- 1. Connect the device to the TV with HD cable, connect device to the power adaptor, connect mouse, air mouse or other input devices with USB port
- 2. After the device and cables connected, power LED turns into blue
- 3. After disconnect the device from the power adaptor, Power LED turns off.
- 4. Under power on mode, press remote control's power button, device is entering into sleep mode, Power LED turns into red
- 5. Under sleep mode, device will be wake when you press remote control's power button, power LED turns from red to blue

1.1.9 File Browser

Move to "File browser". Press OK to enter into the device list.

When inserting with USB device or SD/SDHC/MMC cards, the sign "Device is mounting" will be shown on the screen.

Here you can cut, copy, paste and move the files and folder between the local disk and external storage card.
