Advanced Wi-Fi** screen, touch **Keep Wi-Fi on during sleep**, and touch **Always**.

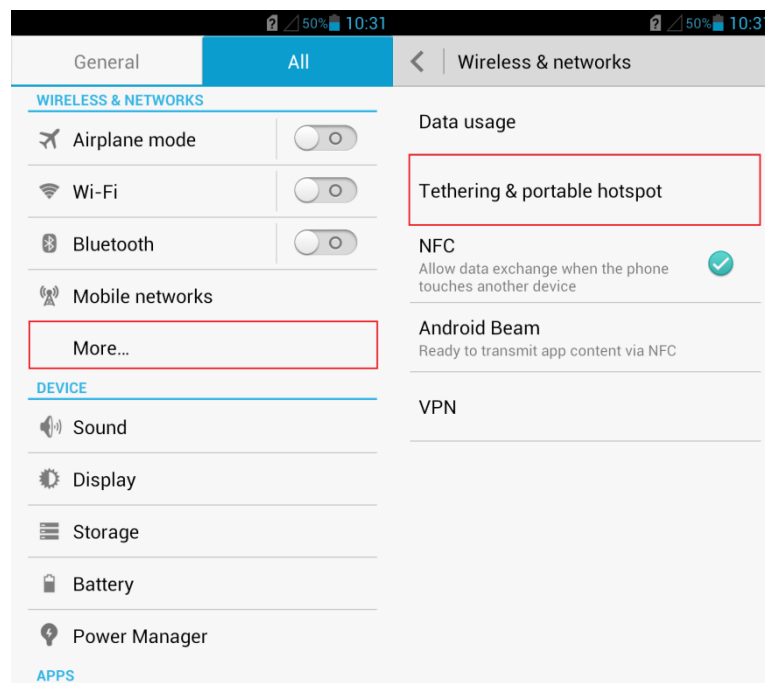

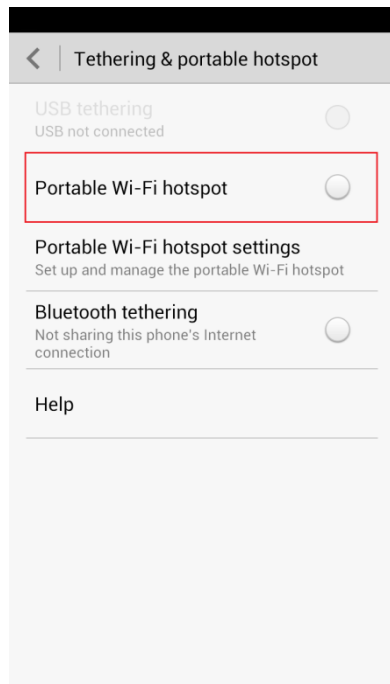

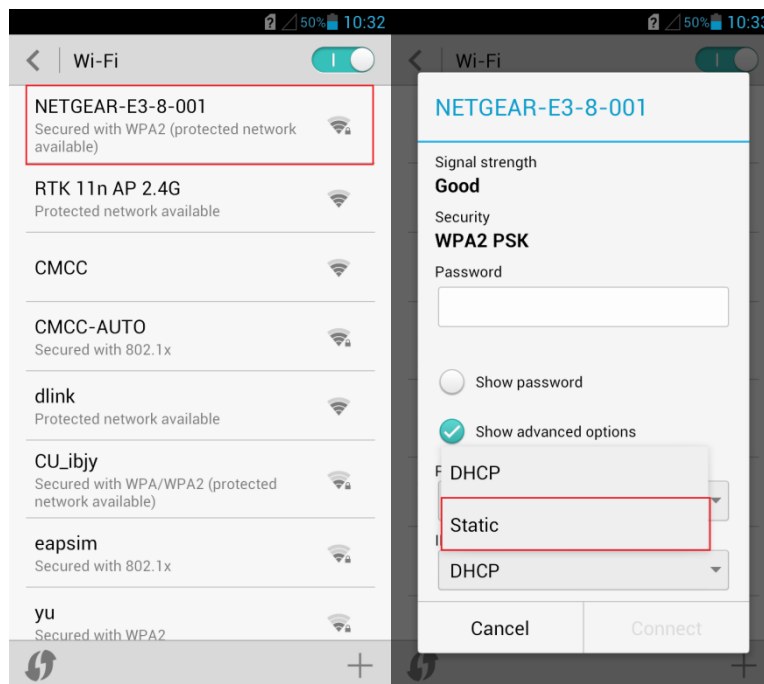

Before using tethering, ensure that the USB driver for Huawei P2-6070 is installed on your computer and your phone can access the Internet.

