
Getting to know your Buzzard 2 device



What the lights mean



Red:

No connectivity



Red (blinking):

Device preparing to connect



Yellow:

3G or 4G signal



Green:

Strong 3G or 4G signal



Blue:

Updating the software (make sure the device remains

powered when updating)

Logging in to the Connection Manager page

Connect to the Connection Manager to read or send text messages, update your security password and more.

To log in, follow the steps below

- Make sure the connection to your Car WiFi device is working normally.
- 2. Open your internet browser and enter 192.168.1.1 in the address box.
- Enter the username and password which, by default will be:
 Username: admin Password: admin

Inserting your Micro SIM

1. Open the SIM door.



 Insert the Micro SIM (push out the Micro SIM from the full size SIM provided).




3. Close the SIM door.



Connecting your tablet or phone to the WiFi

 Insert device into the 12v power socket. Now press and hold the power button for two seconds.



2. Now wait for a static yellow or green light. More lighting info overleaf.



Now search for your WiFi network on your tablet or phone. And once prompted enter the WiFi password.

Almost there

On pay as you go?

So you've got your yellow or green light on your device. Brilliant. Open a web browser window and you'll automatically be taken to a registration page. Fill in some short details, and then activate your SIM. Now you're ready to go.

IMPORTANT

On the back of your SIM pack is a number starting with '07' Please write it on your Keep Me Card for safe keeping.

You'll need this number if you want to call us up to talk about your device or if you're on pay as you go and need to top up.
