


Welcome to the user manual for this comfortable-fit Bluetooth headset designed by Hussar. It uses Bluetooth 4.1 echo elimination technology, provides premium sound quality, and has an easy hands-free operation. Before using this product, please read this manual in detail.

Product Overview



FEATURE	OPERATION
Power On	Long press the "MFB" button for 2 seconds. Remove finger. The blue indicator light flashes.
Power Off	Long press the "MFB" button for 3 seconds. The red indicator light flashes 1 second and goes off.
Answer a call	Short press the "MFB" button.
End a call	Short press the MFB button.
Reject a call	Long press the "Vol-" button for 2 seconds.
Redial last number	Double press the "MFB" button.
Play/Pause	Short press the "MFB" button to play and pause.
Previous/Next Track	Press the "Vol-"/"Vol+" button for 2 seconds.
Volume up/down	Short press the "Vol+"/"Vol-" button.
Microphone mute/unmute	During a call, long press "Vol-" for 2 seconds to mute or unmute.
Call switch	During a call, long press "Vol+" for 2 seconds to switch the audio between Bluetooth headset and cell phone.
Voice command (Siri on iPhone)	Short press "Super" button.
EQ Switch (two EQ settings)	EQ1: normal bass EQ2: heavy bass Press and hold the "Super" button for over 2 seconds to switch to another EQ. Return to the EQ1: double press the "Super" button.

How to wear



First, for the best audio experience, please try each size of the ear tips and select the pair that is tight and secure in your ears. Then, wear the headphones according to following diagram.

How to connect

- Keep the Bluetooth headset within 1 meter or 3 feet when pairing.
- Make sure the headset is off. Press and hold the Multi-Function Button for approximately 2 seconds, then remove the finger. The LED indicator should flash blue quickly. This means the headset is in pairing mode.
- Enable the Bluetooth function in your device. Search for available Bluetooth devices and select "Magicbuds II" from the list of found devices.
- If a password or PIN is required, please enter "0000".
- If prompted by your mobile phone to connect, select "Yes". (This is different for various mobile phone models.)
- After successful connection, the LED indicator will flash blue once per 8 seconds.

Note:

- Please dry the headphones after each workout.

Reconnect the headset

- The Bluetooth headset will try to reconnect to the mobile phone automatically.
- If your Bluetooth headset does not reconnect, please press the MFB 1 time or click the "Magicbuds II" in your phone's Bluetooth menu to reconnect manually.

Charging

Magicbuds II comes with a built-in rechargeable battery. It is recommended that you charge the battery fully before its first use.

- Plug in the micro USB cable and plug another side to the USB port of the PC/laptop or into any USB power charger.
 - LED indicator red light on: Charging
 - Red light off and blue light on: Charging complete
- It takes about 2 hours to charge fully.

Warnings:

- Please do not expose the headphones under direct sunlight while charging, especially when environmental temperatures are high.
- Please avoid water damage. If this occurs, do not use any more.
- Please avoid low quality USB chargers.

Restore to factory settings

When charging, press and hold the "MFB" button for 3 seconds to clear pairing records. This is done until the indicator flashes blue.

Multi-pairing

- When the Bluetooth headset is turned off, press and hold the Multi-Function Button for approximately 2 seconds, until the LED indicator is flashing blue quickly. This means the headset is in pairing mode.
- Enable the Bluetooth of mobile phone #1 and search for the Bluetooth devices. Then select "Magicbuds II" to complete the connection.
- Disable mobile phone #1's Bluetooth and long press the Multi-Function Button until the red light is on to turn off the Bluetooth headset.
- Turn on the Bluetooth headset again and make it into the pairing mode.
- Enable the Bluetooth function of mobile phone #2, Searching for the Bluetooth devices. Then, select "Magicbuds II" to complete the connection.
- Enable mobile phone #1's Bluetooth function again and find the Bluetooth headset "Magicbuds" in the list. Then, select it to complete 1 to 2 pairings.

Keep your Bluetooth headset close to the cell phone. The straight unblock distance is about 10 meters (30 feet) between the cell phone and Bluetooth headset. Beyond this distance, the sound quality may decline and lose connection.

Voice Prompt

When the headset is on, there will be an automatic voice prompt: Power On

When the headset is off, there will be an automatic voice prompt: Power Off

When connected successfully, there will be an automatic voice prompt: Your Headset is Connected

When disconnected, there will be an automatic voice prompt: Your Headset is Disconnected

When the battery is low, there will be an automatic voice prompt: Battery Low

FAQ

1.The mobile phone can't find the Bluetooth headset.

Solution:

- Check whether the Bluetooth headset is turned on and in pairing mode. When the indicator light flashes blue quickly, it shows that Magicbuds II is in pairing mode.
- If the Bluetooth headset is turned on and in pairing mode but still can't be found, please try restarting your mobile phone and Bluetooth headset.

Note: The Bluetooth headset will turn off automatically after 2 minutes without connection.

2.After connecting the Bluetooth headset with the mobile phone, it is always disconnected or has noise.

Solutions:

- The battery is low; please recharge the headset.
- Make sure the mobile phone is within the Bluetooth signal distance. The maximum distance is 30 feet or 10 meters.
- Don't cover the Bluetooth headset with your hand.

3.The Bluetooth headset is connected, but you can't listen to music.

Solutions:

- Check your Bluetooth setting and adjust the sound path to hands-free mode.
- Some mobile phones do not have the stereo Bluetooth module and Bluetooth function. Please connect your Bluetooth headset to other mobile phones to check whether the headset is okay.

4.How do I use the Bluetooth headset to listen to music or chat on the computer?

Solutions:

If your computer has Bluetooth function, simply enable the function and search for the "Magicbuds II" Bluetooth headsets. If your computer does not have Bluetooth function, you need a Bluetooth adapter. By using Bluetooth software (V.T), the adapter can connect the Bluetooth headset with the computer.

5. What's the Bluetooth pairing password?

Solutions:

The Bluetooth pairing password is "0000". Most cell phones support entering the password automatically; in only a small number of devices will it be necessary to enter the password "0000" manually.

6.The red light is not on when charging.

Solutions:

If it has been a long time since you used the Bluetooth headset, it must be charged for about 30 minutes; then the red light should be on.