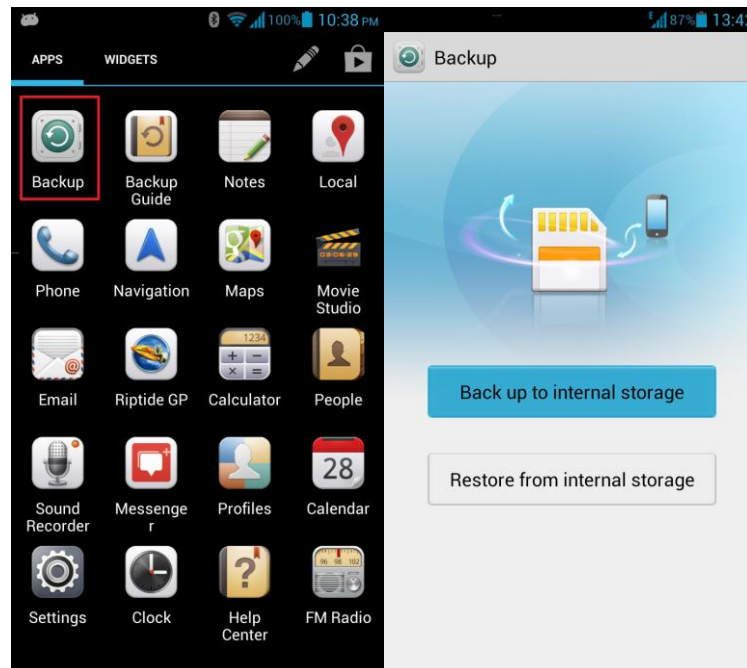

- Animation scale: controls the animation scale.
- Background process limit: limits the number of background processes.
- Show all ANRs: shows the **App Not Responding** dialog box for background applications.

2.20 Can I Use My Phone as a USB Flash Drive? Are There Any Conditions?

Connect your phone to a PC. Flick down the notification bar, touch **Connected as an installer**, and select MTP or PTP. Your phone is used as a USB flash drive. Only audio and video files can be transferred in the MTP mode, and only pictures can be transferred in the PTP mode.

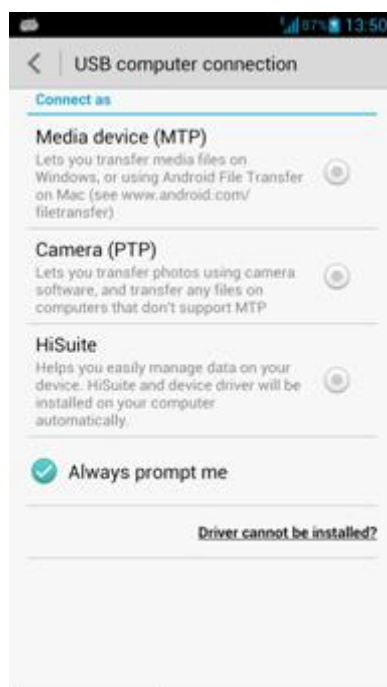

If an upgrade package exists on the microSD card or after the upgrade package is downloaded, power off your phone and hold on the Power key and volume up key to enter the recovery mode. Press the volume up or down key to select an option to enter the corresponding function.

To restore factory settings, touch **Settings > Backup & reset > Factory data reset > Reset phone**.

3.6 Can I Scan a 2-Dimensional Barcode with My Phone?

Yes. A 2-dimensional barcode application must be installed on your phone.

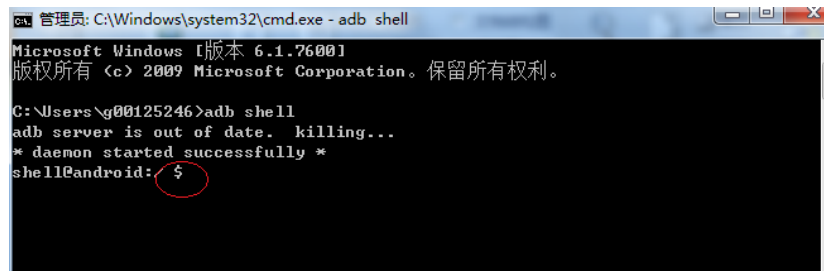
3.7 Does My Phone Support 3D Speed Up?

Yes. To enable 3D speed up, touch **Settings > Developer options**, and select **Force GPU rendering**.

3D speed up allows for smooth game playing, but increases memory resource consumption. If many applications are running when you play games, the phone may respond slowly.

3.8 How Do I Tell Whether the Phone Is Rooted?

Run the **adb shell** command. If \$ is displayed in the command output, the phone is not rooted. If # is displayed in the command output, the phone is rooted.
